PURSUANT TO NRS 233B.0608

RE: Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Amendments to NAC Chapter 388D.XXX.

The proposed regulation regarding assessments that must be administered to students in private schools receiving public funding is not likely to impose a direct or significant economic burden upon a small business, or directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business. A concerted effort was made to determine any economic burden. All relevant materials were reviewed, and the Department considered its history of implementing similar regulations; the proposed changes are within the scope of the Department's activities and present no significant cost of enforcement. Comment has not been solicited from small businesses, and no summary of their response is provided, because small businesses are not impacted by this regulation and thus no burden or adverse economic impact can be assessed.
