

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN EDUCATION**

**The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed
by the agency submitted on 08/23/2025**

The intent of this regulation is to allow the Superintendent of Public Instruction to update or remove endorsements on a license when an endorsement no longer exists.

NAC 391.XXX Elimination of Endorsements

The Superintendent of Public Instruction may:

- 1. Remove an endorsement from a license when the endorsement no longer exists and there are no other options to transition into another endorsement.*
- 2. Change the name of an endorsement on a license when there is a name change to that endorsement or when an endorsement is discontinued but the educator can be transitioned, without additional requirements, into another endorsement that can teach in the same assignment.*
- 3. Allow an educator three years to transition, if a transition pathway is available into a new endorsement that has additional requirements, if their current endorsement no longer exists.*
