

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION**

A REGULATION relating to education; requiring certain reports regarding internship programs to be submitted to the State Board of Education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest

Existing law authorizes the board of trustees of a school district or the governing body of a charter school that obtains the approval of the State Board of Education to authorize certain pupils to participate in a public or private internship for the purpose of obtaining credit toward the total number of credits required for graduation. (NRS 389.167) This regulation requires the board of trustees of a school district or the governing body of a charter school that authorizes pupils to participate in such an internship to submit to the State Board reports containing certain information regarding participation in a public or private internship. This regulation provides that the State Board will approve such a report if it contains all of the information required or notify the board of trustees or governing body of any information required for approval. This regulation also provides that the State Board will suspend any authorization to allow pupils in a school district or charter school to participate in an internship if, after receiving notice of any changes required for approval, the board of trustees or governing body does not revise and resubmit the report to the State Board within 6 weeks after receiving such notice.

Section 1. Chapter 389 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. The board of trustees of a school district or the governing body of a charter school that authorizes pupils enrolled in the school district or charter school to participate in a public or private internship pursuant to NRS 389.167, as applicable, shall submit a report to the State Board not more than two times each school year that includes, without limitation:

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this paragraph, the information which the board of trustees or governing body is required to prescribe pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection 2 of NRS 389.167. If the information has been submitted in a previous report and has not changed since the last report was approved by the State Board, the board of trustees or governing body, as applicable, may instead include a statement that the information has not changed.

(b) The number of pupils who earned elective credit by successfully completing a public or private internship during the previous school year.

2. The State Board will consider whether to approve a report submitted pursuant to this section at its next meeting immediately following receipt of the report. The State Board will approve the report if all of the information required pursuant to subsection 1 is included in the report. After the meeting, the State Board will notify the board of trustees or governing body, as applicable, that the State Board:

(a) Has approved the report and that pupils may participate in a public or private internship for the purposes of obtaining credit; or

(b) Has not approved the report and will further provide notice:

(1) Of any information which must be included for the report to be approved; and

(2) That the authority of the board of trustees or governing body, as applicable, to authorize pupils to participate in a public or private internship for the purposes of obtaining credit is suspended until the State Board approves a revised report.

3. If the board of trustees or governing body, as applicable, is notified by the State Board that the report has not been approved, the board of trustees or governing body, as applicable,

must revise and resubmit the report to the State Board not later than 6 weeks after receiving such notice.
