PURPOSE

Why is the status of Nevada Criminal Justice Information System (NCJIS) Mod important to other Agencies?

The FBI requires each state to have a Central Repository/CJIS Systems Agency to manage access to the FBI systems to ensure compliance. Hence requiring all agencies to utilize NCJIS.

With that responsibility, DPS – RCCD gets to set the statewide policies to ensure State of Nevada is in compliance with FBI as well as other agencies get the information they need.

It is important for DPS – RCCD to ensure the system is kept up-to-date with the latest technology to avoid security risks and downtime.




NCJIS Mod – Planned Chart (SFYs 2014 - 2021)

2018 – 2019 Biennium – Revised Plan

- Replace JLink and Hot Files with a COTS product.
 - Sent the RFI out and received the responses.
 - Re-engage MTG Management Consultants, LLC.
 - Engage Norsoft Consulting to assist with winding down JLink.
- Continue with application re-engineering for
 - Accounts Receivable
 - Protection Order Program application (projected May 2018 deployment)
 - USoft Carry Concealed Weapons (CCW) application (Recently been decided to provide this functionality while implementing CCH Part 2)
- Focus EITS on maintaining RCCD's existing systems while simultaneously completing the following important projects:
 - Finish remaining JLink Upgrade defects (maintenance)
 - Finish CCH Part 1 (projected April 2018 deployment)
 - Begin/Finish CCH Part 2
 - Begin/Finish Oracle Upgrade from 11g to 12c
 - Finish Protection Order Program application
 - Finish Store and Forward
 - Rap Back for State Department of Health & Human Services (per SB 502 from 2013)
 - Sex Offender Registry Tool (SORT) Part 2
 - Finish Sex Offender Registry Scanner
 - Spillman server upgrade
 - Spillman disaster recovery solution
 - Nevada Offense Code table upgrade

2020 – 2021 Biennium – Proposed Plan

- Continue New Message Switch implementation, Hot Files and data migration.
- Move forward with Civil Requests, Portal, and Document Management solutions. (MTG Initiative 3, Projects 3.11 and 3.14 and Initiative 6. Originally planned for 18/19 biennium)

- Possible State Warrants File replacement
- Local user requests
- Legislative mandates
- Application and Environment refresh
- NCJIS Disaster Recovery Capability
