

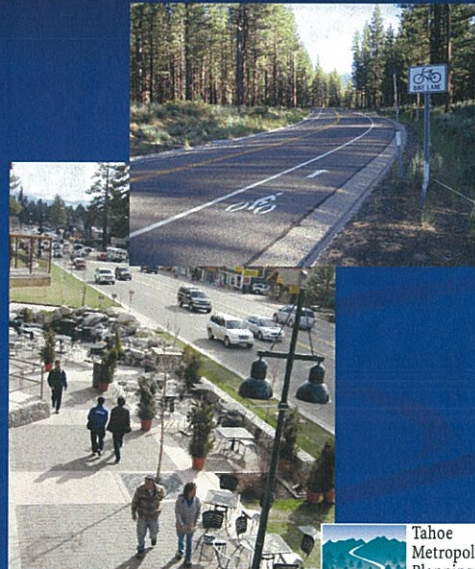
TRANSPORTATION ACTIVITIES AT LAKE TAHOE

- Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organization (TMPO) formed in 1999 to recognize the influx of visitors (300,000 people on peak days) and their impact on the transportation system.
- TMPO is responsible for regional transportation planning and funding allocation based on the regional transportation plan
- TMPO's Federal Transportation Improvement Program contains over \$500M of funded transportation projects to be carried out in the next 5 Years

“An innovative multimodal transportation system is in place that gives priority to viable alternatives to the private automobile, appeals to users and serves mobility needs, while improving the environmental and socioeconomic health of the Basin.”

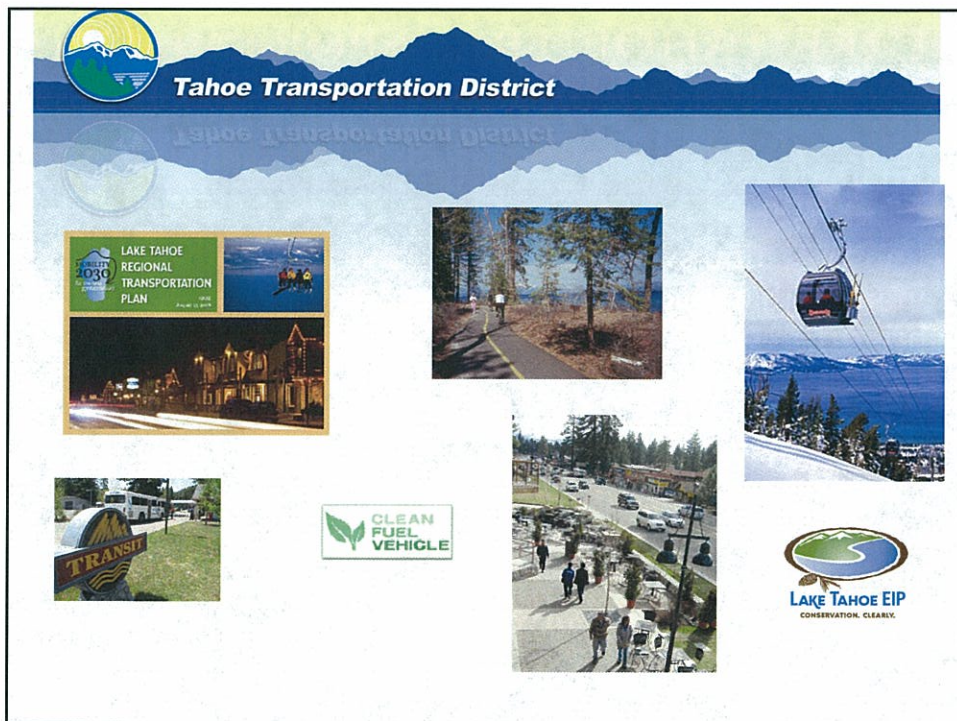

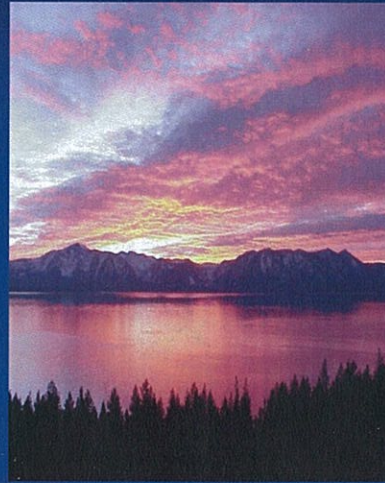

PUBLIC LAW 96-551 THE BI-STATE COMPACT

- The bi-state Tahoe Regional Planning Compact of 1980 required the adoption of environmental threshold standards and created the Tahoe Transportation District (TTD)
- Compact Article IX which created the TTD gave it the authority to own and operate transportation services and facilities, or implement what is needed to meet Compact policy



THE BI-STATE COMPACT

- Unlike other Articles of the Compact Congress authorized the two States the ability to amend Article IX for the TTD as long as they are congruent bills. This was last done in 1997 (SB 24) which changed the TTD Board of Directors mix and added private sector representation (NRS 277.200) .

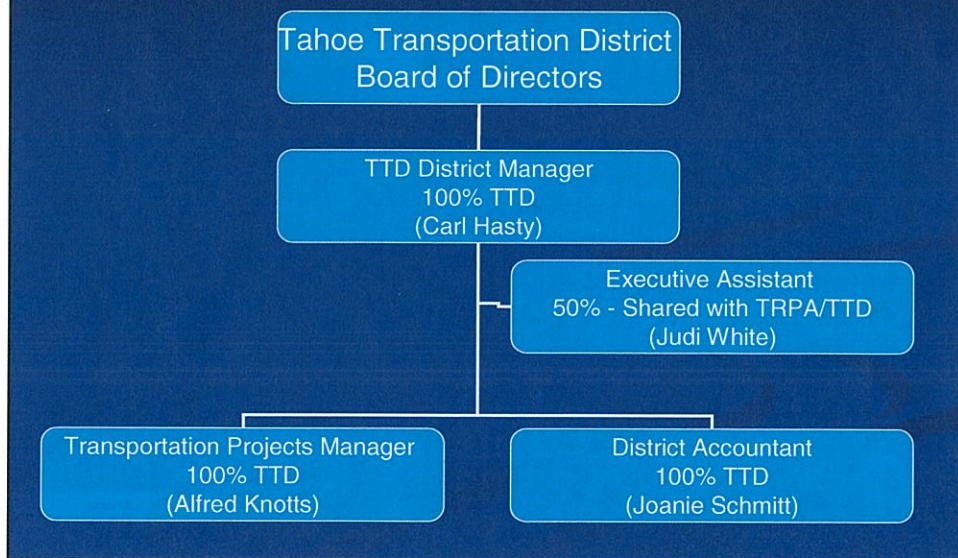


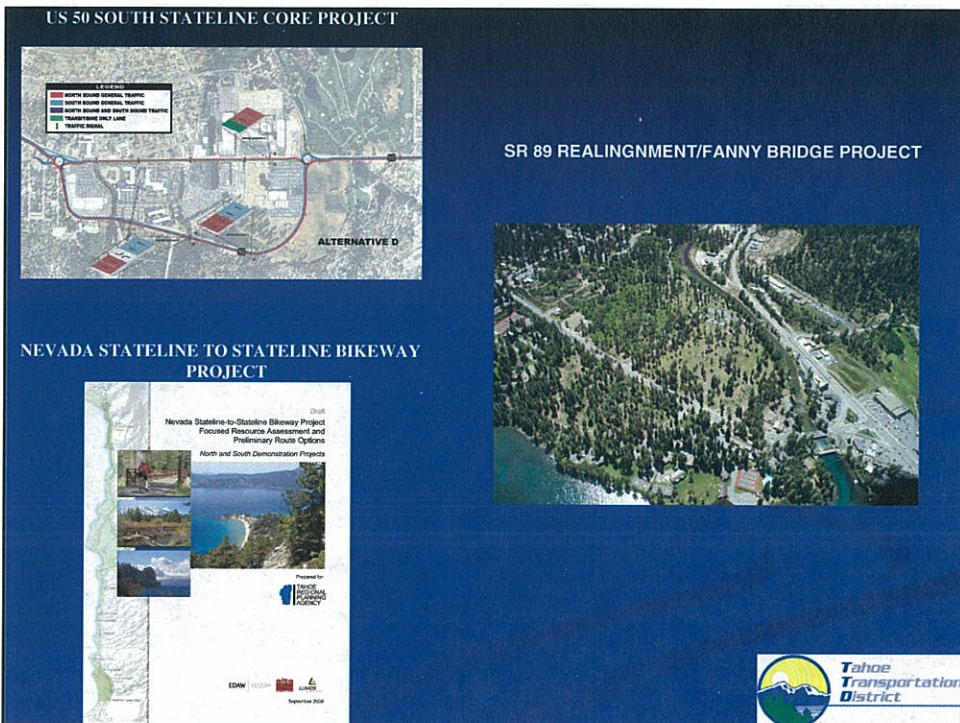
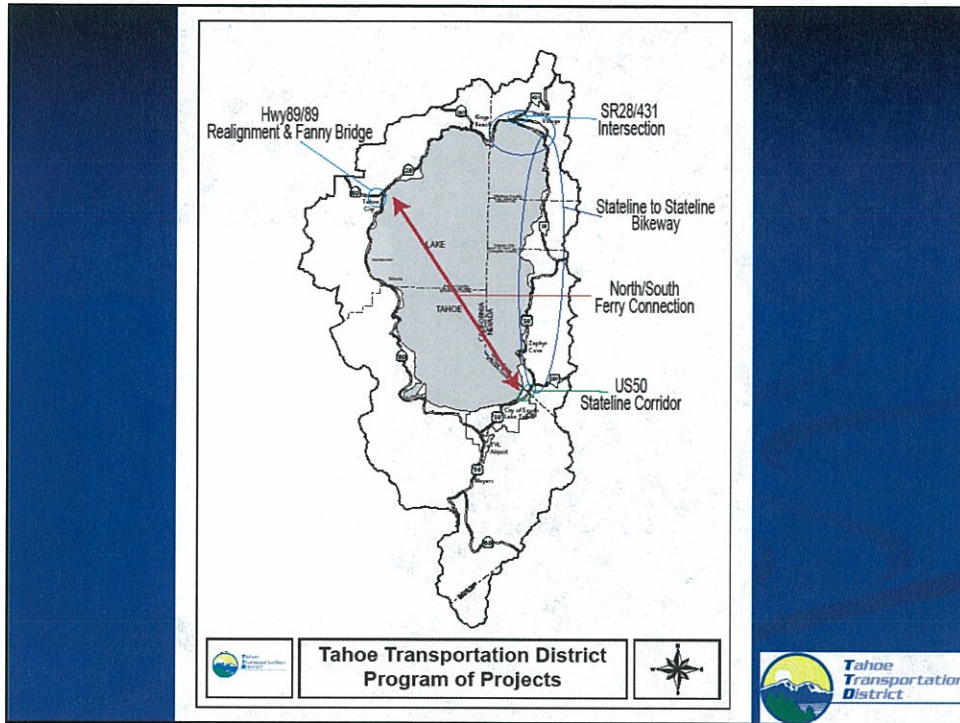

SR 431/28 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



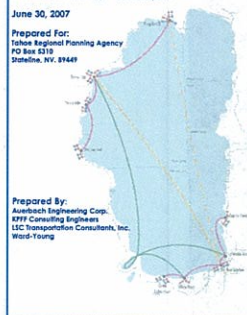
