Nevada's Challenges

Nevada is the only state still deep in the recession

- 185,000 residents actively seeking employment
- 1 in every 95 Nevada homes has been foreclosed
- Nevada had the highest increase in SNAP (food stamp) applications in 2009 – a 51.7% increase, nearly 30% higher than the national average
- Nevada had the largest increase (4%) in the nation in Food Insecurity between 2006 – 2008



A Vision for Nevada

Closing the Gap on Hunger in Nevada 2010-2012

Goal 1: Increase participation in school breakfast from 37% to 60% of free and reduced eligible children eating lunch

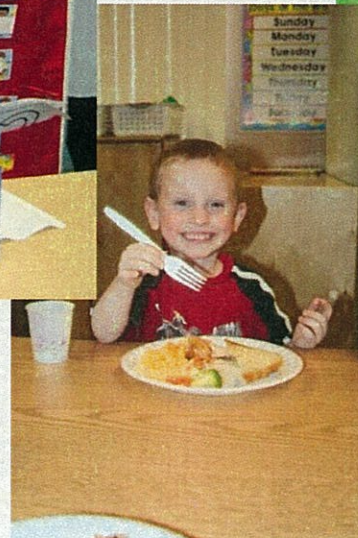
Goal 2: Enroll 72,000 additional eligible households in the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program in the next two years



Nevada's Federal Share

Increase participation in school breakfast to 60% of students participating in free or reduced lunch

▪ \$5,649,158 in new federal dollars to Nevada



Nevada's Federal Share

Enroll 3,000 new eligible households in SNAP per month for 24 months

- \$180,000,000 in new federal dollars to Nevada
