PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION

The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed by the agency submitted on 06/12/2025

NAC 385B.302 Establishment and submission of schedules of events; *participation in unsanctioned events*; penalties. (NRS 385B.060)

- 1. Each school shall establish a schedule of events for each season for a sanctioned sport in which the school participates. After establishing the schedule, the school shall submit a copy of the schedule to the Association on a form or in a manner approved by the Association not later than:
- (a) June 15 of each year, if the schedule is established for a sanctioned sport that is conducted during the fall of that year;
- (b) September 15 of each year, if the schedule is established for a sanctioned sport that is conducted during the winter of that year; or
- (c) January 15, if the schedule is established for a sanctioned sport that is conducted during the spring of that year.
- 2. The schedule submitted pursuant to subsection 1 shall include all games, contests or matches, including league, non-league, and tournaments for each sanctioned sport the school participates in.
- 3. For each in-season tournament in which a school participates in each sanctioned sport, the school shall submit a copy of the full format, dates and times and all participating teams in the tournament to the Association no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the tournament.
- 4. Schools shall inform the Association of all changes (date, time, site, opponent) made to the established schedule when any changes are made.
- 2. 5. The Association will impose a penalty *in accordance with the provisions of NAC 385B.960* of \$100 against each school that fails to submit to the Association a schedule, *tournament schedule or schedule changes* within the periods prescribed in subsections 1-4.
- 6. Before a school may host, attend or participate in a tournament, the tournament must have approved Association and National Federation of State High School Association sanctioning, when applicable.
- 7. Member schools may compete against schools in good standing. Any tournament in which a school participates must follow all Association regulations, regardless of the state in which the tournament occurs or any other states' regulations, and must be in compliance with NAC 385B.308-310. Schools shall not participate in tournaments on Sundays per NAC 385B.330. Schools that participate in events that do not have Association and National Federation of State High School Association sanctioning will be in violation of NAC 385B.302. The Association will impose a penalty in accordance with the provisions of NAC 385B.960 against each school that violates any provision of subsections 6 and 7. (Added to NAC by Nev.
