Legislative Review of Adopted Regulations as Required by NRS 233B.066

Pertaining to NAC 388.133, 388.281, 388.284, of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 388:

This proposed regulation will create vital clarity regarding assessments for assessing a pupil's proficiency in the subject area of reading.

Notice of Hearing for the Adoption of LCB File R196-24 by the Nevada State Board of Education
