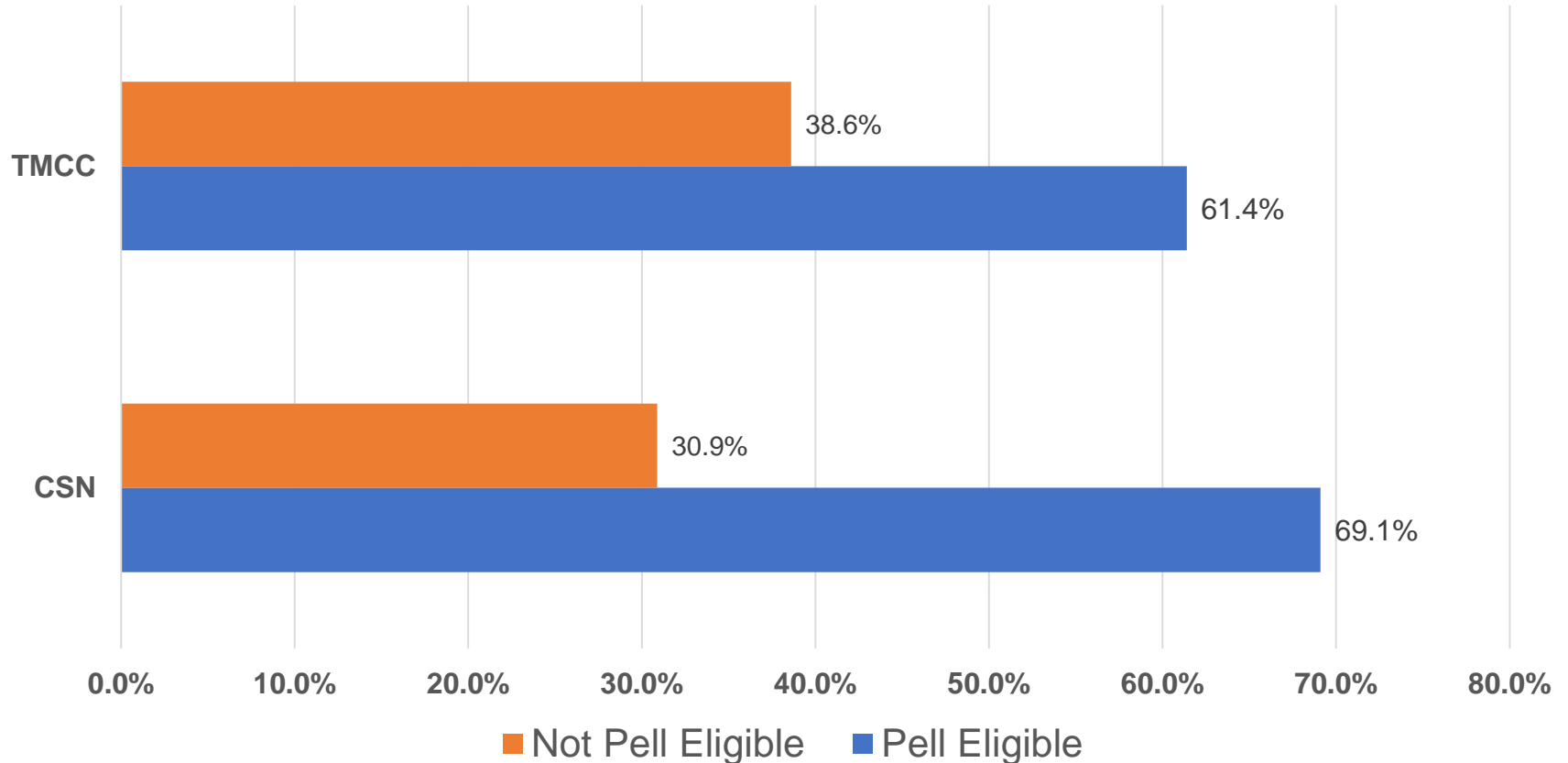

*Based on 1,489 students at CSN, and 430 students at TMCC that have completed a FAFSA as of 1/25/2018 and received an EFC from the US Department of Education. More complete data will be available in April after the FAFSA deadline has passed and data can be collected from all four colleges on all eligible NPS students.

Next Steps

Students:

- Apply for admission to their college
- File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by April 1st
- Meet with mentor at least once
- Perform 20 hours of community service
- Register for 12 or more credits for the fall

Next Steps

Colleges:

- Ensure students are meeting with mentors
- Remind students of deadlines and other requirements
- Schedule second training for students
- Track deadlines and applicant progress
- Package financial aid awards to determine unmet need
