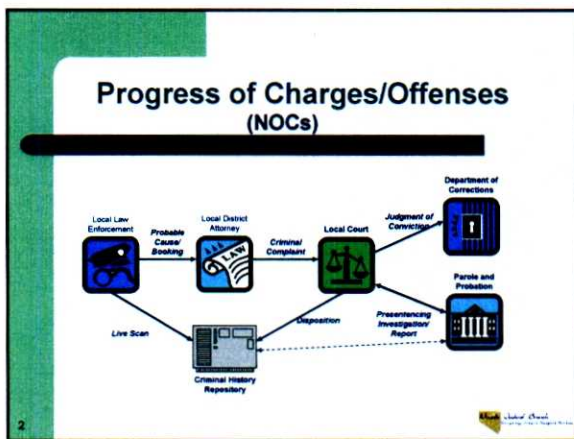

NOC Redevelopment Project Summary

- Redeveloped NOC table required for data integration
- Project Tasks
 - Redesign the NOC model to better meet needs of all parties
 - Develop useable content for new model
 - Provide mapping and migration path from old and new models
- Over 100 people from law enforcement, prosecutors, courts, public safety, P&P, Corrections participated

NOC Redevelopment Project

Existing NOC Table

- Flat table with almost 13,000 entries
- No organization – difficult to find the right crime
- No formal procedures/body for maintaining entries
- Many duplicate and ambiguous/erroneous entries
- Lacks sufficient information to properly define crimes
 - Inadequate crime descriptions (maximum 50 characters)
 - Only one statute is cited for each code
 - Limited capabilities for grouping crimes

NOC Redevelopment Project Goals

- Develop an "intelligent" code
 - Use hierarchical approach
 - Provide a mechanism to group similar crimes
 - Plan for table growth and modification
- Provide an adequate description of each crime
- Eliminate duplicate and invalid table entries
- Allow the ability to cite multiple statutes for a single crime
- Enhance the ability to locate the specific NOC entries
- Be backwards compatible

11-Character "Intelligent" Code

- Crime Type designator: A 1-character alpha code (A-Z) describing the major categorization of the crime (e.g., crimes against person, crimes against property, traffic)
- Crime Sub-Type designator: A 2-digit sequential number used to group similar crimes together (e.g., homicide, kidnapping, assault)
- Substantive Crime designator: A 3-digit sequential number within each Crime Sub-Type identifying variations in crimes covered by a single statute or the same statutes (e.g., manslaughter, mayhem, DUI)
- Crime Class/Category designator: A 1-character alpha code to designate crime class/category (e.g., Class A, B or C felonies, Gross)
- Extended/Enhanced Crime designator: A 2-digit sequential number for each extension or enhanced crime (e.g., gang member, elderly)
- Jurisdiction designator: A 2-character alpha code identifying each applicable jurisdiction (e.g., state, county, municipality)

Why is this Important to the Criminal Justice Community?

- Provides accuracy and consistency across different agencies (law enforcement, prosecutors, courts, DPS, corrections)
- Allows electronic sharing of case information (e.g., booking, charging document, dispositions)
- Reduces duplicated/inefficient effort
- Improves analysis and statistics capabilities

Implementation Plan

- Have obtained buy-in from criminal justice agencies
 - Nevada Judicial Council
 - Nevada Sheriffs and Chiefs Association
 - Nevada Prosecutors (DA's) Association
- Have established an interim oversight committee and drafted policies and procedures for maintaining content
- Have implemented in approximately 10 courts
- Will complete loading into NCJIS by year end (using backward-compatible 5-digit NOC)
- Working with Clark and Washoe Counties to implement in law enforcement, prosecutors and court systems
