

Small Business Impact Statement

EFFECTIVE DATE OF REGULATION:

Upon filing with the Nevada Secretary of State

1. Background:

The purpose of this regulation is to provide the process by which the Board will act by resolution to delegate authority to the Director. In accordance with NRS 408.131(6), the Board shall delegate to the Director such authority as it deems necessary under the provisions of this chapter, except as provided otherwise in NRS 408.389. The Board shall act by resolution, vote, or order entered in its records pursuant to NRS 408.131(7).

2. Description of Solicitation:

NDOT solicited impact statements from small businesses that are associated with industries familiar with NDOT's projects via email to determine whether the regulation would likely impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business or directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business.

The proposed regulation was also brought before NDOT's January 12, 2026, Board of Directors (BOD) meeting as an action item to allow NDOT to move forward with the permanent regulation process as set forth in the Administrative Rulemaking guide. The Board meeting provided the public with two (2) opportunities to comment on the proposed regulation; no comments were received or made by the public. The Board unanimously approved the action item.

3. Does the proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business or directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business? (NRS 233B.0608(1))

No, the proposed regulation does not impose a direct or significant economic burden on small business and does not directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a small business.

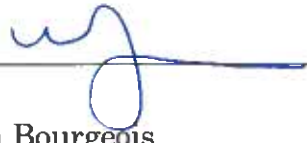
4. How was that conclusion reached?
