Immigrant Educational Attainment

The number of immigrants in Nevada with a college degree increased by 140.5 percent between 2000 and 2007.

Between 2000 and 2007, the number of foreign-born persons in Nevada older than 25 who had a bachelor's or higher degree increased from 33,351 to 80,203, representing a difference of 140.5 percent. In comparison, the foreign-born, college-educated population grew from 10,202 to 33,351 between 1990 and 2000, a difference of 226.9 percent.

At the national level, the foreign-born population with a bachelor's or higher degree increased from 3,103,918 to 5,862,756 between 1990 and 2000, representing a change of 88.9 percent, and grew from 5,862,756 to 8,503,988 (45.1 percent) between 2000 and 2007.

The number of immigrants in Nevada with less than a high school diploma increased by 36.3 percent between 2000 and 2007.

Between 2000 and 2007, the number of foreign-born persons older than 25 in Nevada who had not completed high school increased from 109,286 to 149,006, or 36.3 percent. In comparison, the foreign-born population lacking a high school diploma increased from 32,812 to 109,286 between 1990 and 2000, a difference of 233.1 percent.

At the national level, the foreign-born population without a high school diploma increased from 6,285,122 to 9,297,557 between 1990 and 2000, representing a change of 47.9 percent, and grew from 9,297,557 to 10,106,082 (8.7 percent) between 2000 and 2007.

In 2007, 19.7 percent of immigrants in Nevada had a college degree, while 36.5 percent did not complete high school.

In 2007, 19.7 percent of Nevada's foreign-born population age 25 and older had a bachelor's or higher degree while 36.5 percent lacked a high school diploma. In comparison, 22.4 percent of native-born persons above age 25 had a bachelor's or higher degree in 2007, and 9.9 percent lacked a high school diploma. In 2000, 13.7 percent of the foreign born in Nevada had a bachelor's or higher degree, and 45.0 percent had less than a high school diploma. In 1990, 12.7 percent had a college degree, and 40.9 percent lacked a high school diploma.

Nationally, 26.9 percent of the foreign-born population age 25 and older had a bachelor's or higher degree in 2007 compared to 24.1 percent in 2000 and 20.3 percent in 1990. At the same time, 32.0 percent of the foreign born at the national level lacked a high school diploma in 2007 compared to 38.2 percent in 2000 and 41.2 percent in 1990.

Of foreign-born persons who were naturalized citizens in 2007, 26.4 percent had a bachelor's or higher degree compared to 14.6 percent of noncitizens.

In Nevada, 26.4 percent of foreign-born persons who were naturalized citizens had a bachelor's or higher degree, compared to 14.6 percent of noncitizens. At the same time, 23.3 percent of naturalized citizens lacked a high school diploma compared to 46.5 percent of noncitizens.

At the national level, 32.2 percent of naturalized citizens and 22.2 percent of

noncitizens had a college degree. Further, 22.2 percent of naturalized citizens lacked a high school diploma compared to 40.5 percent of noncitizens.

Education by Language Spoken at Home

The educational attainment of all adults in Nevada in 2007 varied by the language spoken at home.

Of the total population (both native and foreign born) age 25 and older in Nevada, 22.8 percent of those who spoke only English at home had a college degree compared to 9.1 percent of those who spoke Spanish, 37.3 percent of those who spoke other Indo-European languages, 38.5 percent of those who spoke Asian and Pacific Island languages, and 29.8 percent who spoke other languages.

At the same time, 9.6 percent of those who spoke only English lacked a high school diploma compared to 46.7 percent of those who spoke Spanish, 9.4 percent of those who spoke other Indo-European languages, 15.0 percent of those who spoke Asian and Pacific Island languages, and 16.1 percent who spoke other languages.

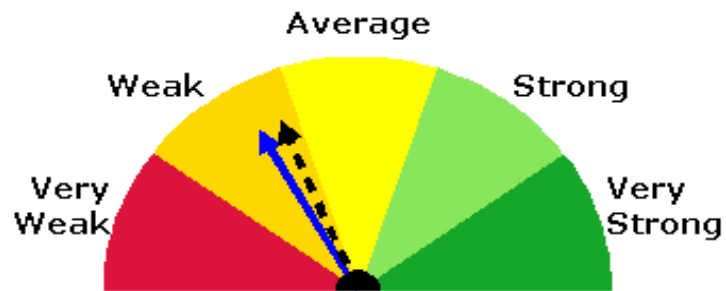
