

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA
INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION**

AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 385B.060.

A REGULATION relating to interscholastic activities; authorizing the Legislative Commission to appoint a Legislator to serve in an ex officio capacity as a nonvoting member of the Board of Control of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

Existing law authorizes the county school district trustees to form a nonprofit association, to be known as the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association, for the purposes of controlling, supervising and regulating all interscholastic athletic events and other interscholastic events in the public schools. (NRS 385B.050) Existing regulations establish the Board of Control as the governing body of the Association and set forth the voting and nonvoting membership of the Board. (NAC 385B.106) This regulation authorizes the Legislative Commission to appoint a Legislator to serve in an ex officio capacity as a nonvoting member of the Board.

Section 1. NAC 385B.106 is hereby amended to read as follows:

385B.106 1. The Board consists of twelve voting members selected pursuant to NAC 385B.110. The Board is the governing body of the Association.

2. In addition to the voting members specified in subsection 1, the Board includes the following nonvoting members:

(a) The president of:

(1) Each class established pursuant to NAC 385B.250;

- (2) The private schools selected pursuant to NAC 385B.240; and
- (3) The Nevada Athletic Directors Association or its successor organization;
- (b) A representative from Class 4A North who is not serving as a nonvoting member pursuant to subparagraph (1) of paragraph (a);
- (c) A representative from Class 4A South who is not serving as such a nonvoting member;
- (d) A representative appointed by the Nevada Association of School Administrators or its successor organization;
- (e) A representative appointed by an association of sports officials approved by the Association;
- (f) A representative from a charter school that is a member school; ~~and~~
- (g) *A Legislator appointed by the Legislative Commission who serves in an ex officio capacity; and*
- (h) Three pupils who are currently participating in a sanctioned sport of the Association to include:
 - (1) A resident of a county whose population is 700,000 or more;
 - (2) A resident of a county whose population is 100,000 or more but less than 700,000; and
 - (3) A resident of a county whose population is less than 100,000.

↪ Of the three members selected pursuant to this paragraph, none may be a child or immediate family member of an employee of a school district, charter school or private school.

3. Each nonvoting member specified in subsection 2 serves for a term of 2 years.
