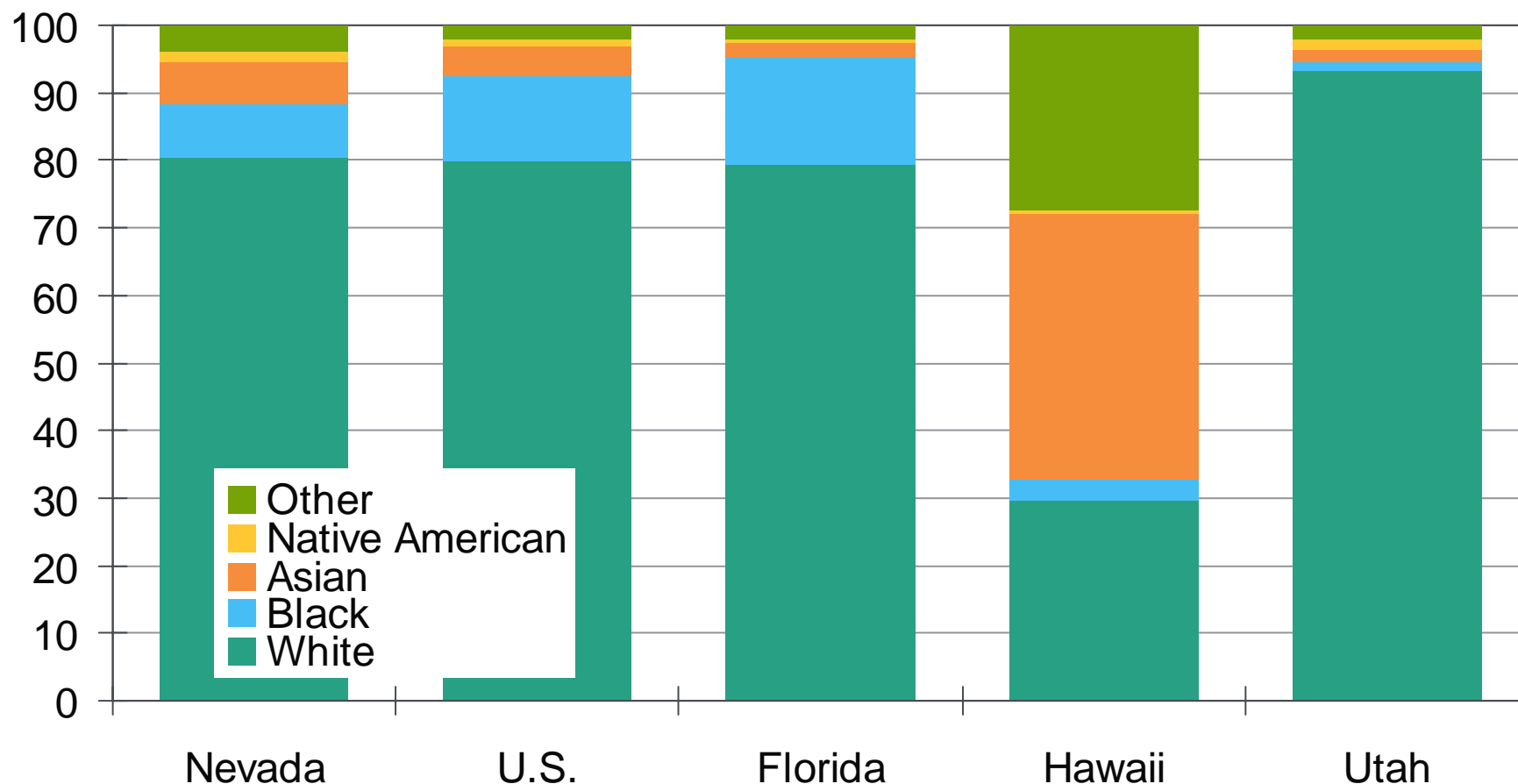

Nevada's Share of Minorities Close to Average

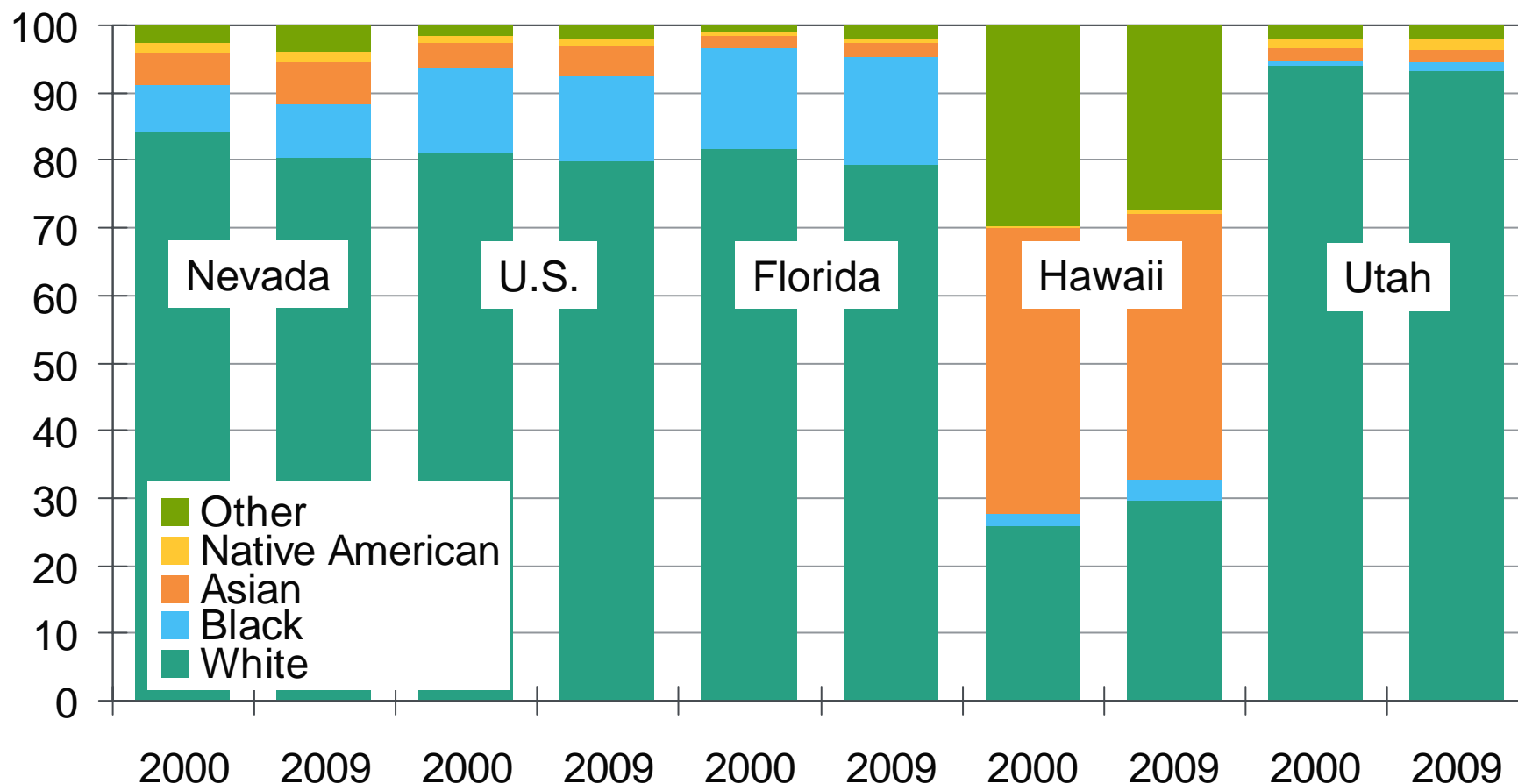
% of total population

Nevada's Share of Minorities Expanding

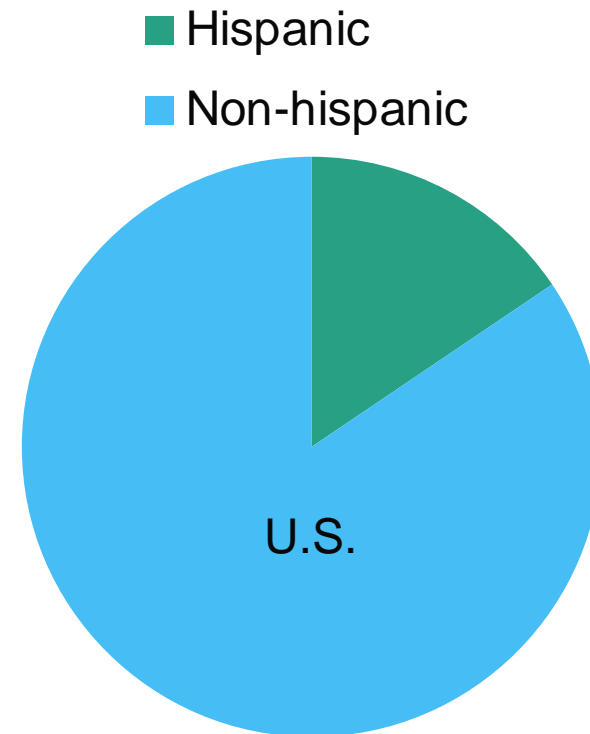
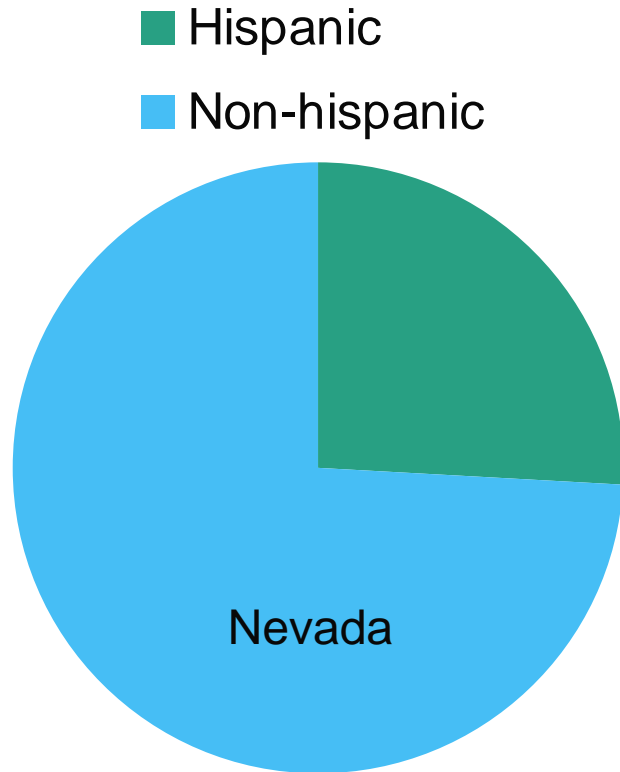

% of total

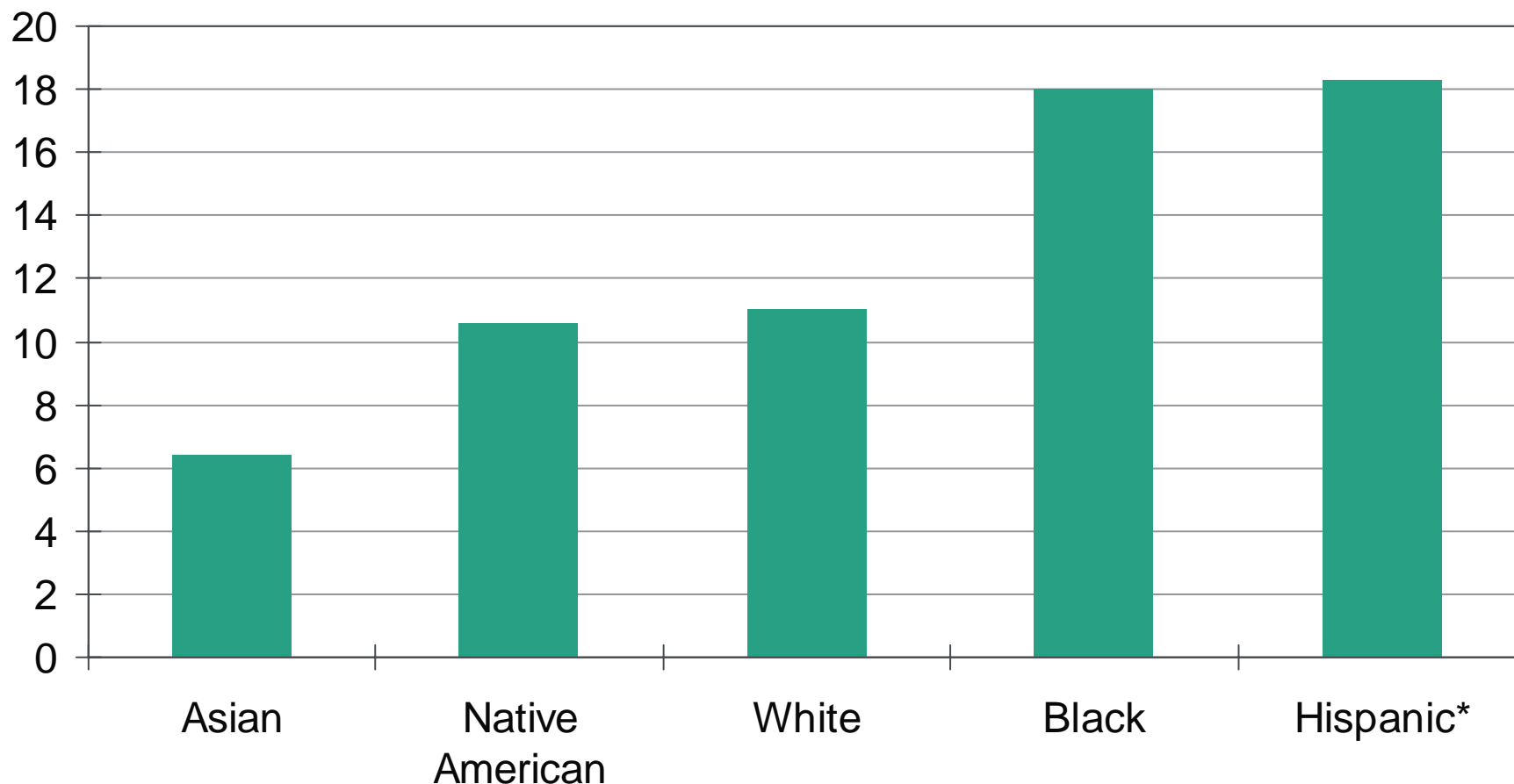

% in poverty

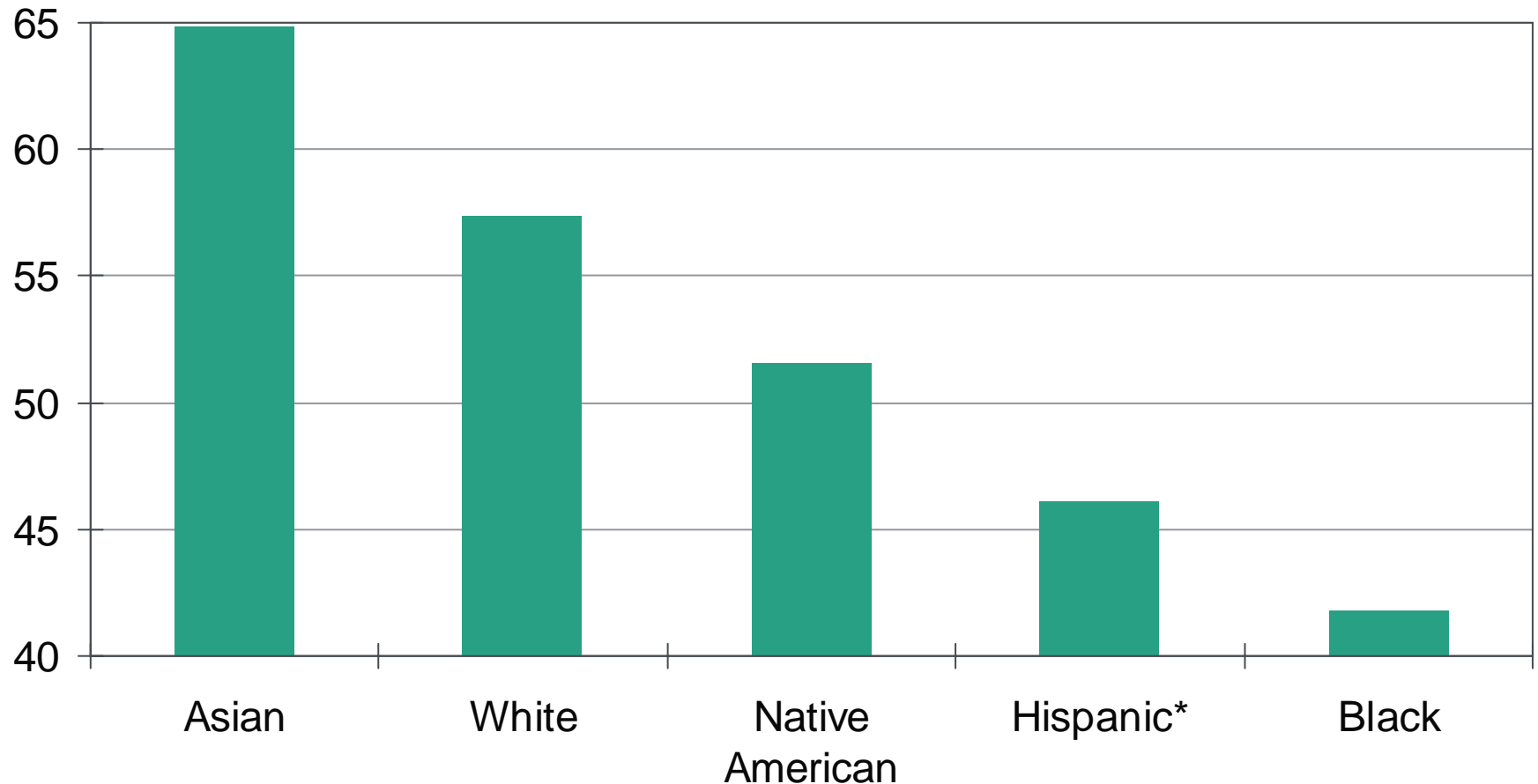

Median household income, by race/ethnicity of householder



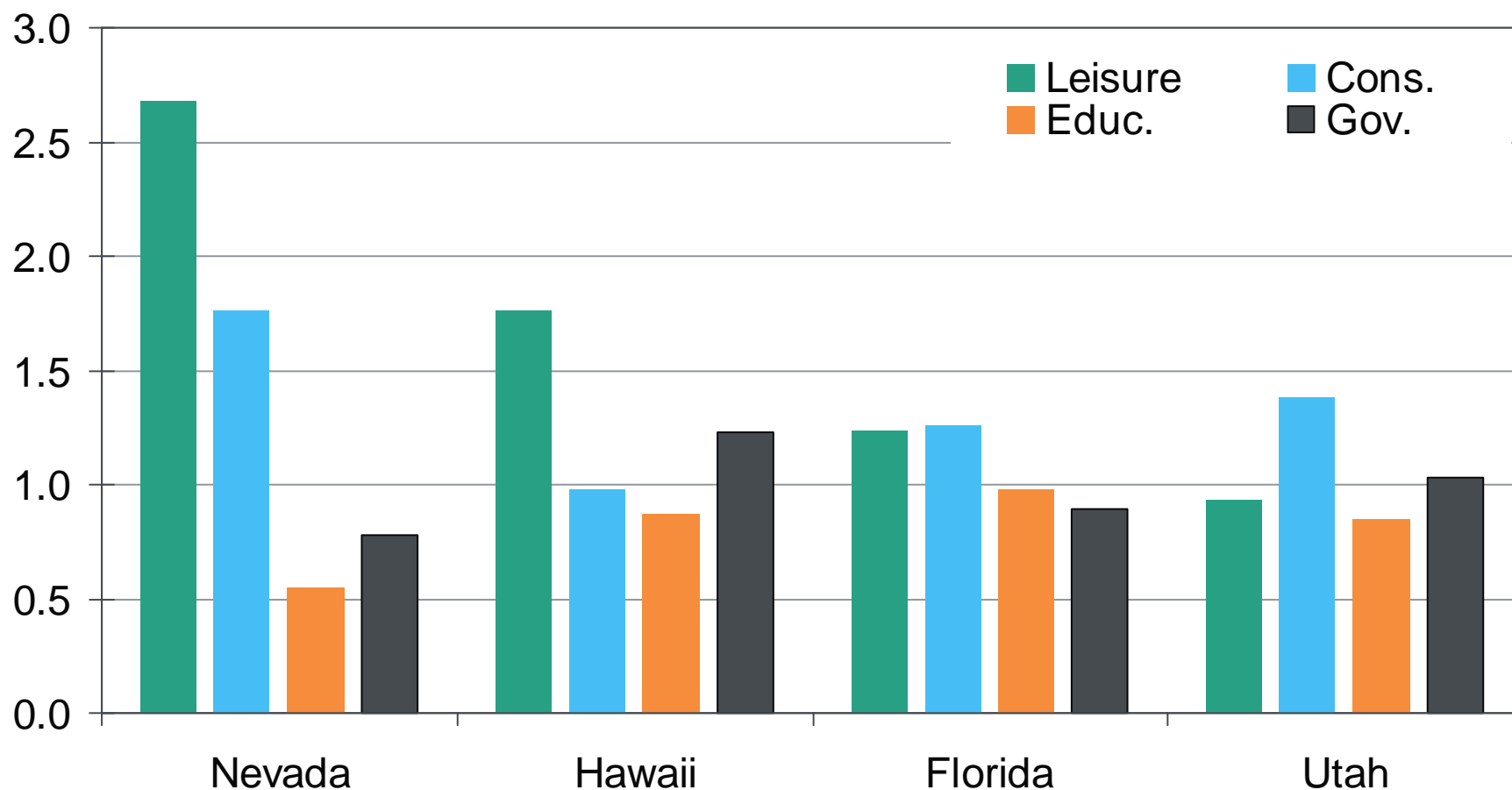

Nevada Lacks Stabilizing Economic Structure

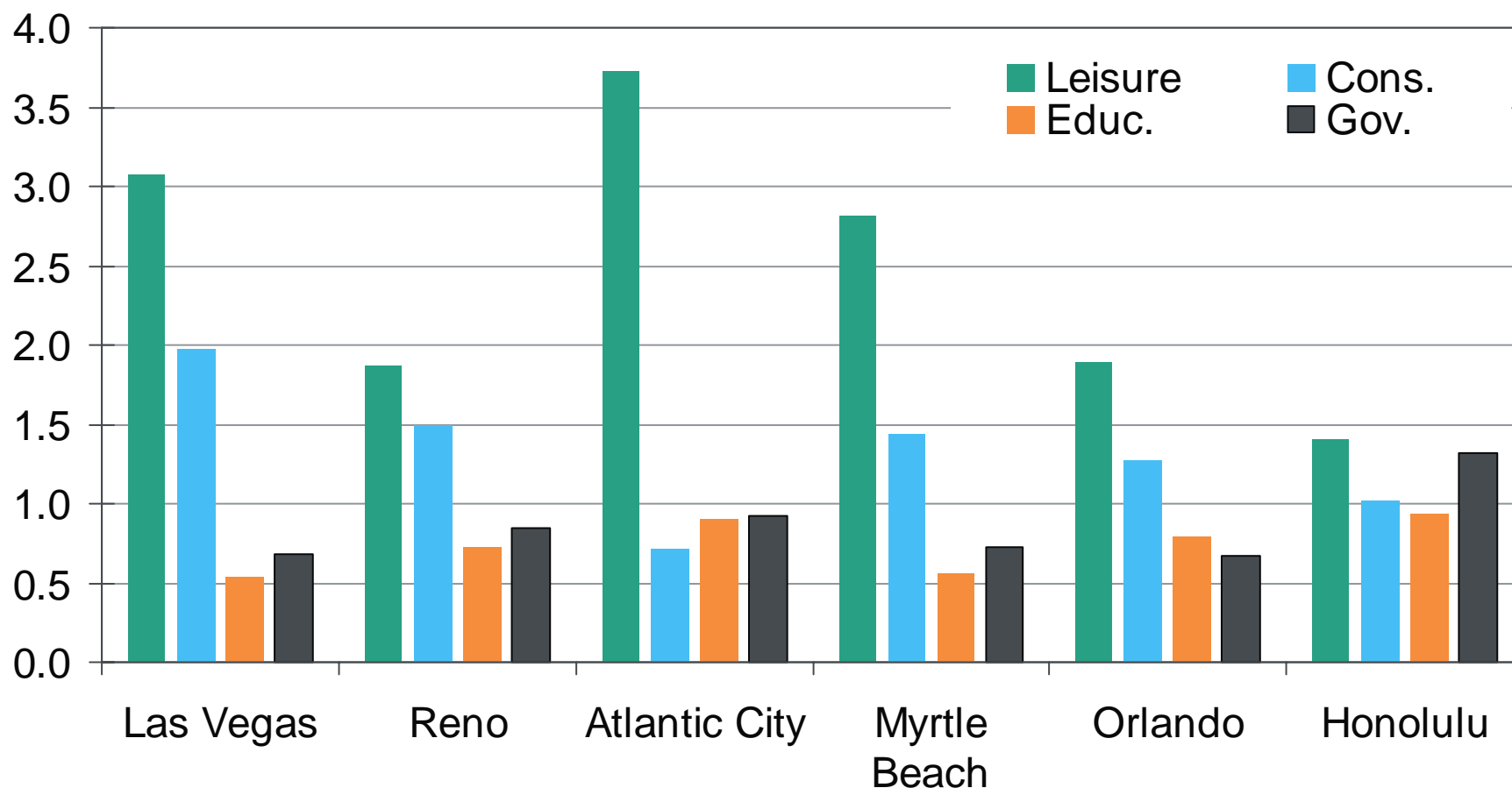
Location quotient, U.S.=1.0

Large Tourism Destinations Not Well Balanced

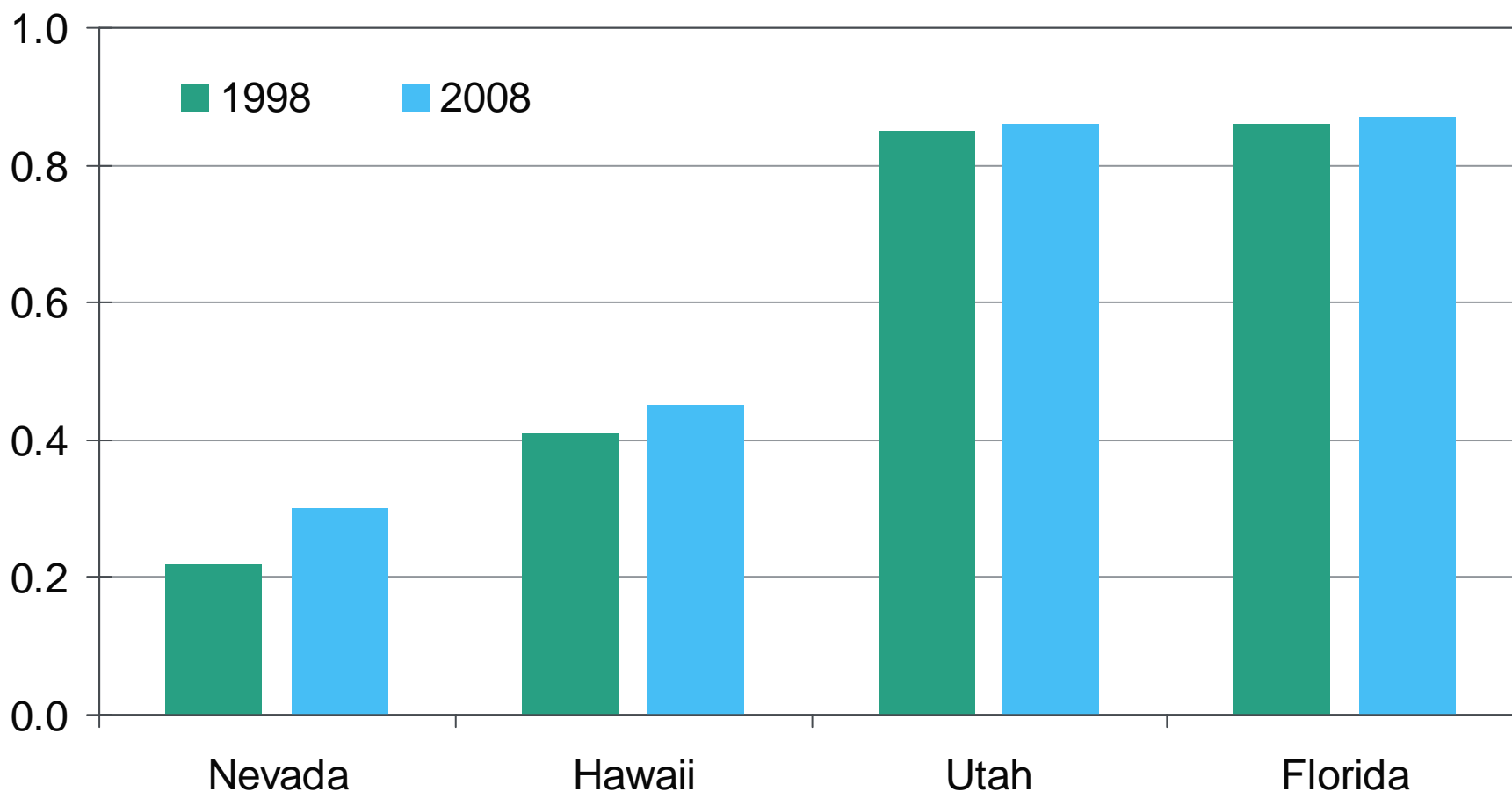

Low Diversity Is Risky

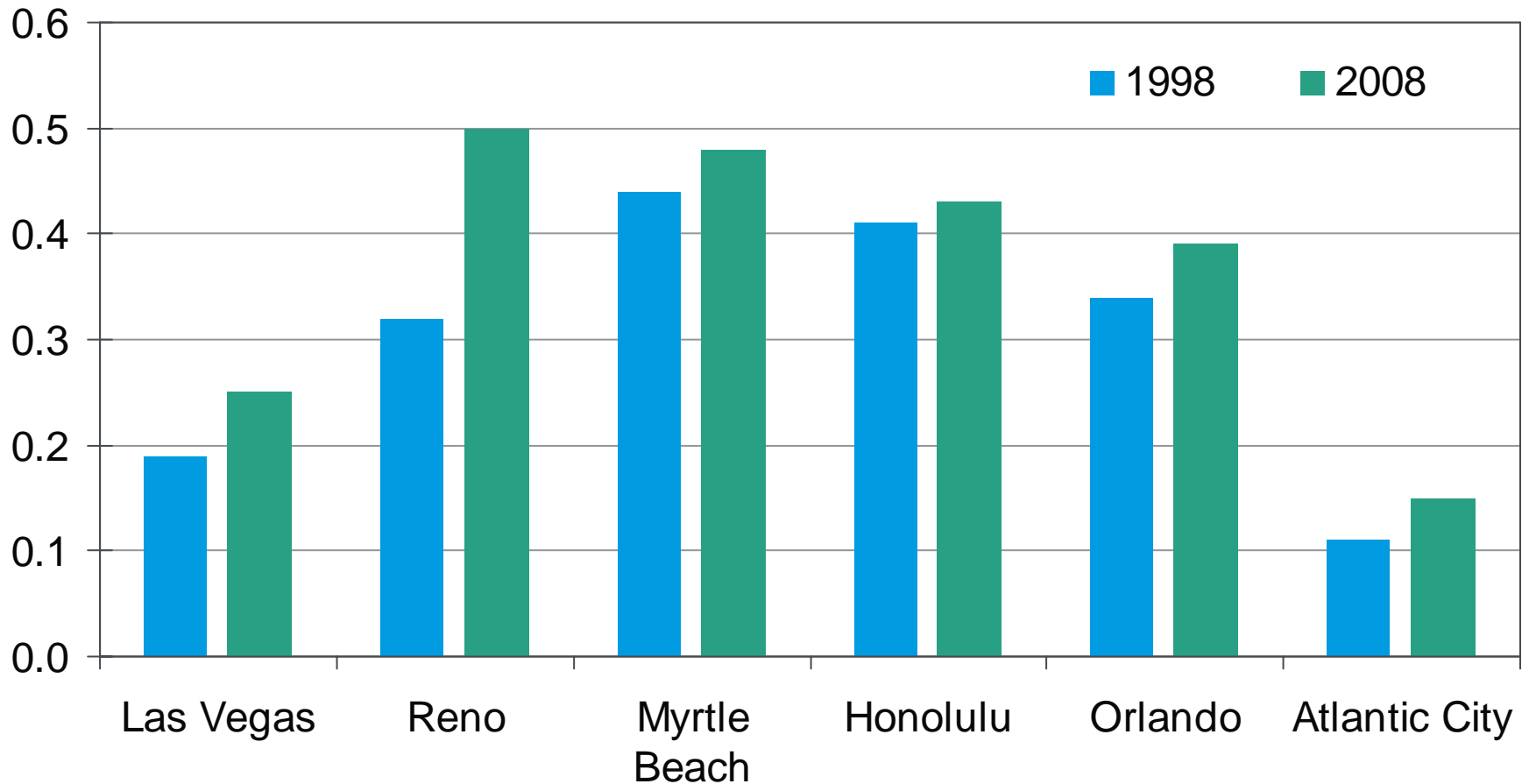
Industrial diversity, U.S.=1.0

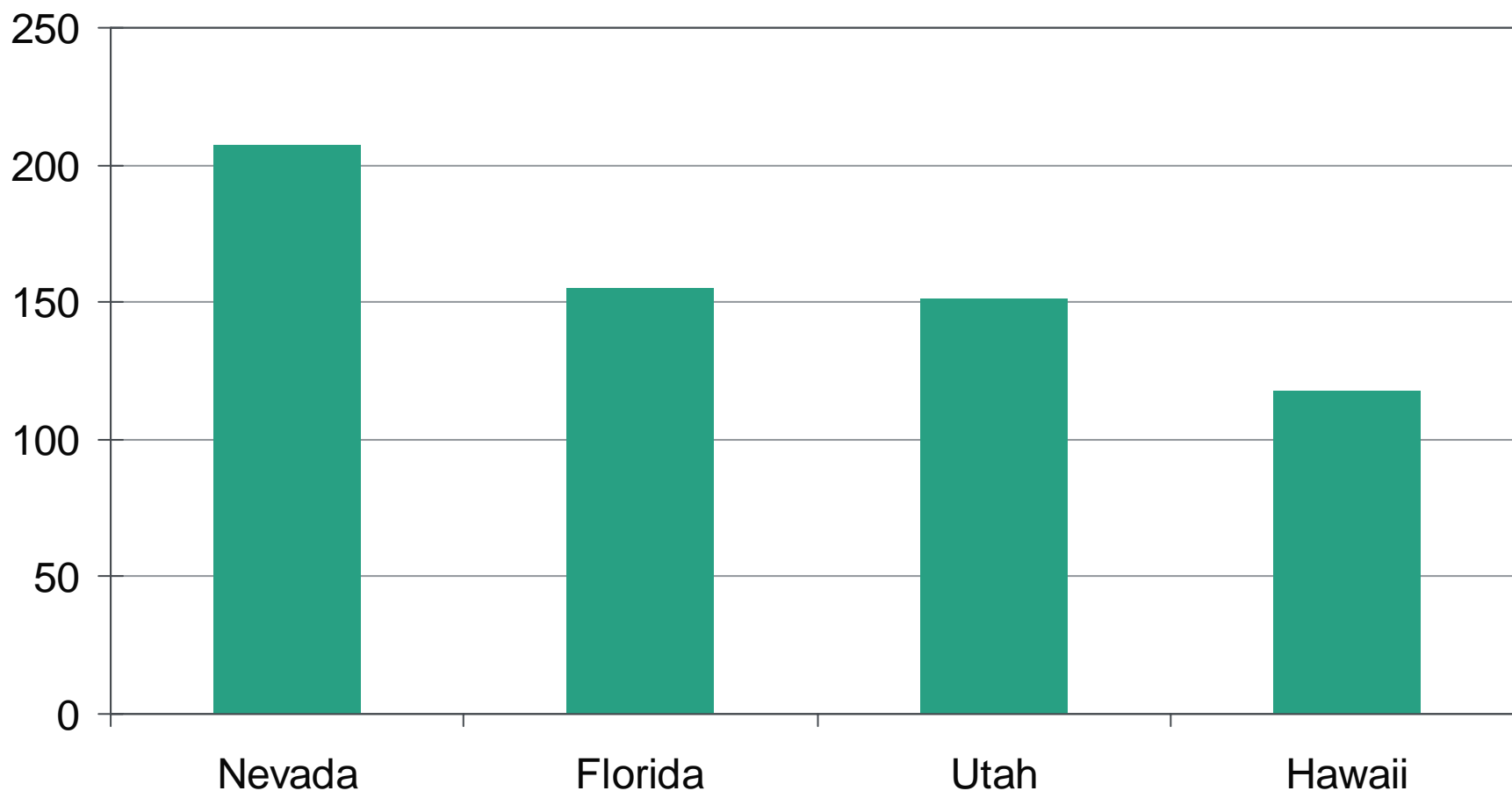

Not All Tourism Areas Have Swings in Economy

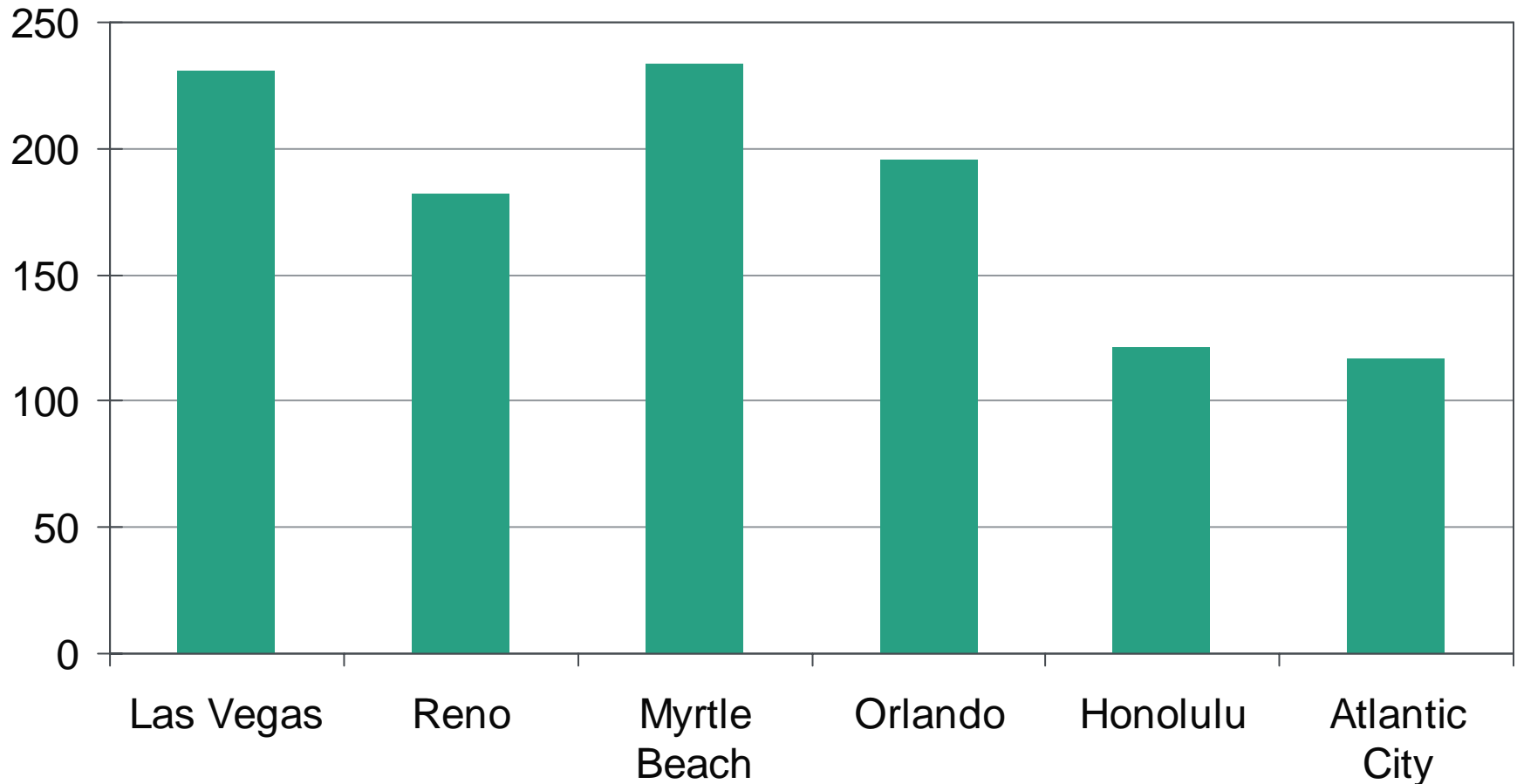
Employment volatility, 2008, U.S.=100

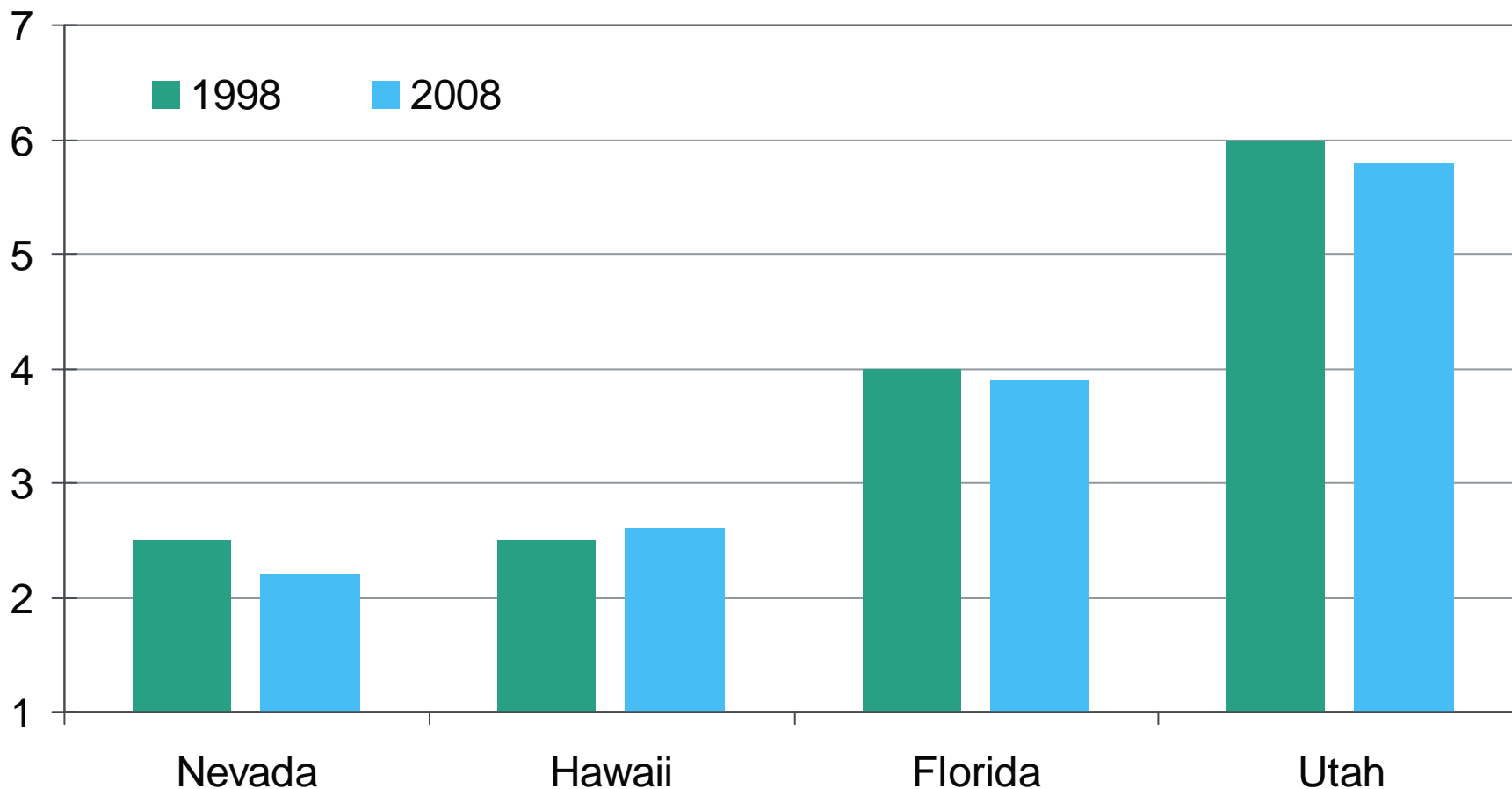

Nevada Unable to Attract the New Economy

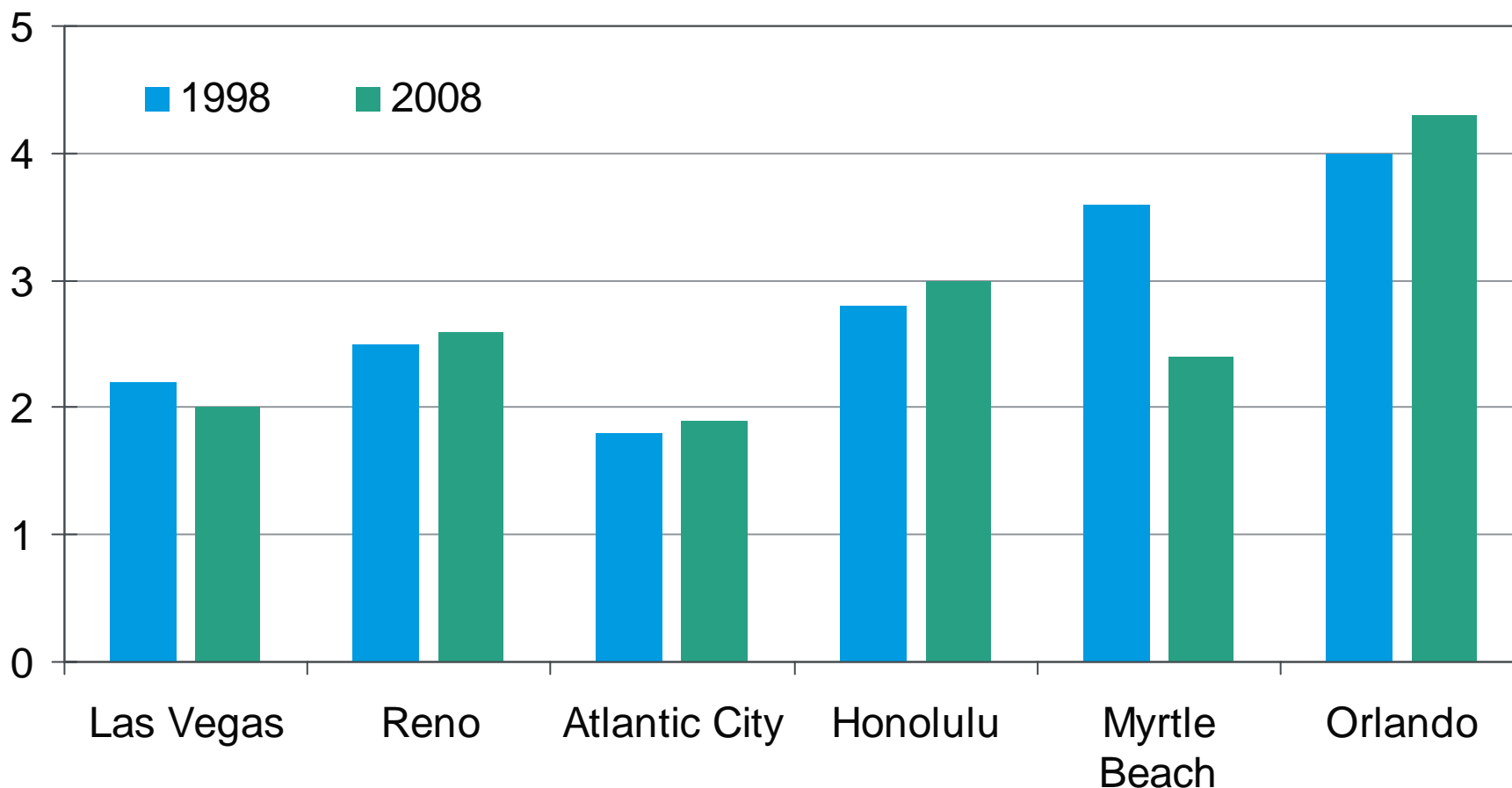
High-tech employment, % of total

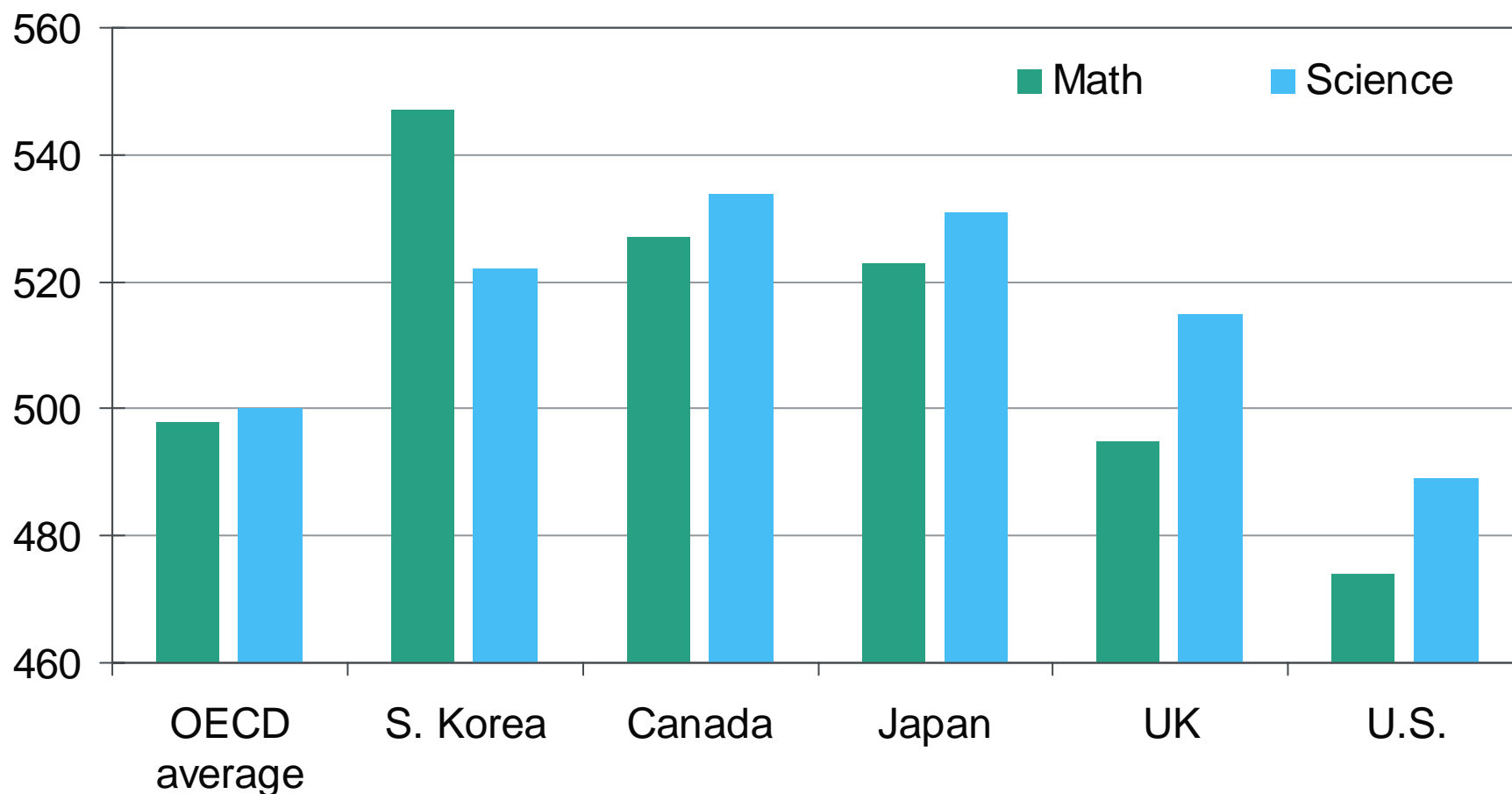

U.S. Student Performance Subpar

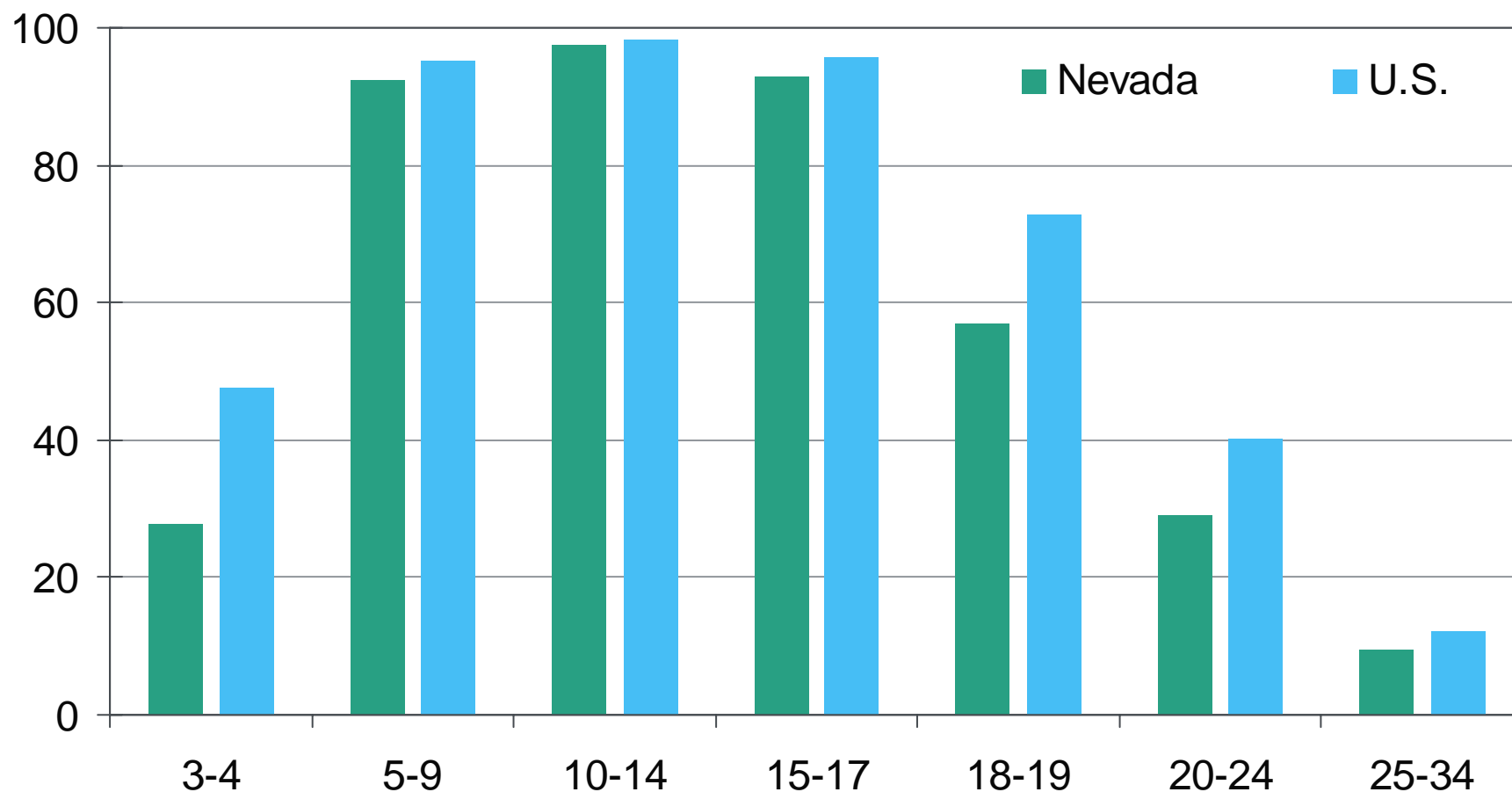
Mean scores for 15-year old students, 2006

Nevadans Choose Education Less Often...

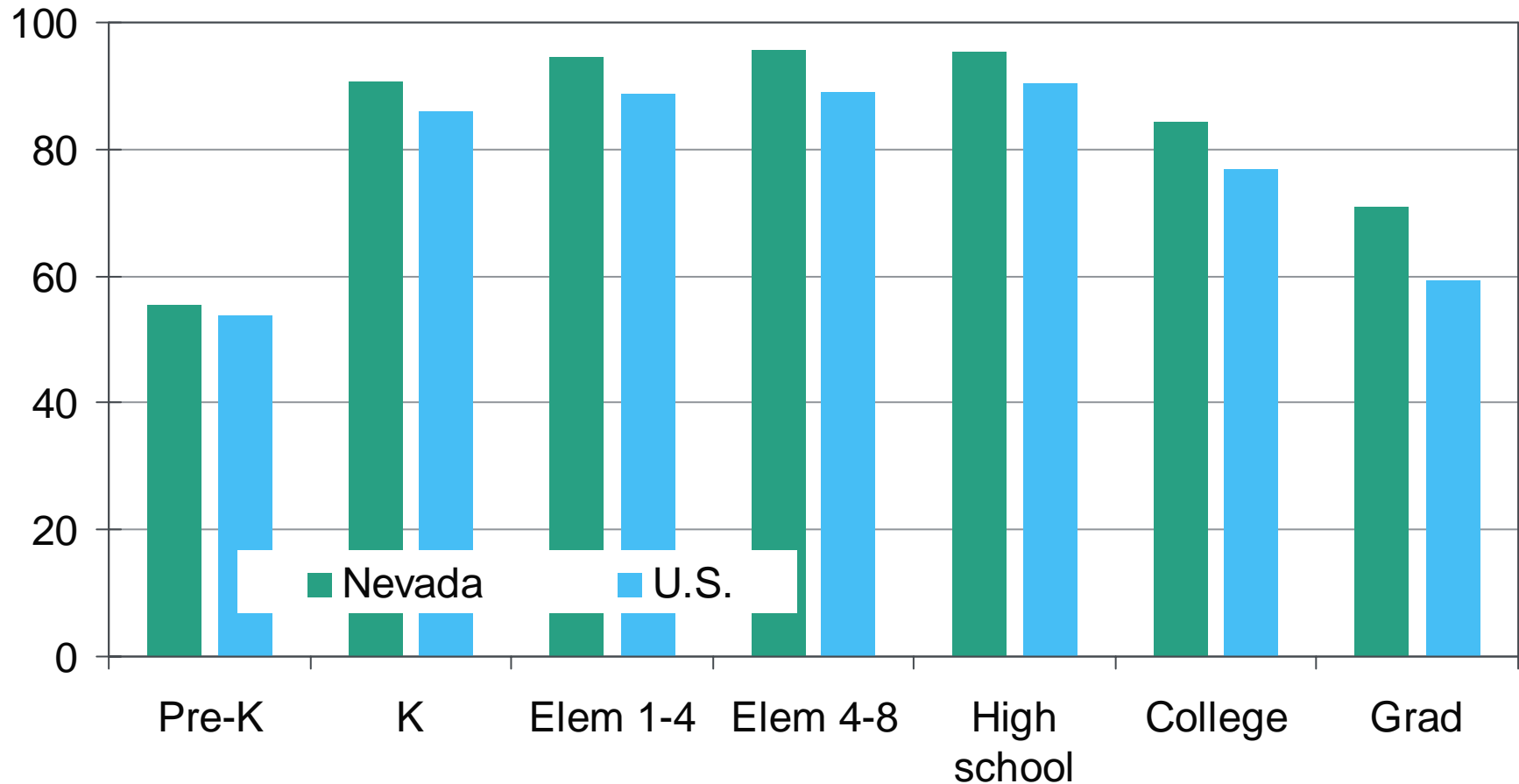
School enrollment, %, 2006-2008, 3-yr estimates

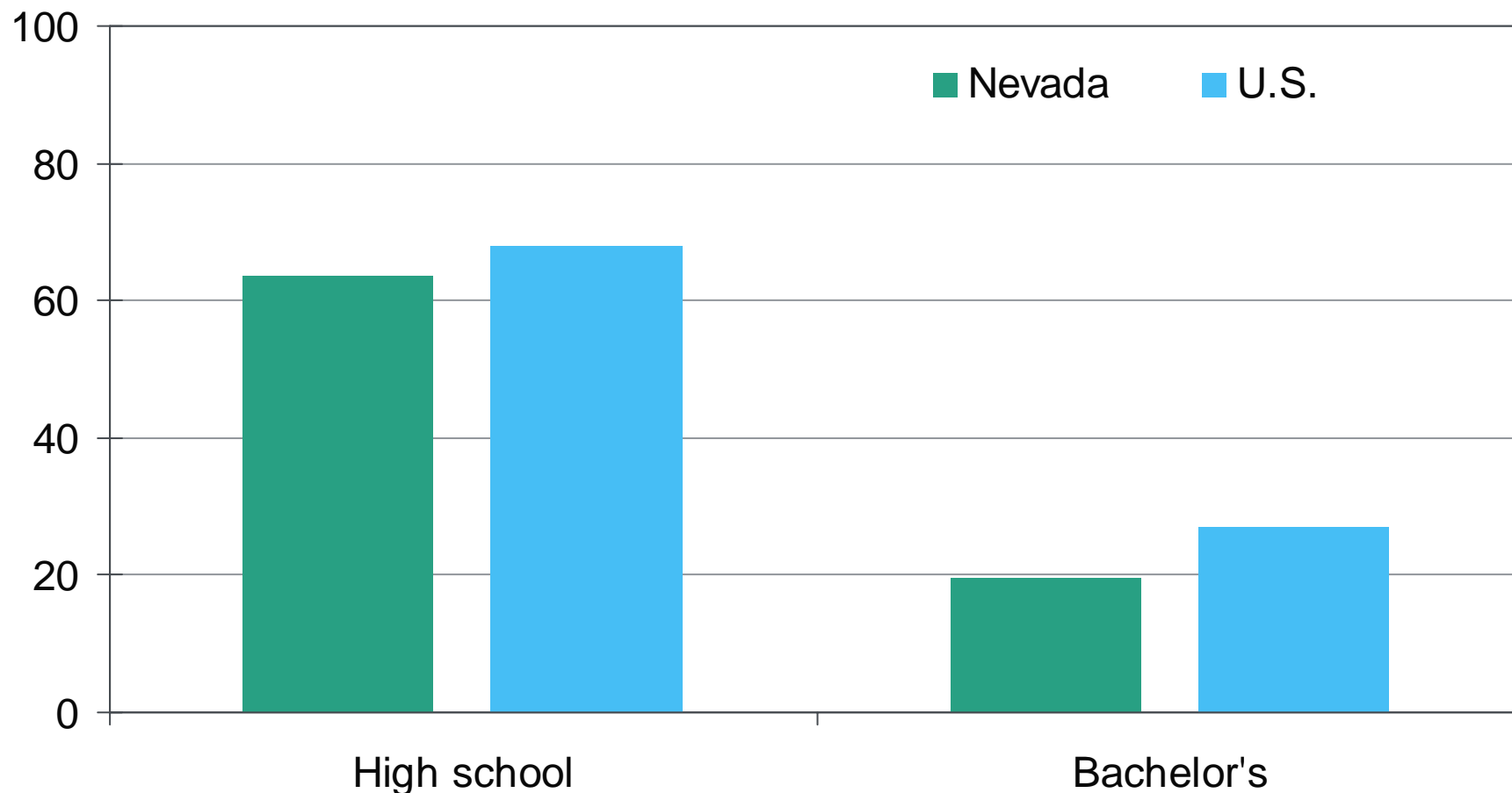
Public school enrollment, %, 2006-2008, 3-yr estimates

Fewer Highly Educated Immigrants

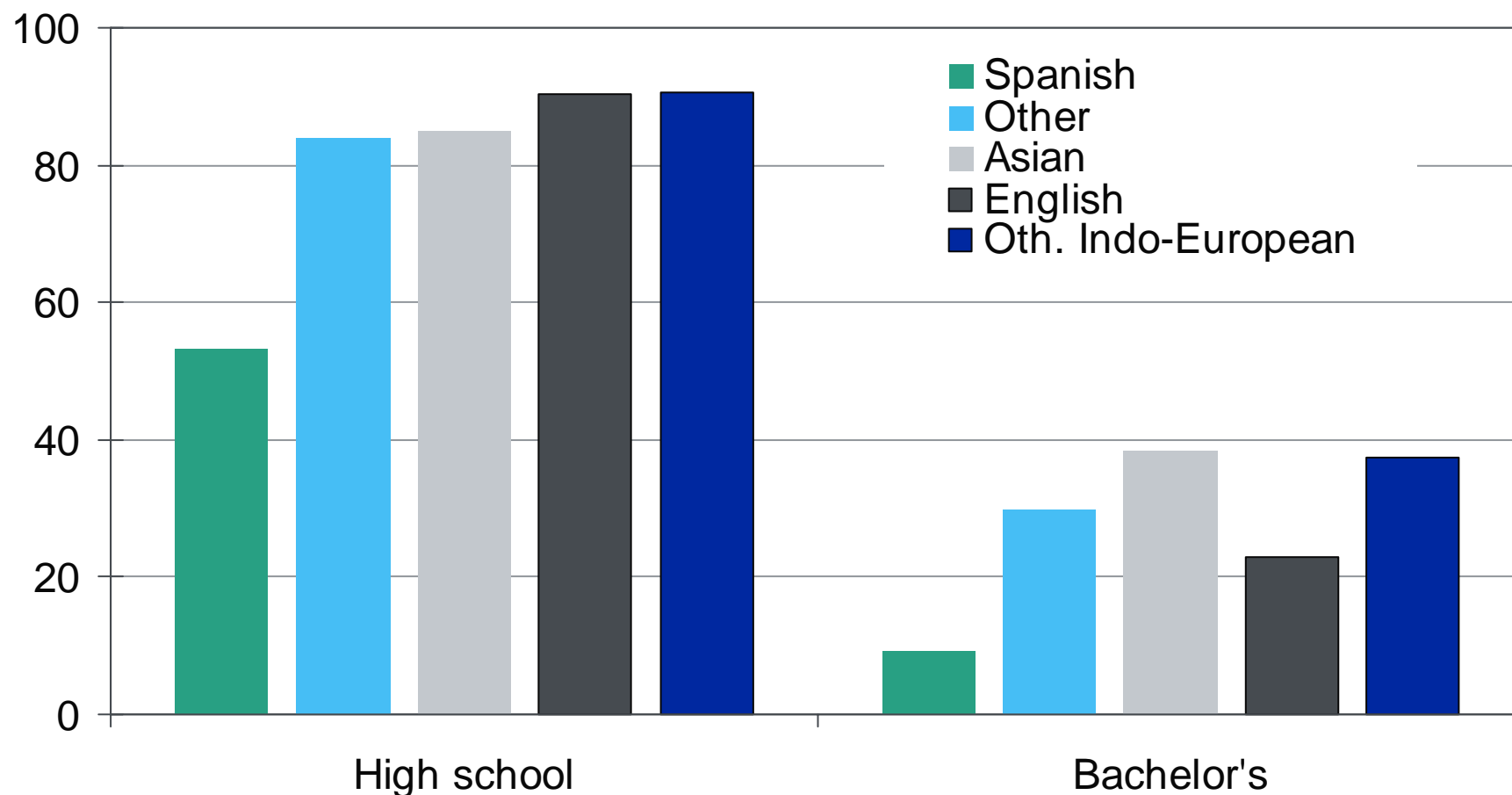
Educational attainment by language spoken at home

Educational attainment by language spoken at home

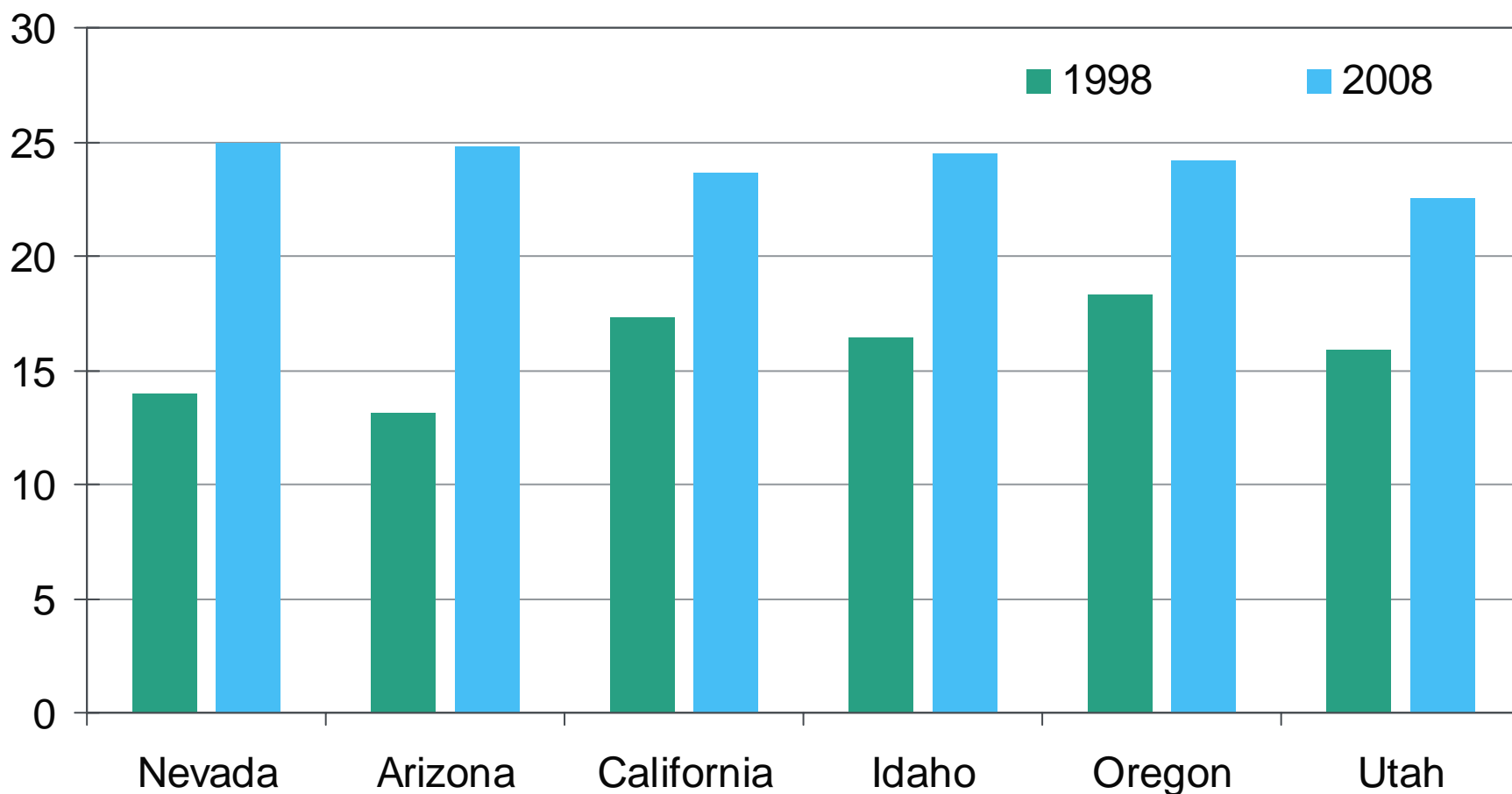

Obesity Becomes a Greater Problem

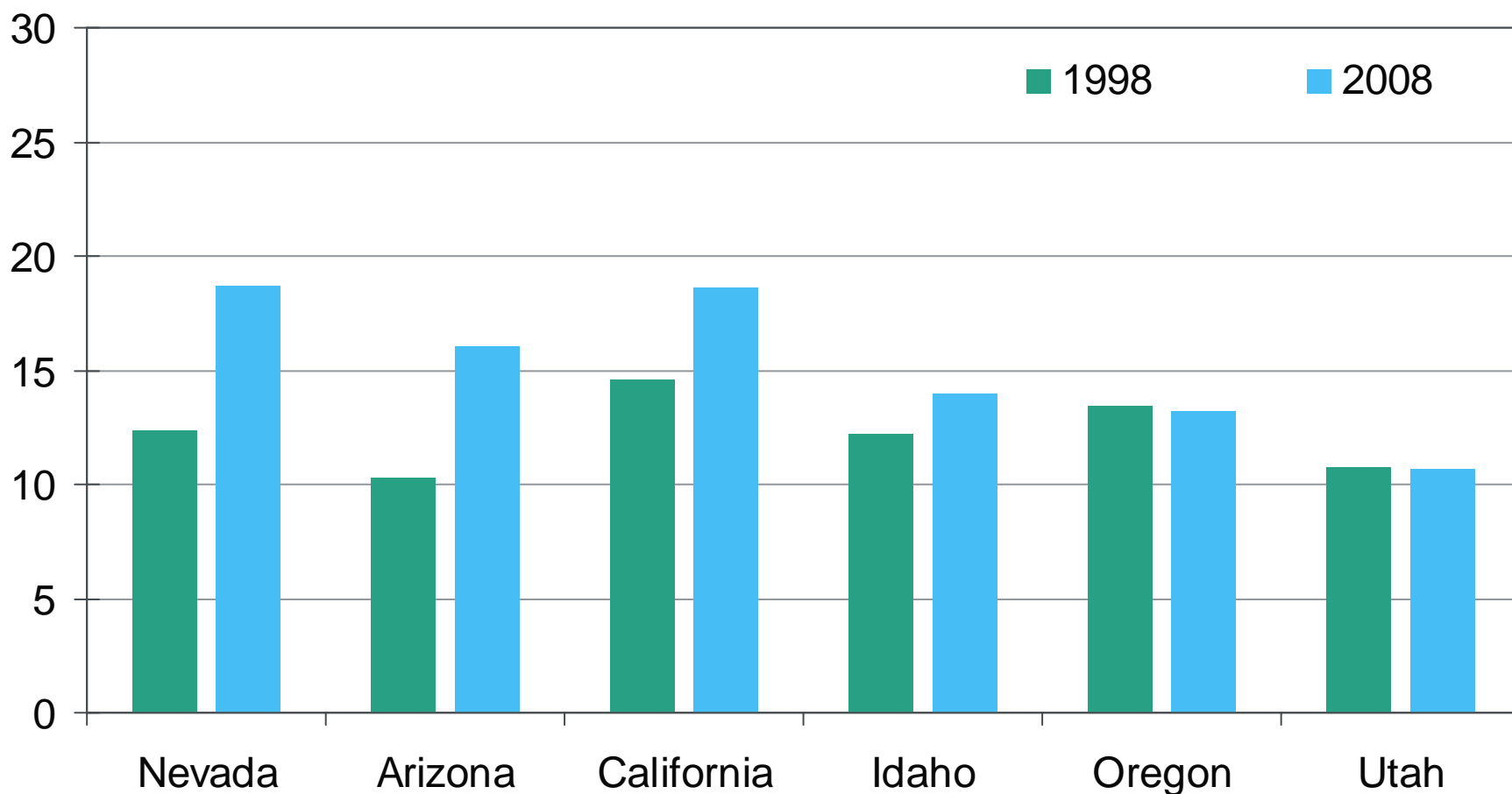
Obesity, % of adult population

Health Status Deteriorating

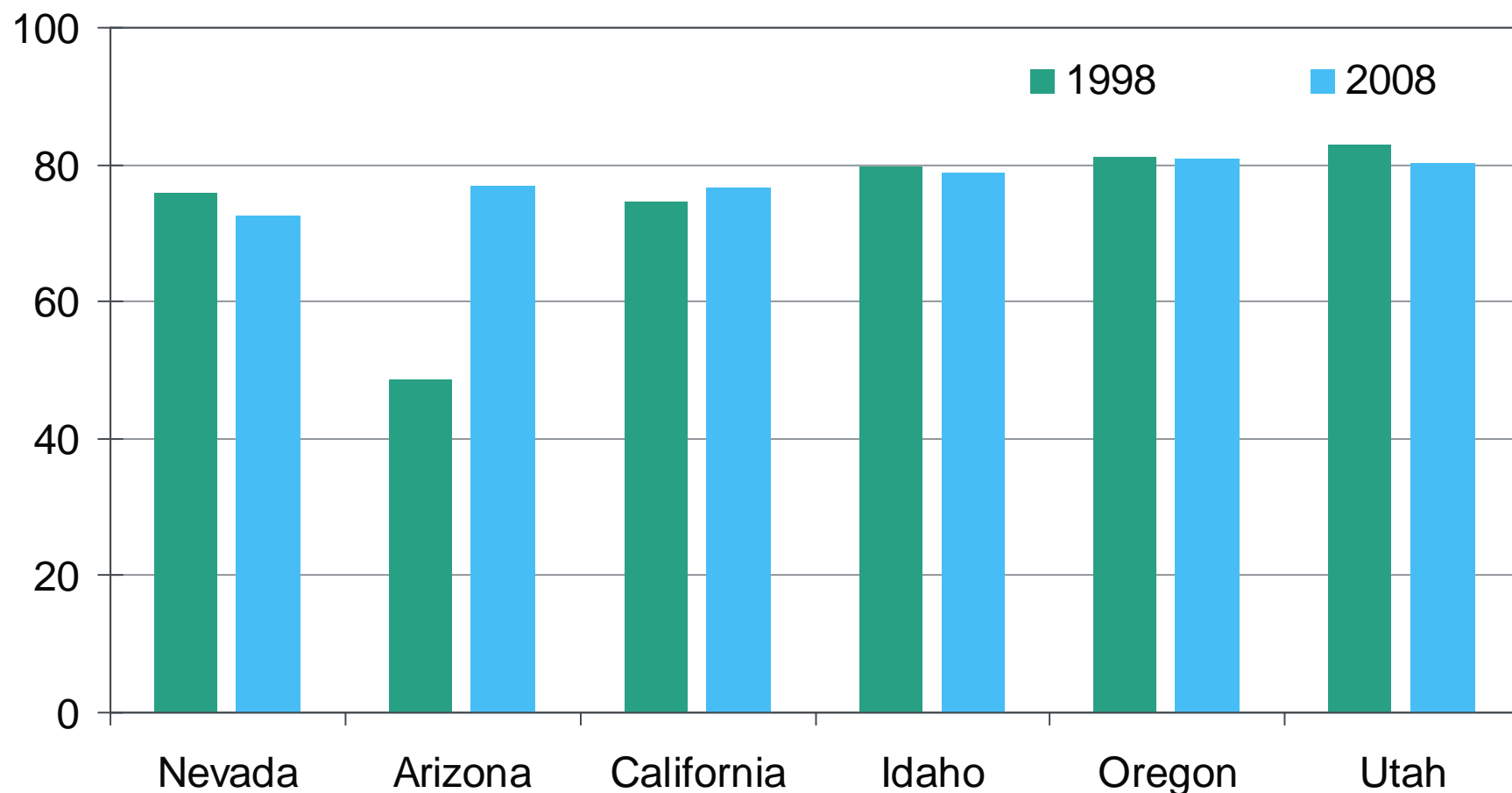
% of population claiming fair or poor health

Slowly Becoming More Sedentary

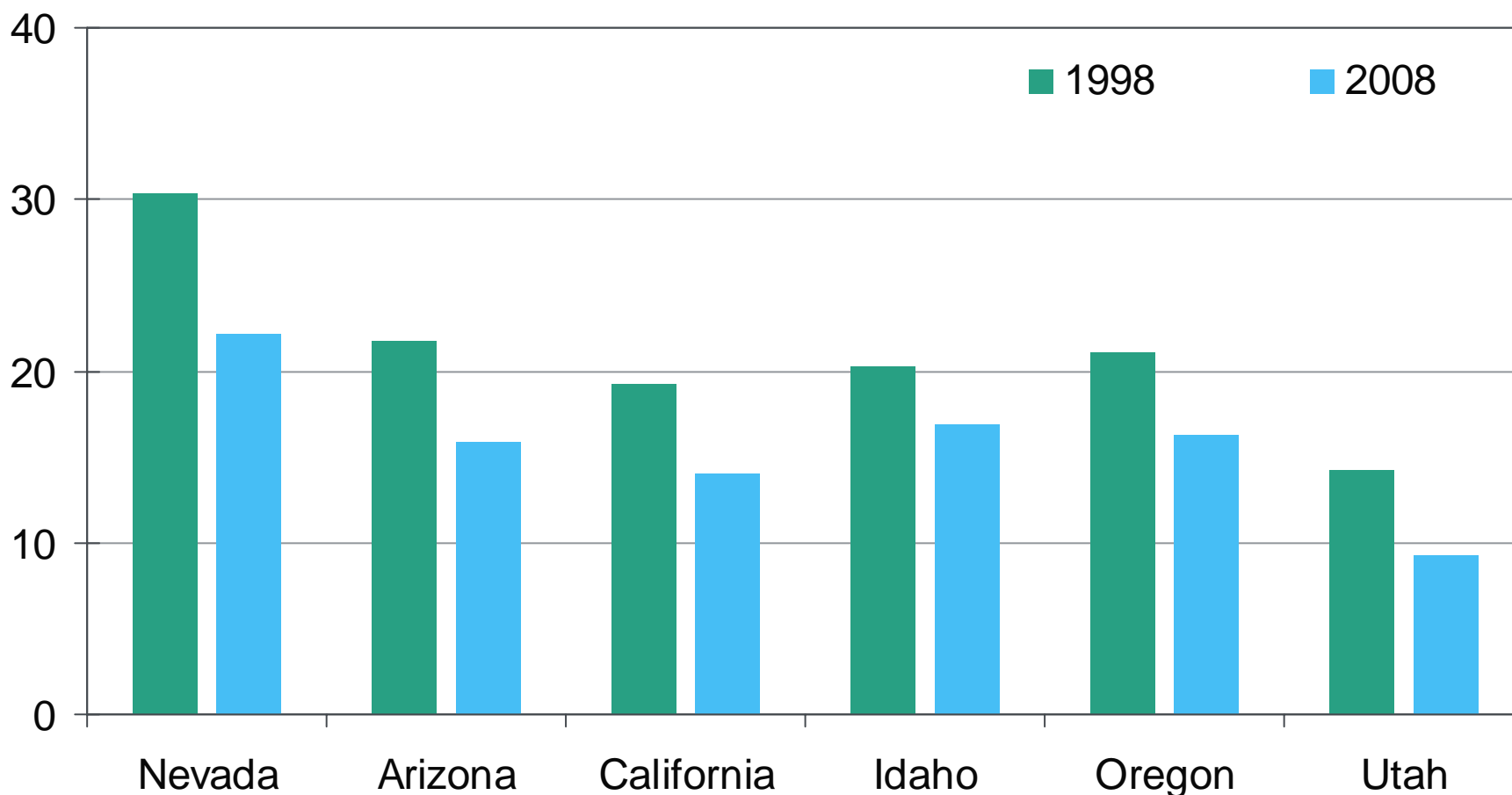
% of adult population that exercises

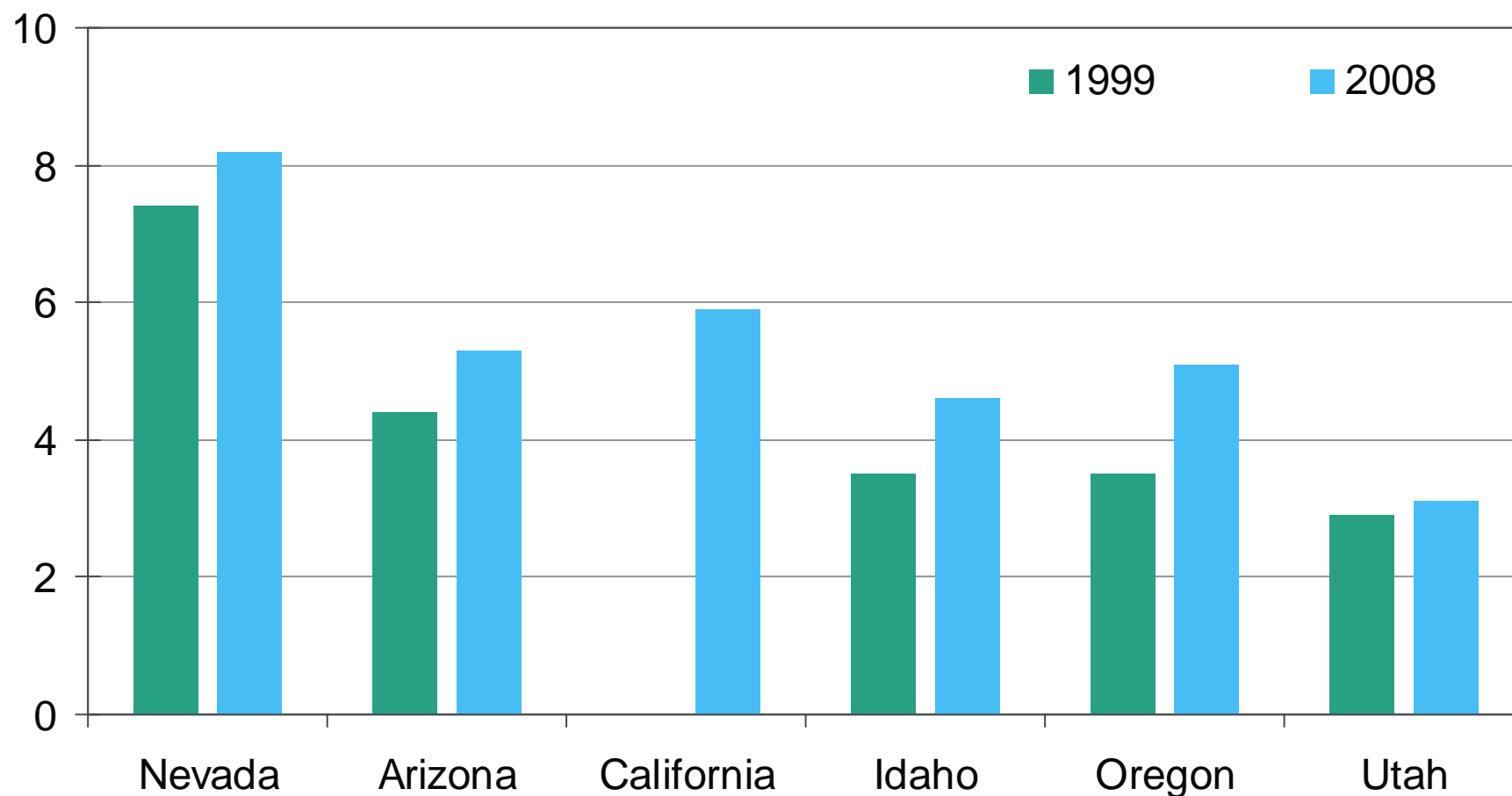
% of adult population that smokes

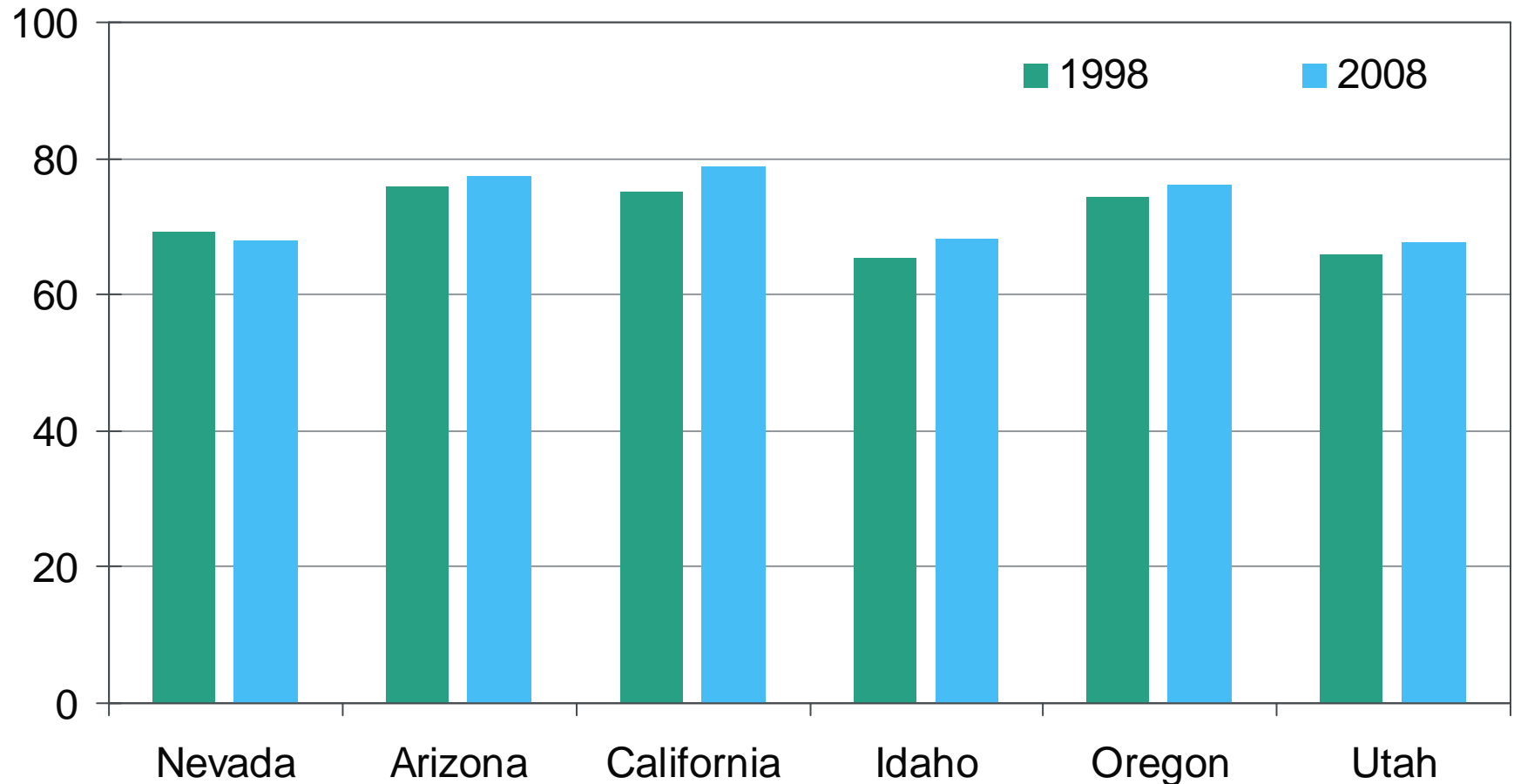
% of adult population that drinks heavily
