
About SHEEO

- Recognize that state context matters






Public FTE Enrollment and Educational Appropriations Per FTE, US, FY 1992-2017





Net Tuition as a Percent of Public Higher Education Total Educational Revenue, US, FY 1992-2017






Public FTE Enrollment and Educational Appropriations Per FTE, Nevada, FY 1992-2017







Net Tuition as a Percent of Public Higher Education Total Educational Revenue, Nevada, FY 1992-2017




Public Higher Education Educational Appropriations Per FTE: Percent Change, FY 2008-2017






Public Higher Education Net Tuition Revenue Per FTE: Percent Change, FY 2008-2017






Total Educational Revenue Per FTE: Percent Change, FY 2012-2017







Percent of Tax Revenues Allocated to Higher Education by State, FY 2015






Higher Education Support Per \$1,000 of Personal Income By State, FY 2016
