**The following document is the initial draft regulation proposed
by the agency submitted on 03/31/2026**

NAC 616C.305 Request or application to permit discovery by deposition, interrogatories or production of documents. (NRS 616C.310)

1. A party who wishes an appeals officer to permit discovery by deposition, interrogatories or production of documents must ~~request such discovery at any prehearing conference held in the matter~~ or submit a written ~~application~~ **motion** to that officer at least 30 days before the hearing. The ~~application~~ **motion** must:

(a) Set forth the reason why the discovery is necessary; ~~and~~

(b) Be accompanied by a copy of the discovery request to be served, an identification of any witnesses sought to be deposed, and a summary of the anticipated testimony of each such witness; and

(b) Be accompanied by the appropriate orders for discovery.

2. ~~The appeals officer shall approve or deny the application within 5 days after the receipt of the application.~~ **Any party opposed to the motion to approve discovery may file an opposition within 5 days after the date of service of the motion.**
