

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

Proposed Regulation of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy

AUTHORITY: NRS 453.221, NRS 454.371, NRS 639.070, NRS 639.0727

A REGULATION relating to the authority of a homeopathic physician who is not licensed as an allopathic or osteopathic physician in Nevada, or otherwise authorized by the Board to possess, administer, prescribe and dispense controlled substances and dangerous drugs; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 639 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. A homeopathic physician who is not licensed as an allopathic or osteopathic physician in Nevada, or otherwise authorized by the Board to possess, administer, prescribe and dispense dangerous drugs, may only possess, administer, prescribe and dispense dangerous drugs in conformance with homeopathic pharmacology as defined in NRS 630A.040 and in the dosages permitted in the Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia of the United States.*
- 2. A homeopathic physician registered pursuant to NRS 453.226(1) who is not licensed as an allopathic or osteopathic physician in Nevada, or otherwise authorized by the Board to possess, administer, prescribe and dispense controlled substances, may only possess, administer, prescribe and dispense controlled substances in conformance with homeopathic pharmacology as defined in NRS 630A.040 and in the dosages permitted in the Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia of the United States.*
- 3. The Board hereby adopts by reference the Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia of the United States, promulgated by the Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia Convention of the United States.*
- 3. As used in this section:*
 - (a) “Homeopathic physician” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 630A.050.*
 - (b) “Allopathic physician” means a person licensed to practice medicine pursuant to NRS 630.160.*

(c) “Osteopathic physician” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 633.091.

Section 2. Chapter 639 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

A pharmacist or dispensing practitioner shall not fill a prescription or dispense a dangerous drug or a controlled substance pursuant to a prescription issued by a homeopathic physician who is not licensed as an allopathic or osteopathic physician, or otherwise authorized by the Board to prescribe, except in dosages permitted in the Homeopathic Pharmacopoeia of the United States.
