NRS 639.070(1)(d); NRS 454.213(1)(f) and (g).

A REGULATION relating to the possession and administration of dangerous drugs by an advanced emergency medical technician or paramedic.

Section. 1. NAC Chapter 454 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

An advanced emergency medical technician or paramedic may possess and administer a dangerous drug to a patient in a hospital or correctional institution if:

- 1. The dangerous drug is ordered by a practitioner;*
- 2. The advanced emergency medical technician or paramedic holds a certification in good standing issued pursuant to Chapter 450B of the Nevada Revised Statutes;*
- 3. The hospital or correctional institution has enacted a medication administration policy and protocol related to the possession or administration of the dangerous drug; and*
- 4. The advanced emergency medical technician or paramedic complies with all applicable provisions of Chapter 450B of the Nevada Revised Statutes and related regulations.*
