

In response to questions asked of Marc Schifalacqua (Senior Assistant City Attorney, City of Henderson) at the March 3, 2020 meeting of the Committee, David Cherry (Government Affairs Manager, City of Henderson) provided the following information:

- How many persons are currently being held on bail for \$650 or less?

As of March 11, 2020, the current population of the Henderson Detention Center is 377 detainees. This figure includes individuals being detained by the City of Henderson and those who are being housed under contracts with multiple other agencies including U.S. Marshals Service, Boulder City Police Department, Moapa Tribal Police and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Here is the breakdown of the Henderson Detention Center population for the specified date:

- City of Henderson = 225
- U.S. Marshals = 4
- Boulder City Police Department = 5
- Moapa Tribal Police = 0
- ICE = 143
- Of the 225 City of Henderson inmates, 67 have a bail amount (\*\*please note: remaining inmates are either sentenced or are being held without bail).
- Of the 67 bailable inmates, the breakdown is as follows:
  - Highest bail amount = \$250,000
  - Second highest bail amount = four inmates being held on \$150,000 bail
  - Average bail amount = \$16,142
- Of the 67 bailable inmates, 51 have a bail amount of \$5,000 or less

As of March 4, 2020, the population of the Henderson Detention Center was 381. This figure included individuals being detained by the City of Henderson and those who were being housed under contracts with multiple other agencies including U.S. Marshals Service, Boulder City Police Department, Moapa Tribal Police and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). Here is the breakdown of the Henderson Detention Center population for the specified date:

- City of Henderson = 211
- U.S. Marshals = 4
- Boulder City Police Department = 3
- Moapa Tribal Police = 3
- ICE = 160
- Of the 211 City of Henderson inmates, 59 had a bail amount (\*\*please note: remaining inmates are either sentenced or are being held without bail).
- Of the 59 bailable inmates, the breakdown was as follows:
  - Highest bail amount = \$79,530
  - Second highest bail amount = \$77,200
  - Average bail amount = \$6,160
- Of the 59 bailable inmates, 49 had a bail amount of \$5,000 or less
