

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF HEALTH**

RURAL HEALTH CLINIC

Section 1. Chapter 449 of NAC is hereby adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 5, inclusive of this regulation.

Sec. 2. “Rural Health Clinic” defined. “Rural Health Clinic” has the meaning ascribed to “rural health clinic” by NRS 449.0175.

Sec. 3. The following publication is hereby adopted by reference:

1. 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Sections 42 CFR 440.150; 42 CFR 440.155; and Sections 42 CFR 483.410 through 42 CFR 483.480(d)(5).

2. The code referenced in Subsection 1 is located at the National Archives, Code of Federal Regulations electronic system, the publication is available at no cost on the Internet at, <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-42/chapter-IV/subchapter-G/part-483/subpart-I/section-483.410> and is hereby adopted by reference, or, if that Internet website ceases to exist, from the Division.

Sec. 4. A rural health clinic shall:

- (a) Provide a sanitary environment to avoid sources and transmission of infections and communicable diseases; and
- (b) Develop and carry out an active program for the prevention, control and investigation of infections and communicable diseases.

Sec. 5. A Rural Health Clinic shall meet all applicable:

- (a) Federal and state laws;
- (b) Local ordinances, including, without limitation, zoning ordinances; and
- (c) Life safety, environmental, health, fire and local building codes,
