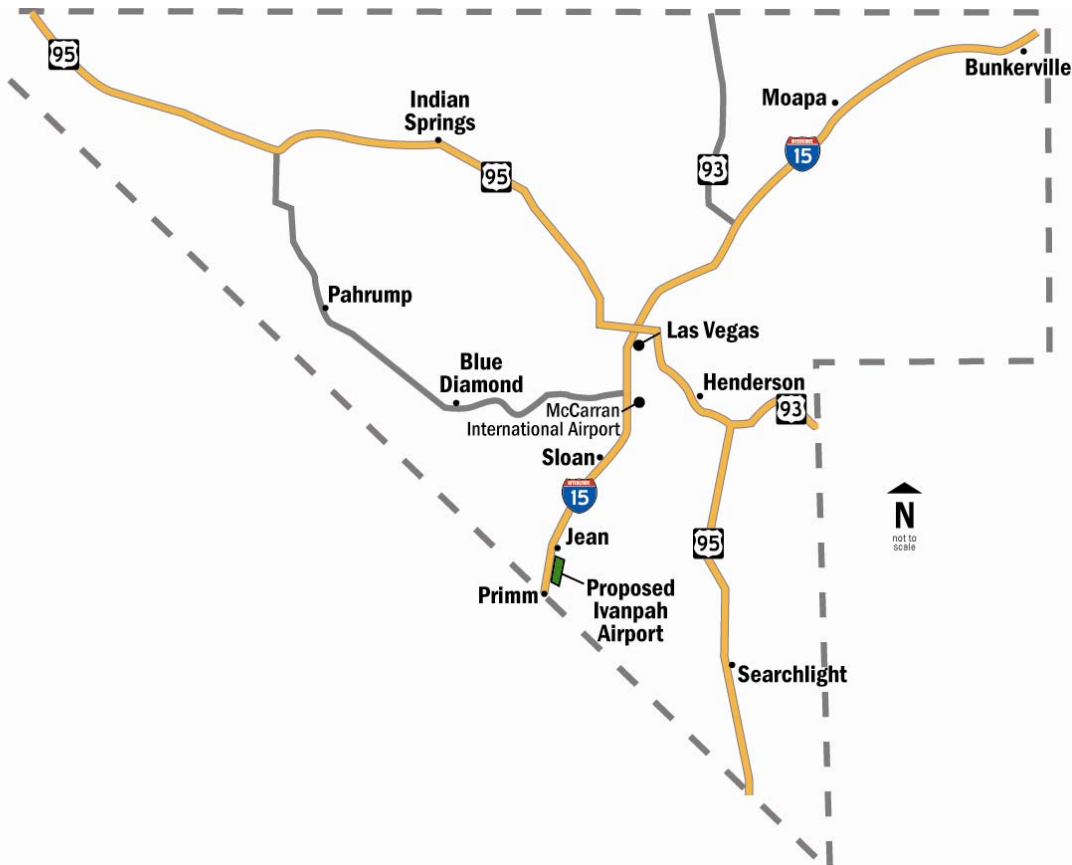

Ivanpah Airport



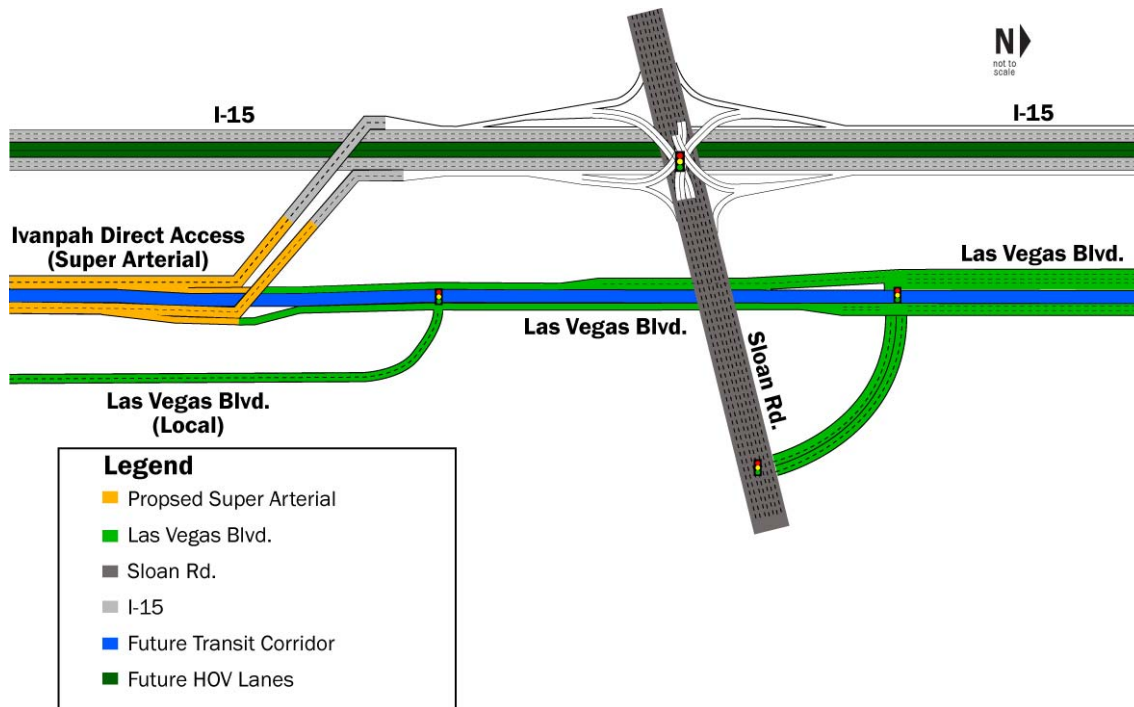
- The RTC is cooperating with the Clark County Dept. of Aviation and NDOT on planning efforts for transportation in the corridor.
- The RTC is conducting a transit options study to determine available corridors and the best transit modes to serve the Ivanpah airport.

Denver International Airport

- Community has rail service.
- DIA opened and currently operates with a number of public bus lines.
- Commuter rail is planned in the future.



RTC Transit Study



- Working with NDOT to preserve right-of-way for transit.
- Dedicated transit lanes on a superarterial parallel to I-15.
- HOV lanes on I-15.

RTC Transit Study

- Study will assess which transit mode(s) best fit the corridor
 - Express bus service
 - Bus Rapid Transit
 - Future light rail

- Study to be completed by December of 2008
