#### MISSION STATEMENT


o Mental Health Court is a multi-jurisdictional, community-based program that provides court supervision and services to mentally ill offenders through cooperation of state, county, and local non-profit service agencies to promote engagement in treatment, improve quality of life, decrease recidivism, and increase community safety and awareness.

- o De-criminalize the severely mentally ill.
- Provide comprehensive wrap-around services and return to productive living.
- Protect public safety.

# Mental Health Court- Clark County Referrals

- o From Dec. 2005 to Dec. 2007 we received 395 referrals, 33 per month
- o We accepted 210 out of 395 = 53%
- o 35% MHC pleas
- o 65% Condition of probation

# Mental Health Court- Clark County Referrals

- Referrals are made by public defender, judges, district attorney
- Specialty Courts reviews for target population and criminal record review
- SNAMHS is referred to interview
- Determination is made and PD/DA negotiate case




## Mental Health Court- Clark County Total Admissions


