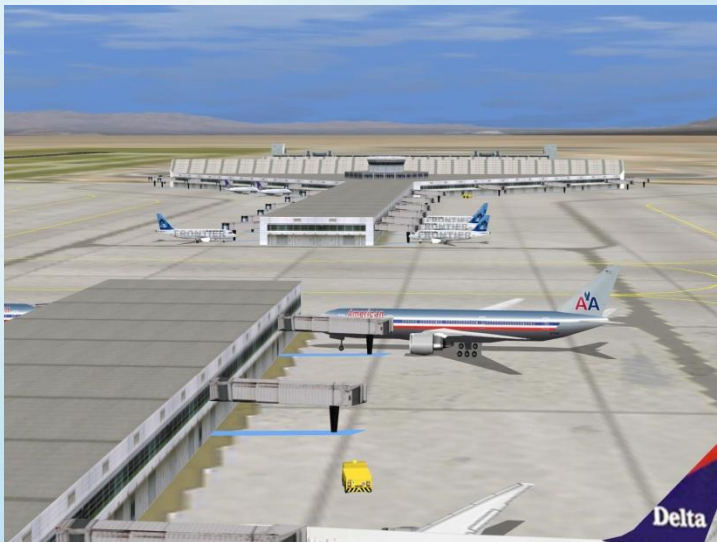


- Current:
Three buildings totaling 164,500 square feet
 - Building 1: 74,500 square feet
 - Building 2: 40,000 square feet
 - Building 3: 50,000 square feet
- Future:
Two new cargo buildings are under construction totaling 201,000 square feet
 - Building 1: 79,000
 - Building 2: 122,000
- Currently there are 12 operators, 10 of which will move to the new buildings.
- There are an average of seven all-cargo flights a day at McCarran.
- McCarran handled 171,900,189 pounds of cargo in 2009.

Proposed Supplemental Airport in the Ivanpah Valley

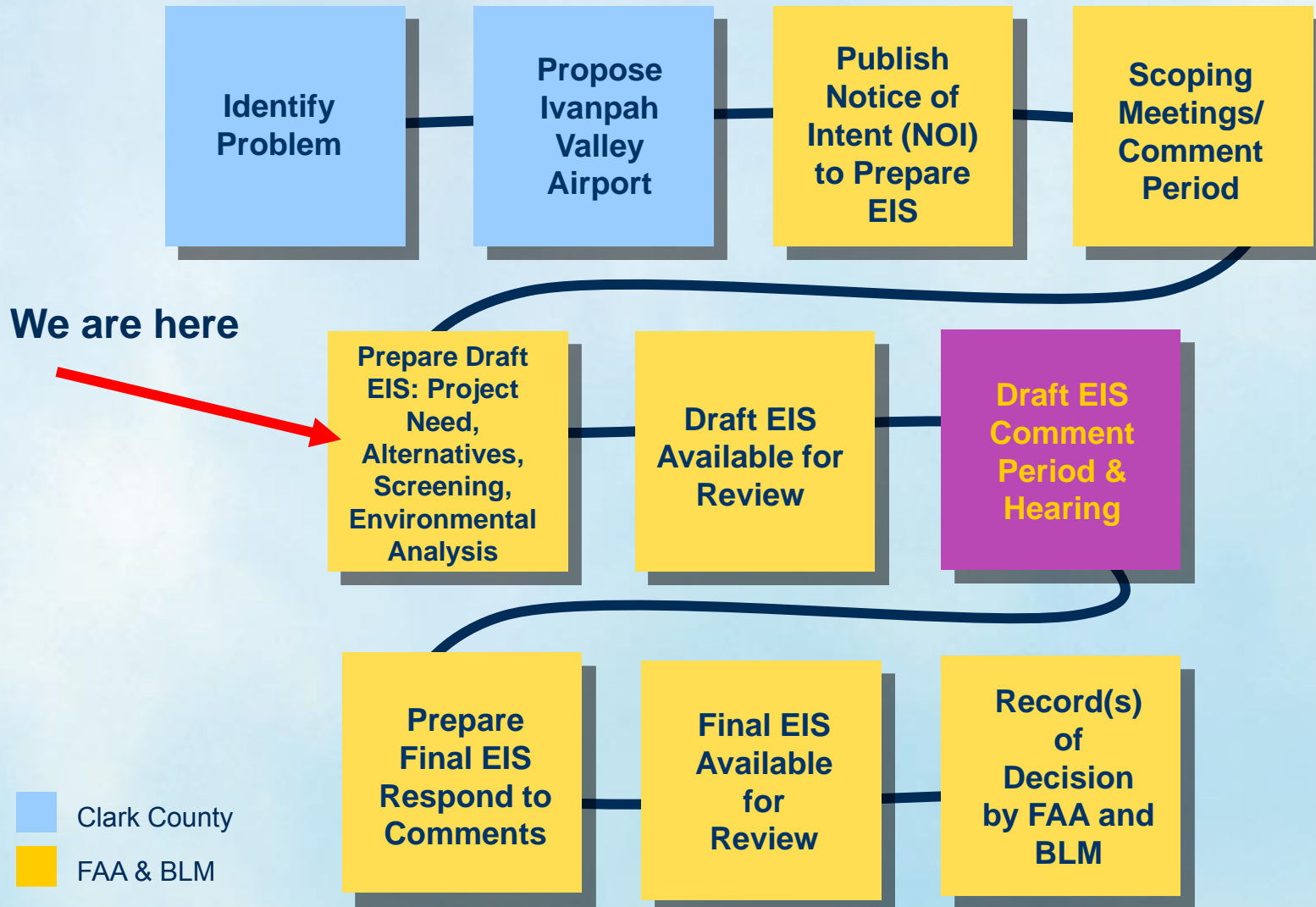


Project Scope

- Supplement capacity available at LAS

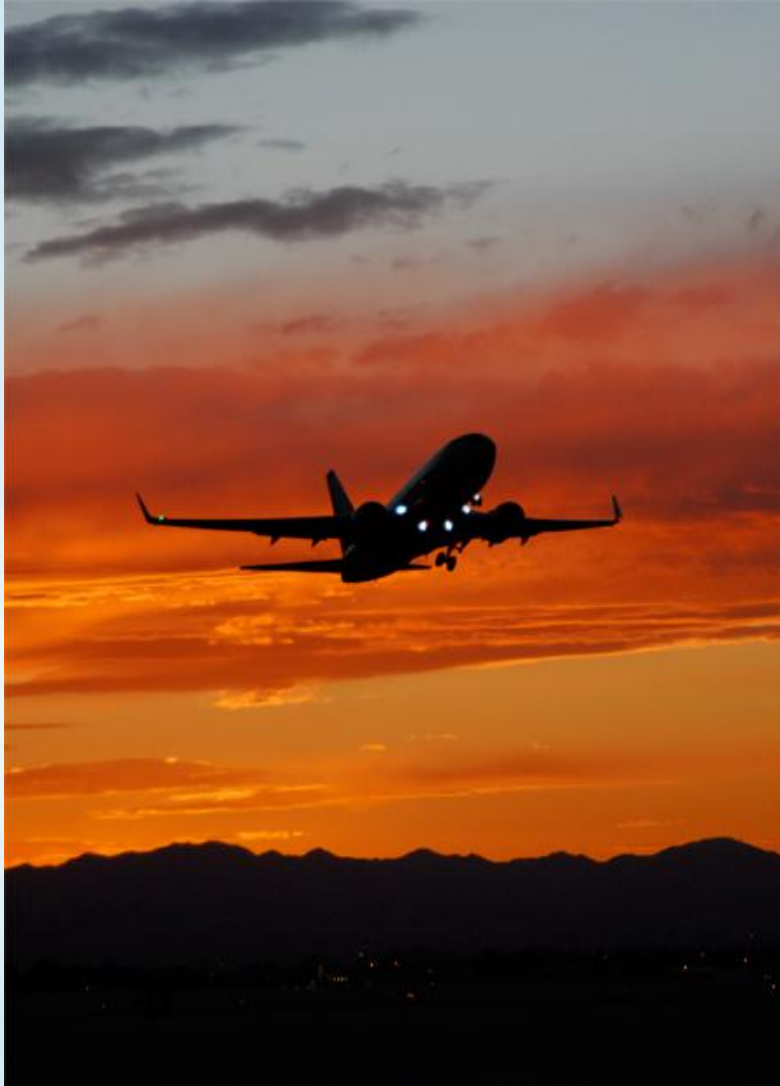
