[A.B. 164](#) (R1) Revises certain provisions concerning the crime of battery. (BDR 15-251)

[A.B. 187](#) Authorizes the establishment by district courts of a program for the treatment of certain offenders who are veterans or members of the military. (BDR 14-955)
