Proposed Amendment to Assembly Bill No. 317

Amend subsection 2 of section 1 of the bill to read as follows:

“2. The tax imposed pursuant to subsection 1 must be collected for live entertainment provided by any house of prostitution. The amount taxed for such live entertainment must be based on the sum of any amount of money paid by the patron to the house of prostitution for:

- (a) Admission to an area of the house of prostitution where live entertainment occurs; and***
- (b) Any food, beverages and merchandise provided to the patron while in any area of the house of prostitution.”***

Amend the effective date in section 2 of the bill to read as follows:

Sec. 2. This bill becomes effective on January 1, 2006.
