

## Small Business Impact Statement

### EFFECTIVE DATE OF REGULATION:

Upon filing with the Nevada Secretary of State


- 1 Background: The Private Investigators Licensing Board (PILB) is updating the Nevada Administrative Codes for 648. This was in response to the Governor's Executive Order 2023-003 to streamline processes.
- 2 Description of Solicitation: The PILB sent out a survey to all licensees regarding the updates and changes to NAC 648.
- 3 Does the proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business or directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business? (NRS 233B.0608(1)): The PILB received information from licensees regarding changes to NAC 648.530 Uniforms, badges and patches. This one change would have created an economic burden on small businesses. Based on the responses in the survey, this NAC change was removed in order to have more workshops specific to uniforms, badges and patches.

The proposed regulations do not impose a direct and significant economic burden on small businesses. These changes will allow for a streamline process and improve the boards able to operate.

- 4 How was that conclusion reached?: Based on the responses from survey the only NAC change that would have caused any economic impact was dealing the uniforms and was removed in order to have more workshops to better correct the NAC and to not cause an economic impact.
