

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE NEVADA
INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION**

AUTHORITY: § 1, NRS 385B.060.

A REGULATION relating to interscholastic activities; revising provisions governing the age at which a pupil becomes ineligible to participate in sanctioned sports; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

Existing law requires the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association to adopt rules and regulations concerning interscholastic events. (NRS 385B.060) Existing regulations provide that a pupil whose 20th birthday occurs during a season is ineligible to participate in any sanctioned sport during that season or any subsequent season. (NAC 385B.710) This regulation lowers the age at which a pupil becomes ineligible to participate in a sanctioned sport by providing that a pupil whose 19th birthday occurs before August 1 is ineligible to participate in any sanctioned sport during that or any subsequent school year.

Section 1. NAC 385B.710 is hereby amended to read as follows:

385B.710 1. A pupil whose ~~20th~~ *19th* birthday occurs ~~during a season~~ *before August 1 immediately preceding a school year* is ineligible to participate in any sanctioned sport ~~during that season and any season that is conducted after that date.~~ *in that or any subsequent school year.*

2. Each school shall maintain a record indicating the age of each pupil who:

- (a) Is enrolled in the school; and
- (b) Participates in a sanctioned sport.
