AN ACT relating to recycling; requiring the Division of
Environmental Protection of the State Department of
Conservation and Natural Resources to conduct a study
concerning programs for reusing and recycling computers
and other electronics; and providing other matters
properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill requires the Division of Environmental Protection of the State
2 Department of Conservation and Natural Resources to conduct a study concerning
3 programs for reusing and recycling computers and other electronics. The study
4 must include an inventory of any programs for donating or recycling computers and
5 other electronics in this State and surrounding states and an evaluation of those
6 programs. This bill also requires the Administrator of the Division to submit a
7 report setting forth the results of the study and at least one recommendation for
8 legislation to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the
9 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature.
