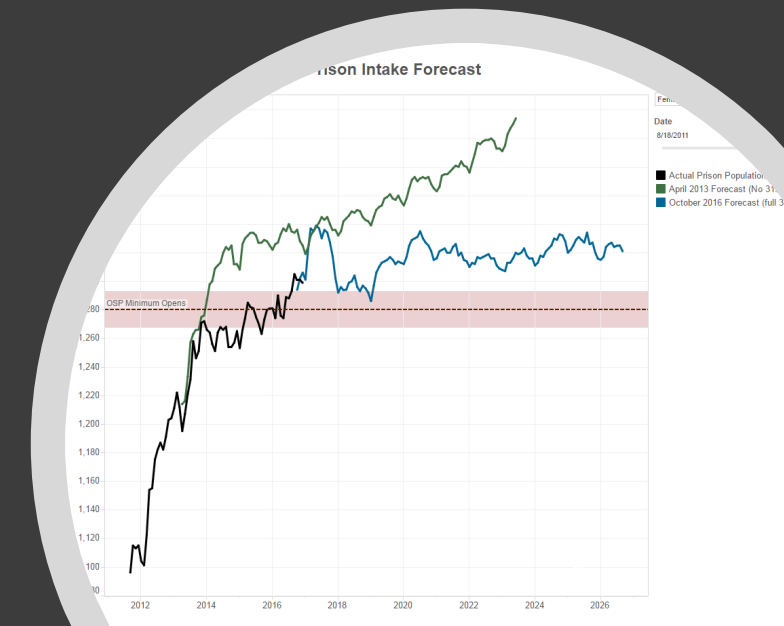
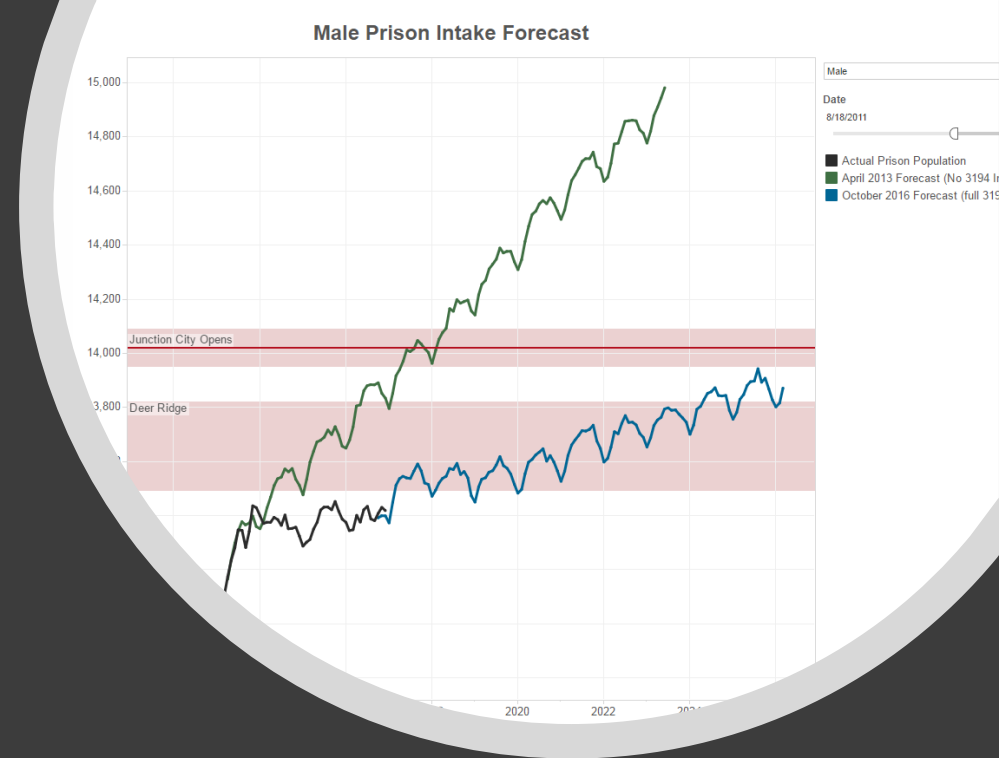
# Oregon's Justice Reinvestment Program

# Road to Justice Reinvestment:

*Between 2000 and 2010, Oregon's prison rate increased by nearly 50% growing to 14,000 inmates with a total biennial corrections budget over \$1.4 billion and the need to build and open an additional prison facility by 2017.*

# HB 3194 (2013) The Justice Reinvestment Act

HB 3194 stated goals:

- Reduce recidivism
- Reduce prison utilization
- Increase public safety
- Hold offenders accountable

Two Major components:

- Justice Reinvestment Grant Program
- Some modest sentencing reductions

## Grant Funding:

2013 – 15: \$15 million

---

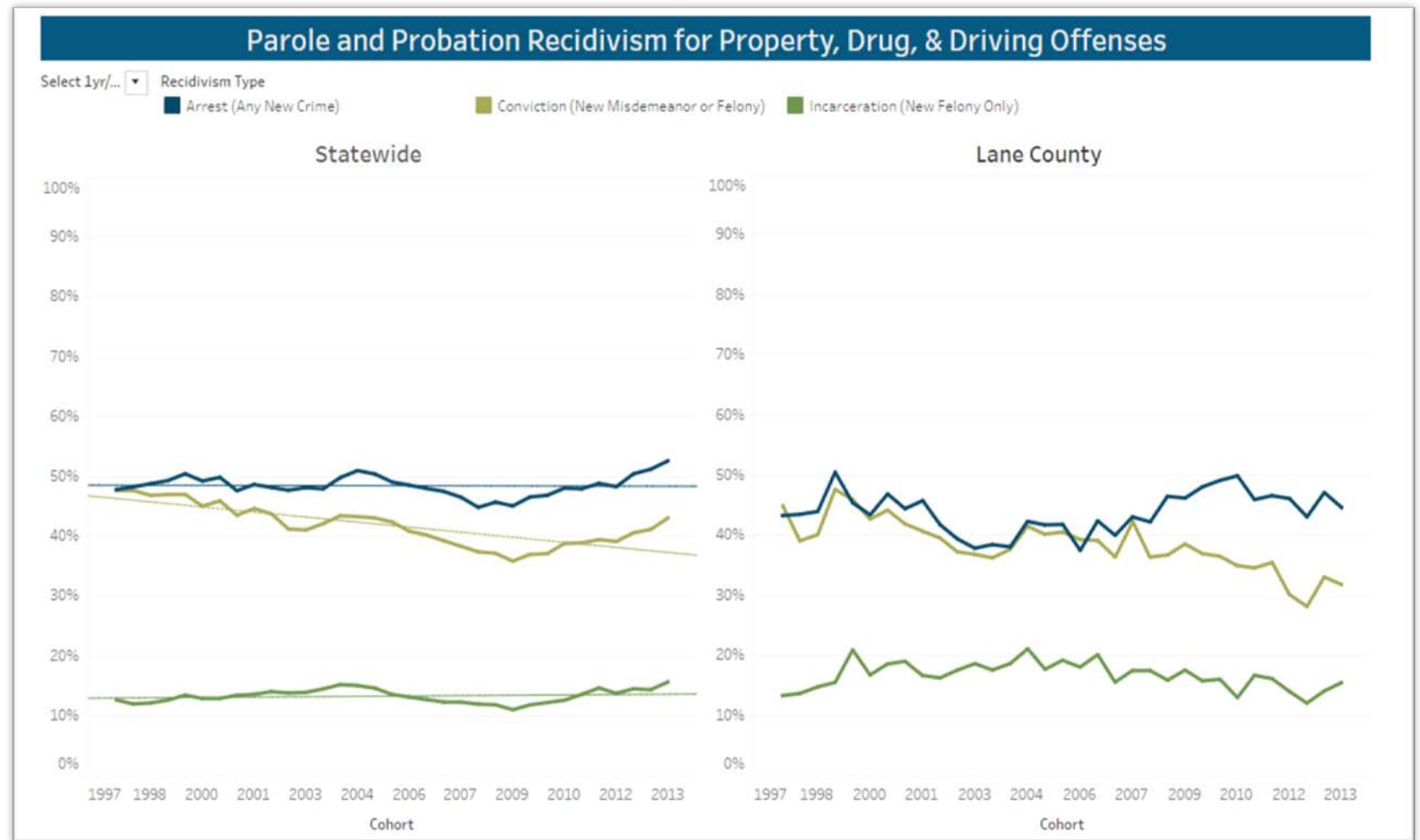
2015 – 17: \$38.7 million

2017 – 19: \$40.1 million

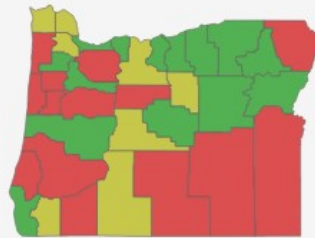

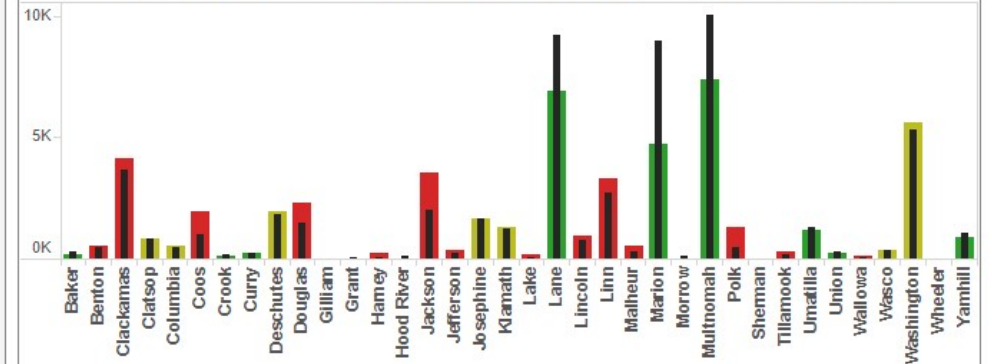

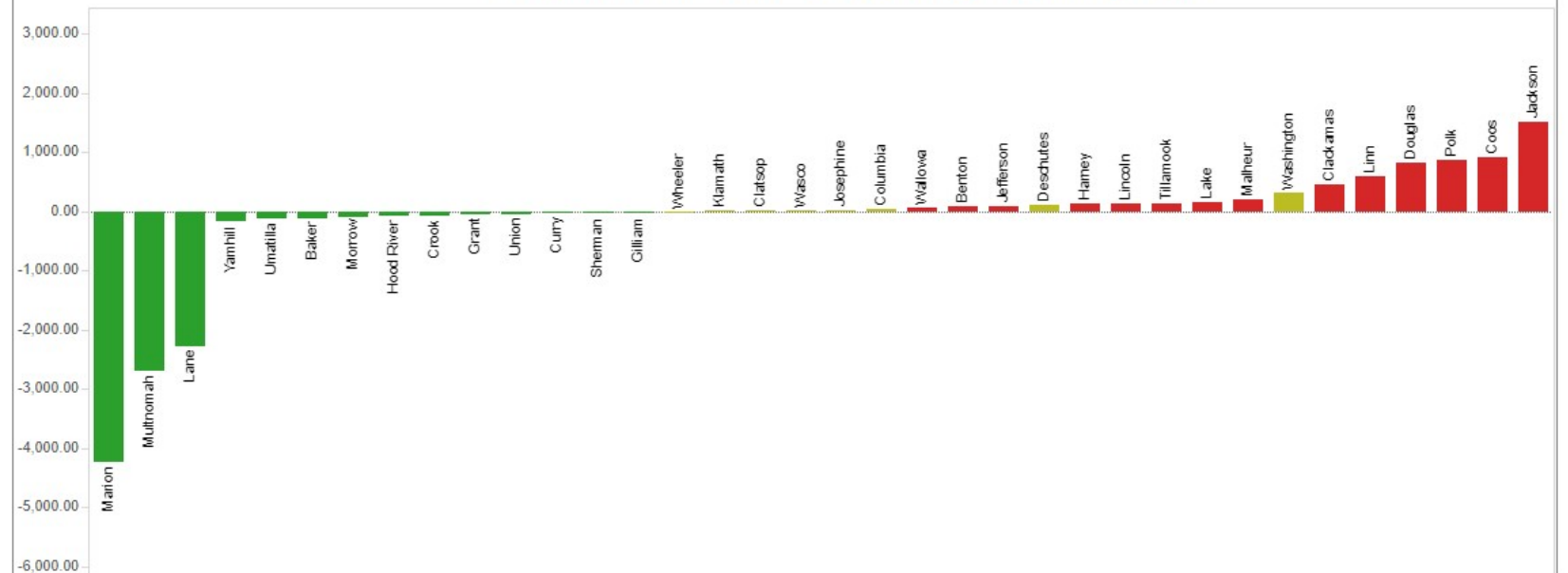


## January '17 - December '17 Compared to Baseline

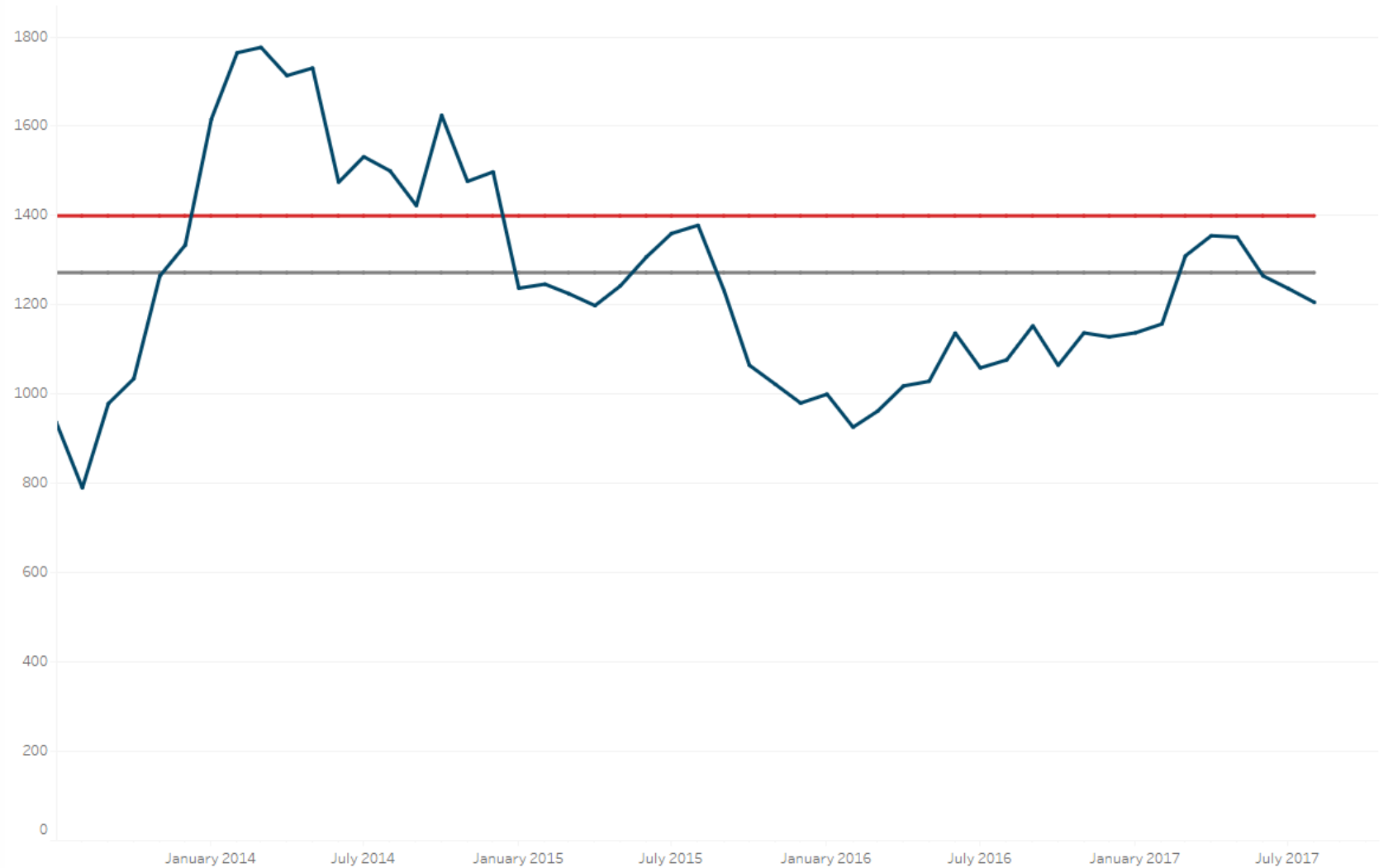

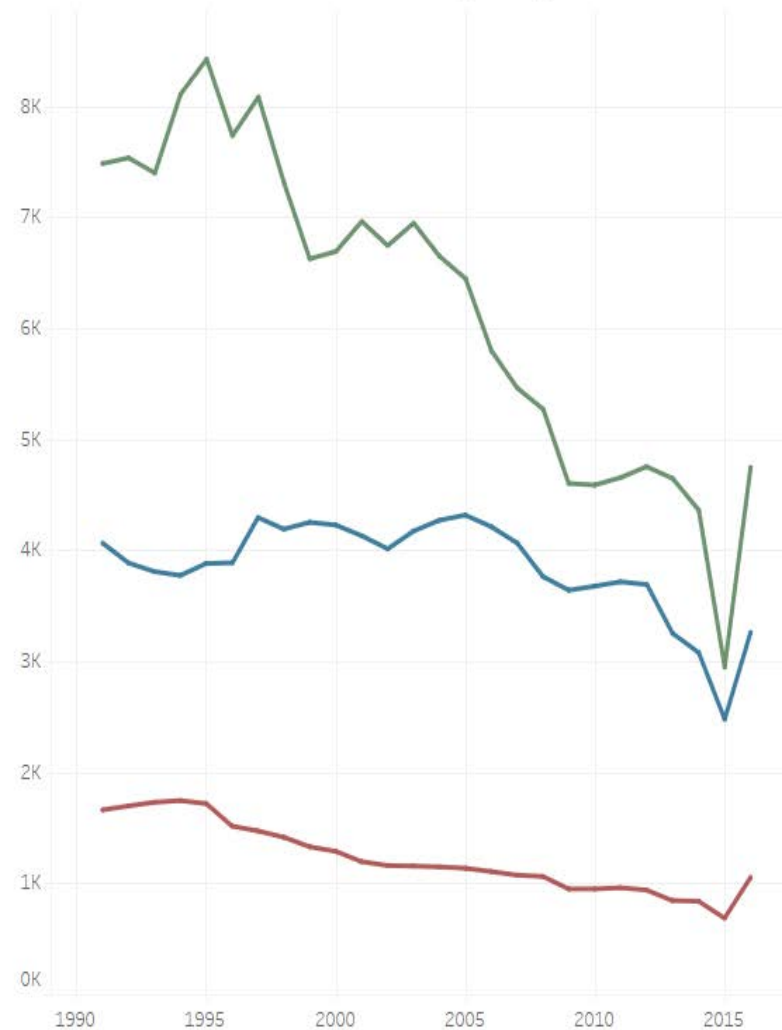

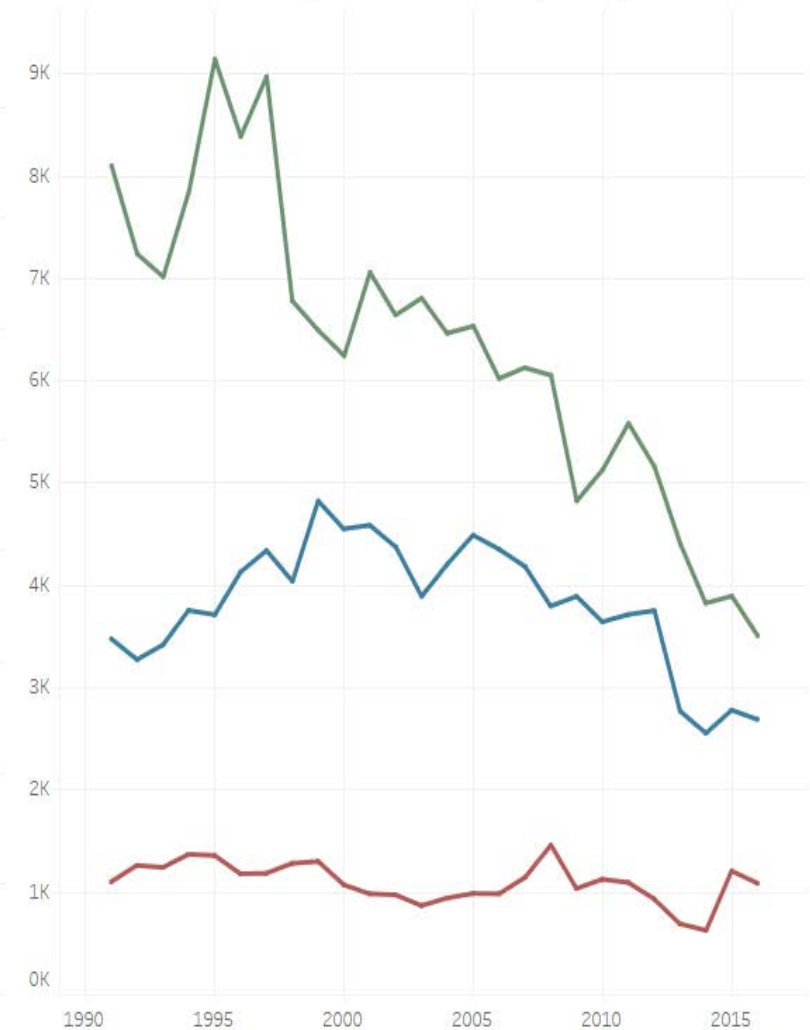

Deschutes County Rates -- 100% Reporting in 2015

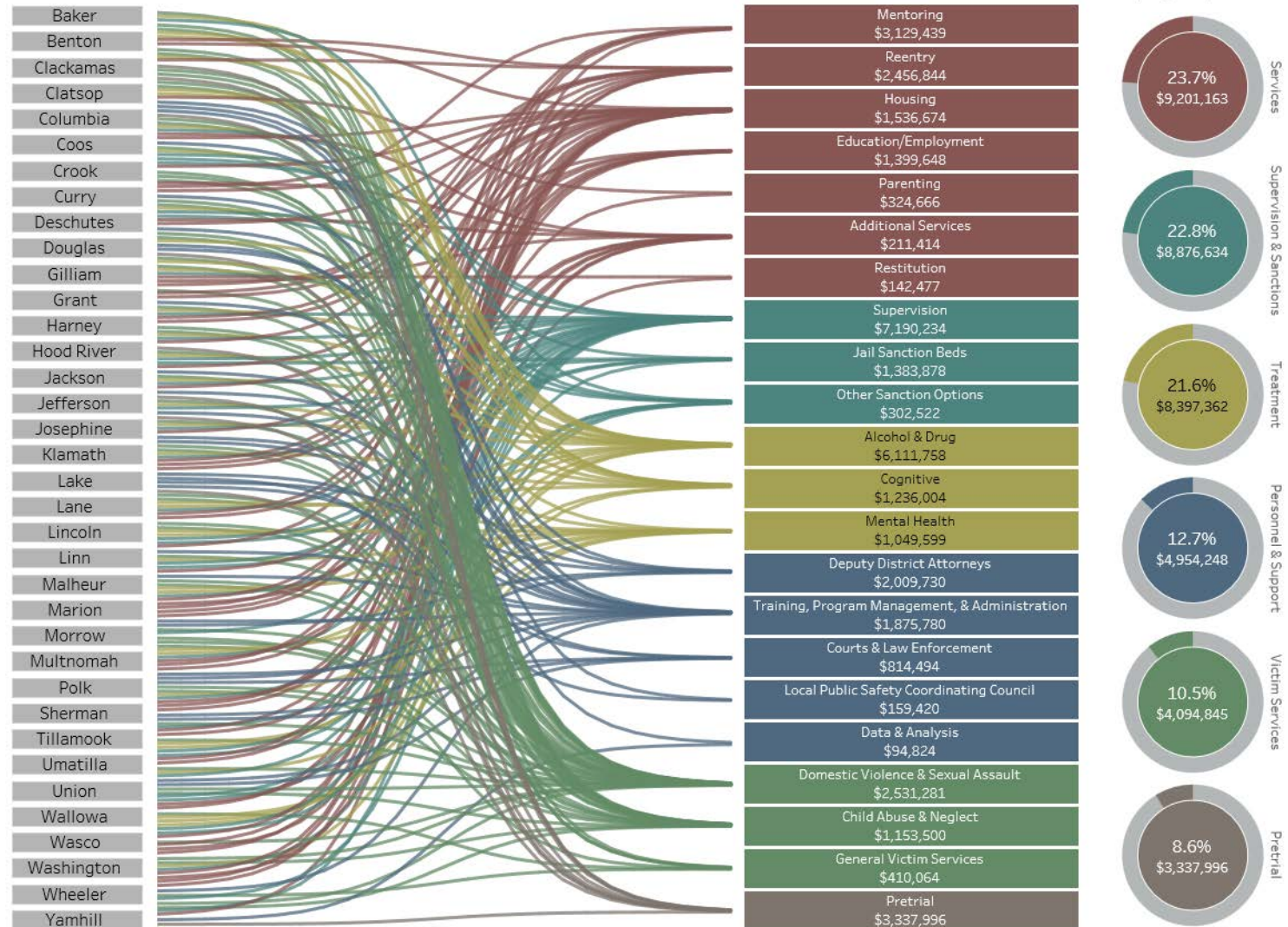




## Types of Programs

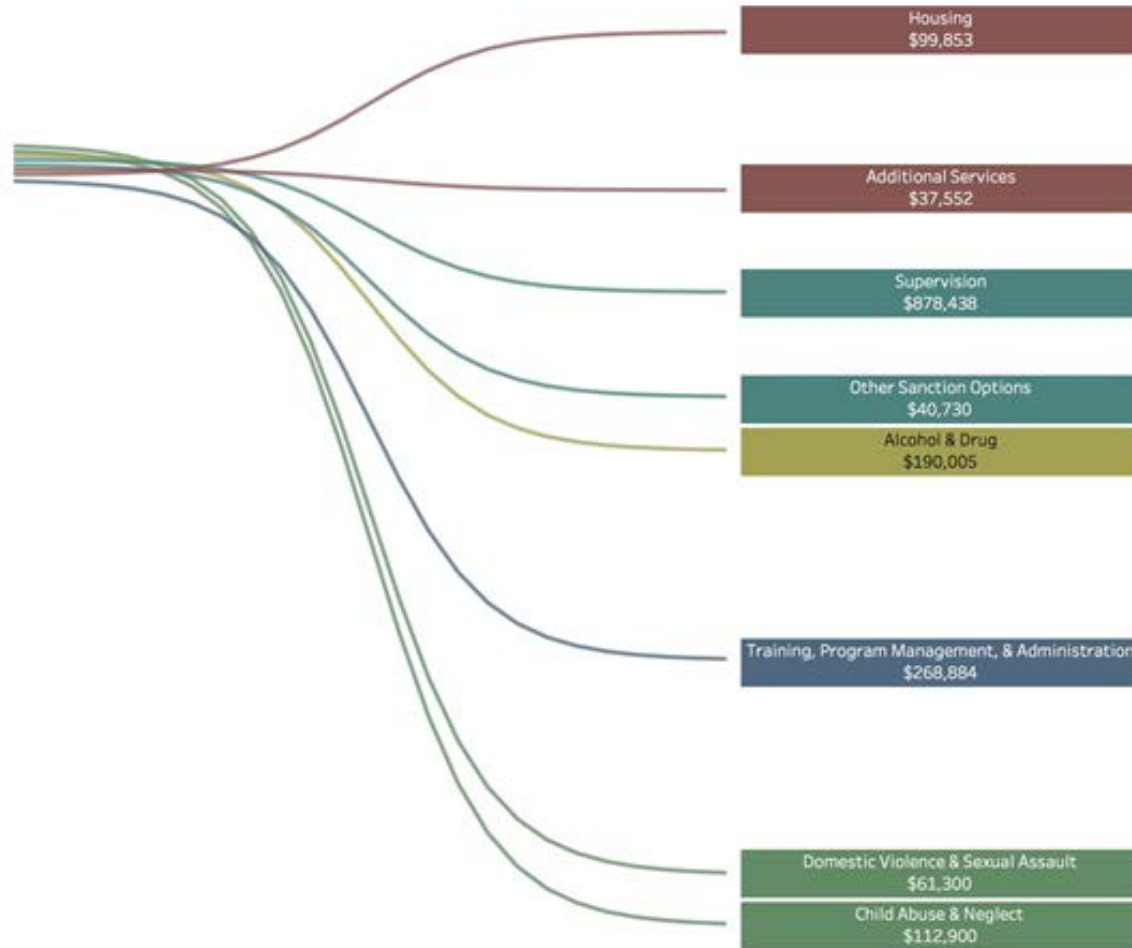

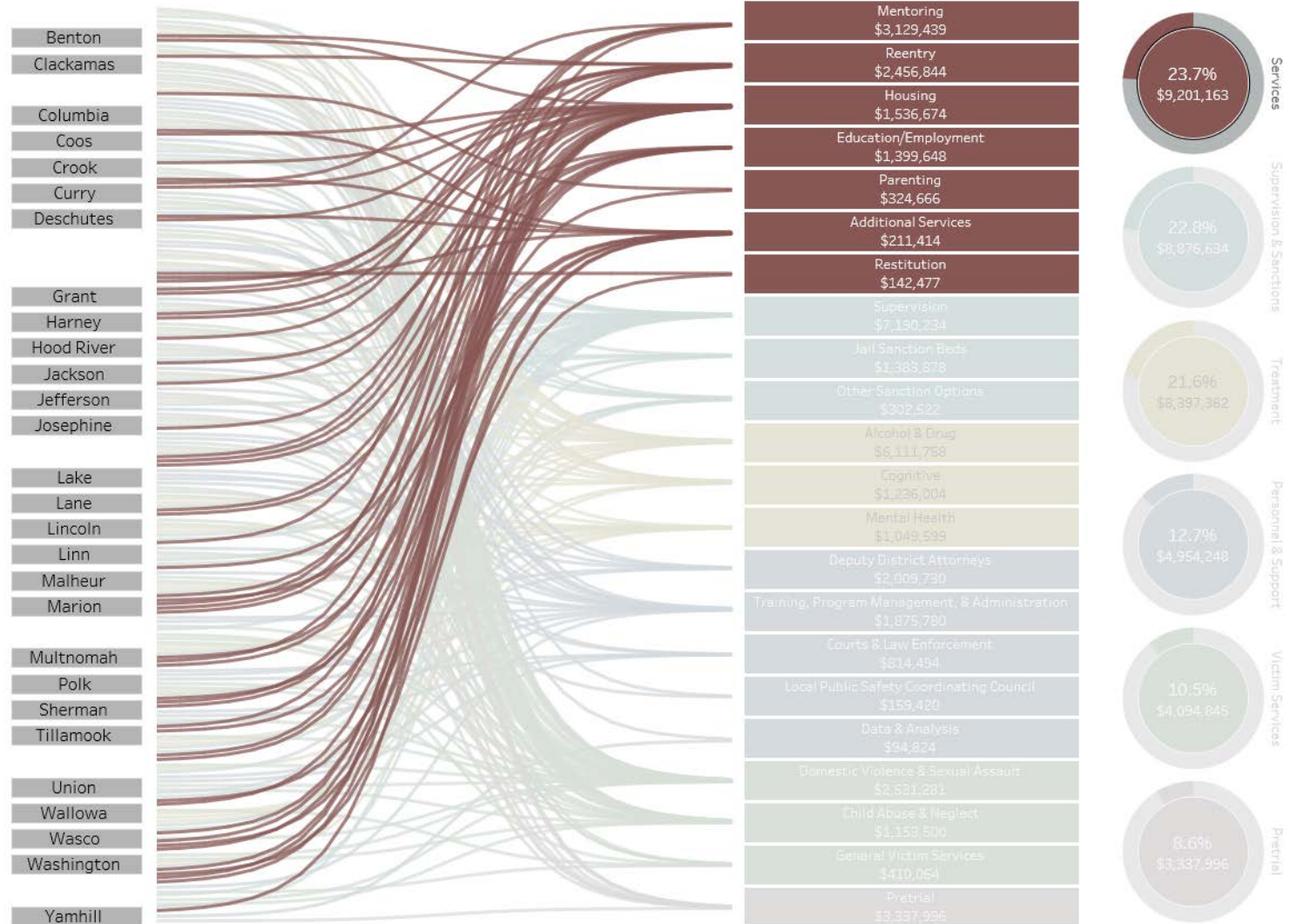

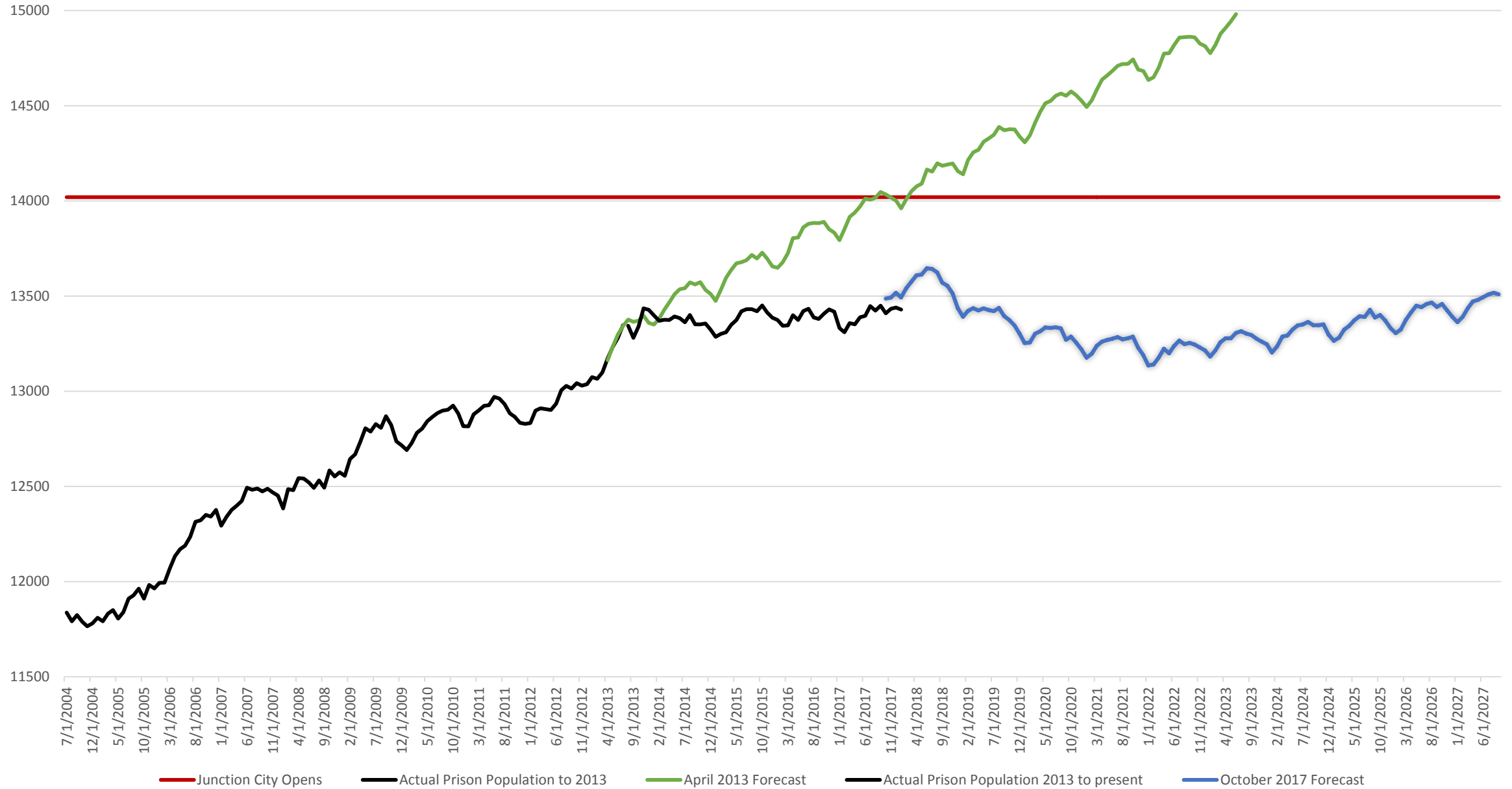




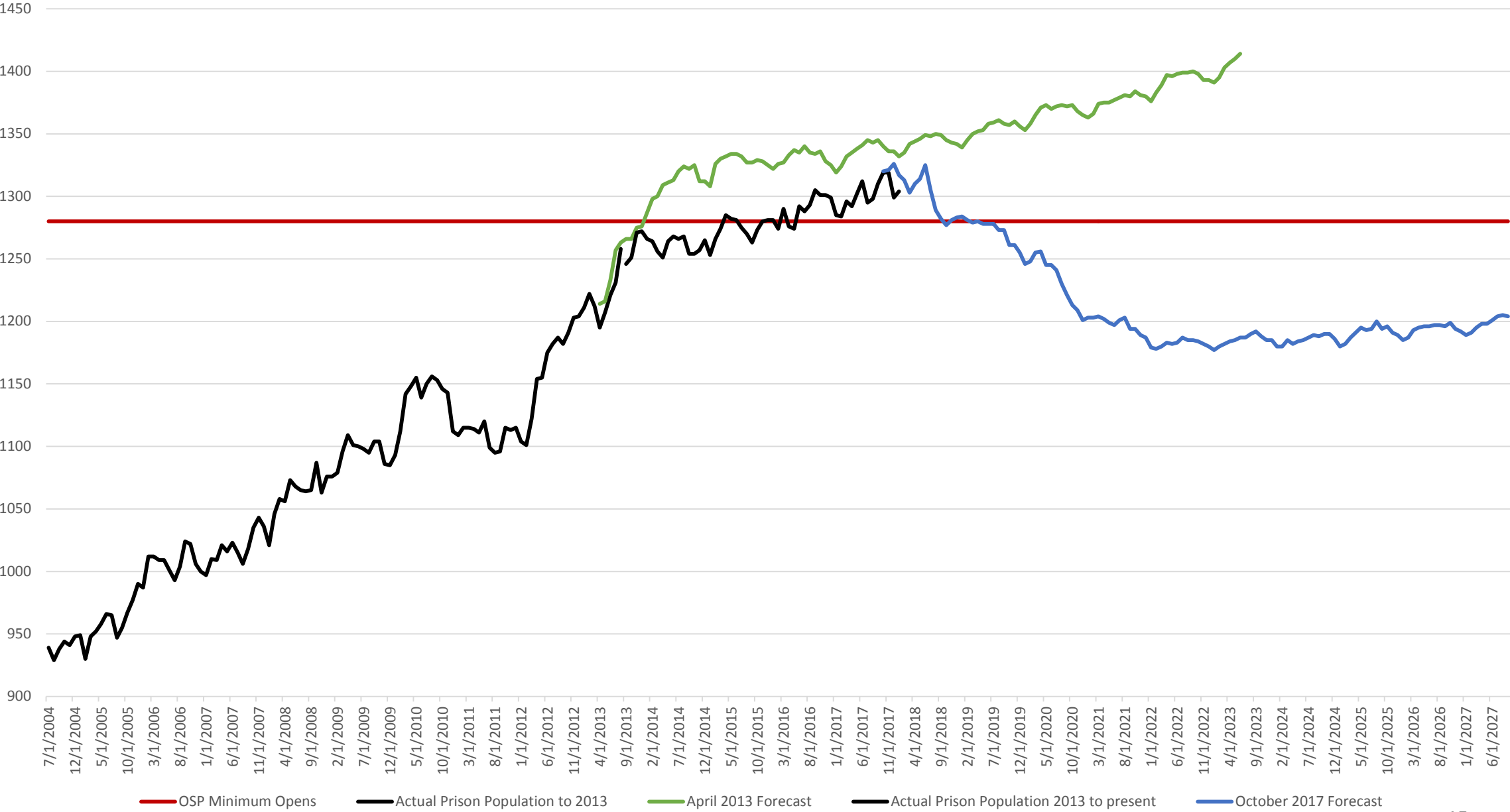
## What seems to work?

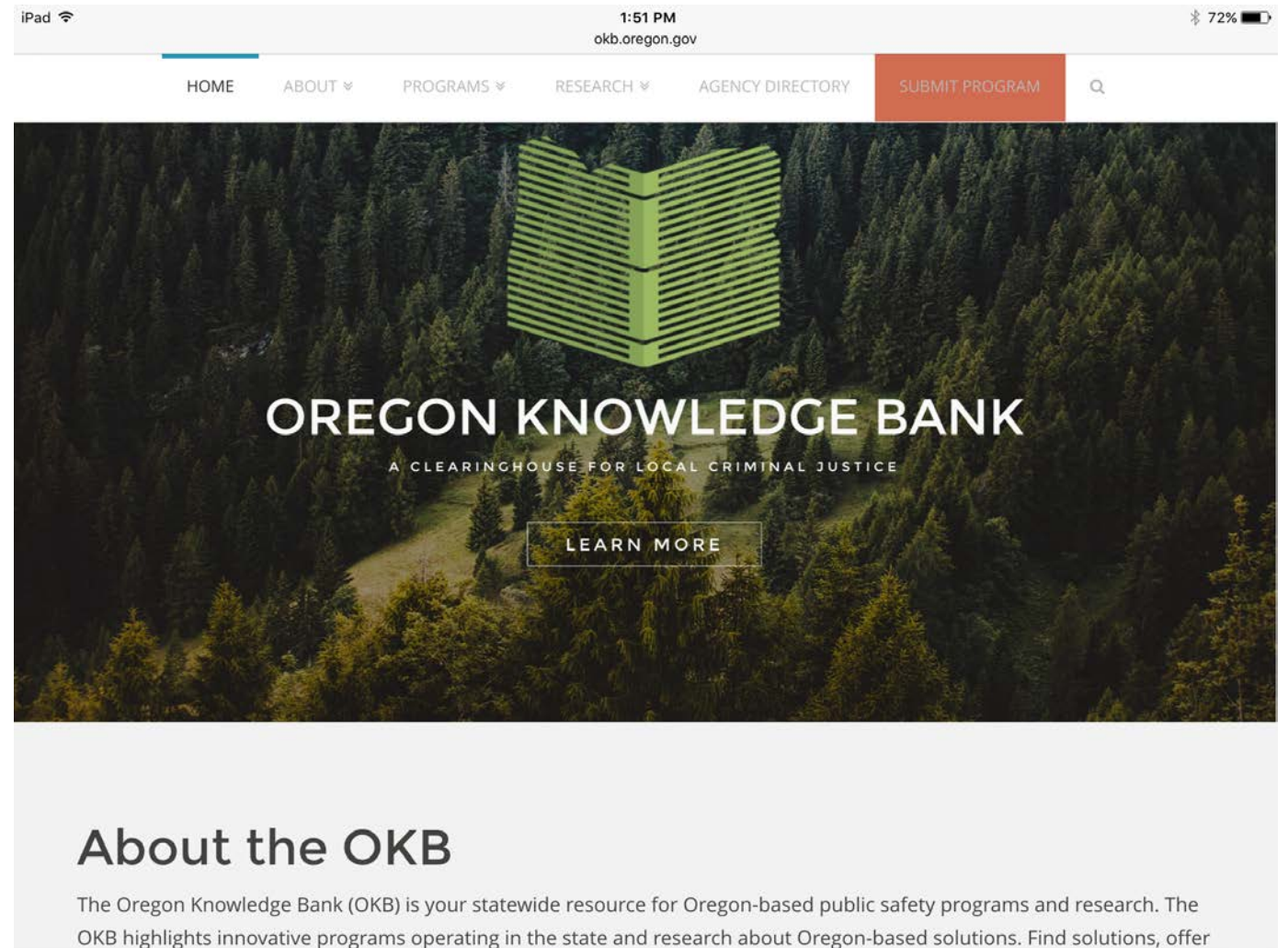
