LCB FILE NO. R205-24 Small Business Impact Statement pursuant to NRS233.0609:

No comments were received by the Division for review.

To keep pace with new methods and technologies, the Nevada State Fire Marshal must adopt newly published fire codes and standards. The State Fire Marshal has notified fire code enforcement agencies throughout the state of Nevada of our intention to adopt a new fire code. No comments were received by the Division for review. The new regulations are strictly administrative in nature and no increase fees for services as listed in NRS 477.030 will be pursued.


LCB file No. R205-24 does not duplicate any existing federal, state or local standards regulating the same activity.
