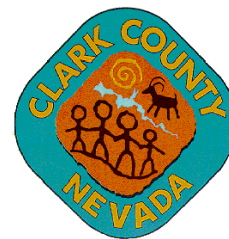

SENIOR CITIZENS PROTECTIVE SERVICE (SCPS) (455-8672)

Provides social work assistance to seniors (age 60+) in Clark County reported to be victims of abuse, neglect, exploitation or isolation. Services include:

- Investigation
- Limited Financial Assistance
- Medical Assistance
- Resource Referrals

OUTREACH SERVICES (455-3052)

Provides CCSS programs to outlying locations: Boulder City, Clark County Detention Center, Laughlin, Mesquite, Overton and Searchlight.

MEDICAL OUTREACH (455-3052)

Provides social work assistance for patients being discharged from hospitals in Clark County.

HOMELESS OUTREACH (455-2854)

Provides assistance for the homeless with obtaining Social Security benefits, housing, medical, and information & referral for basic needs.

RYAN WHITE CARE ACT TITLE I (455-5722)

Provides assistance with health and support services for persons living with HIV/AIDS. Services include information and referrals to community agencies that provide the following:
