SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT STATEMENT AS REQUIRED BY NRS 233B.0608

Pursuant to NRS 233B.0608(1), the Division of Parole and Probation is required to make a determination whether its proposed regulations will: a) imposed a direct and significant economic burden on small business, and (b) directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of small business. NRS 233B.0382 defines a small business to be any business that employs 150 or fewer employees.
