A REGULATION relating to education; specifying that certain records relating to the suspension or revocation of the license of a teacher, administrator or other licensed educational personnel are public records; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest

Under existing law, the State Board of Education is authorized in certain circumstances to suspend or revoke the license of a teacher, school administrator or other person who is licensed to work in a public school. (NRS 391.320, 391.330) This regulation provides that certain records are public records, including any: (1) recommendation submitted to the State Board for the suspension or revocation of a license; (2) document submitted in support of such a recommendation; and (3) document, record or information considered by the State Board in determining whether to suspend or revoke a license. (See NRS 239.010)

Section 1. Chapter 391 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

Except as otherwise provided by law, each of the following is a public record and must be open for inspection pursuant to NRS 239.010:

- 1. Any recommendation submitted to the Board pursuant to NRS 391.322 for the suspension or revocation of a license issued pursuant to chapter 391 of NRS.
 - 2. Any document submitted in support of a recommendation described in subsection 1.
