LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF ADOPTED REGULATIONS AS REQUIRED BY NRS 233b.066 LCB FILE R112-17

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 656.

- 1. This regulation is necessary to update the regulations and keep consistent with statutory changes and provide clarification to court reporters and designated representatives of court reporting firms.
- 2. Copies of the proposed regulations, notice of workshop and notice of intent to act upon the regulation were sent by email to persons who were known to have an interest in the subject of court reporting as well as any persons who had specifically requested such notice. These documents were also mailed to all county libraries in Nevada and posted at the following locations:

- 5. Notices of the workshop and adoption hearing to solicit comments were sent out to each active court reporter and designated firm representative registered with the State of Nevada Certified Court Reporters Board. The notice instructed interested persons to contact the Executive Secretary to submit their comments or request a copy of the materials. No verbal comments were made at each meeting and no written comments submitted.
- 6. As prepared by the Legislative Counsel Bureau, the permanent regulations outlined in R112-17 was adopted by the Board on December 28, 2017 with no amendments.

- 7. The Board does not anticipate any adverse economic effect on the amended regulations. The immediate and long term effects will keep NAC Chapter 656 consistent with NRS Chapter 656 and provide clarification for court reporters and court reporting firms in the state of Nevada.
- 8. There is no additional cost to the Board to enforce these regulations.
- 9. There are no other state or governmental agency regulations that the regulation duplicates.
- 10. There are no federal regulations that apply.
- 11. Section 12 of this regulation increases the fee for a person who is not a certified court reporter to serve as a designated representative of a court reporting firm, must pass an examination that consists of 100 multiple choice questions. The exam fee will increase from \$100 to \$250.
