# RTC of Washoe County

Regional Agency Focused on Transportation

Five member Board of elected officials

- 3 Businesses:
  - Provide Public Transportation
  - Build and Repair Regional Roads
  - Transportation Planning (MPO)





# RTC Street and Highway Funding

- Gas Tax:
  - 10.3 cents/gal
- Sales Tax:
  - NRS 377A.020 allows collection up to ½% tax on sales for public mass transit or road construction 1/16% now enacted
- Regional Road Impact Fee:
  - NRS 278B.160 allows imposition of impact fees to pay capital cost of road improvements need to serve new development
- Federal and State Funds:
  - RTC partners with NDOT, using State and Fed funds



# RTC Public Transit Funding

#### Sales Tax:

 NRS 377A.020 allows collection up to ½% tax on sales for public mass transit or road construction 5/16% now enacted

#### Passenger Fares:

- Fares collected from public transit passengers fund services
- Federal and State Funds:
  - RTC receive Federal Transit Administration and State funds for public transportation



#### **About the RTC: Resources**

- 102 Employees
- Transit services operated by private contractors employing 334
- \$215 million budget in FY 2008





#### **About the RTC: RTC RIDE**

- 263 employees through private contract
- 70 clean diesel buses
- 8.8 million passengers last year Record!





#### **About the RTC: RTC RIDE**

Ranked highly against **ten** peer systems in west for the last decade:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> in Cost/Hour: \$75

2<sup>nd</sup> in Cost/Passenger: \$2.52

Award winning safety programs





#### **About the RTC: RTC ACCESS**

- Door-to-door service for the disabled
- 246 square miles: Cold Springs to Steamboat, Verdi to Vista
- 24 hours/day, 365 days/year
- Innovative night taxi service






#### **About the RTC: Streets and Highways Program**

- Major builder/rebuilder of regional roads in the Truckee Meadows
- Programs based on community needs, regardless of jurisdiction
- Approximately 95 cents of every dollar goes into private sector design and construction








RTC Fuel Tax Rehab and Reconstruct Program: Rehabilitation and Restoration





#### RTP Needs Major Update: Underway

- Major Funding Shortfalls
  - Rapid inflation in construction costs
  - Decrease in revenue streams
- Growth Accelerating
- Need to Look Further Into Future
  - 2040 RTP
  - Long-Long Range Planning



#### **Future Transportation Challenges**

- Major Funding Shortfalls:
  - Federal Level
    - Trust Fund will not be solvent by 2009
    - Last federal fuel tax rate increase: 1993
    - 2010-2015 expected to be 30% decrease in real dollars per capita
  - State Level
    - Blue Ribbon Committee found \$3.8 billion shortfall
    - Last state fuel tax rate increase: 1992
- Nevada Trends 1992 to Present:
  - Per capita travel up 6.8%
  - Per capita fuel use down 8.3%
  - Construction inflation up 82% (NDOT estimates up 44% in last 3 years)



# Current projected 10 year capacity shortfall in Washoe County

\*Assumes impact fees levied at 100% development share

Regional Road System	\$1,313,000,000
Freeway System	\$2,238,000,000
Total capacity needs:	\$3,541,000,000
Capacity Revenues	
Local*	\$ 838,000,000
State	\$ 142,000,000
Federal	\$ 319,000,000
Total capacity revenues:	\$1,299,000,000
Projected capacity revenue shortfall:	\$2,242,000,000



### Projected Non-Capacity Regional Transportation Shortfalls

- Regional Road System Preventative Maintenance/Rehabilitation: \$113 million
- Public Transportation: \$164 million



#### **Future Transportation Challenges**

- Local Funding Solutions:
  - Annually index Washoe County Fuel Taxes
    - 2003-2006, indexing up 11%; construction up 40%+
  - Sales Tax
    - Generally inflation proof, but not recently
  - Public Transit Fares
    - Annual adjustments have kept close to inflation



#### **RRIF: Major Increase Proposed**

- Needed Improvements: \$320 million to \$1.3 billion
  - Right of Way escalation
  - Construction Cost escalation
  - More growth to be accommodated
- Does Not Address Freeway Segment Needs
- Fees Increases:
  - Single Family Home: increase from \$2,000 to \$7,000
  - Must be approved by RTC, Reno, Sparks and Washoe County



#### **Future Transportation Challenges**

- Funding Issues Need Immediate Attention
  - Blue Ribbon Committee
- Avoid the Additional Costs of POBOR/PISTOL
- Quality of Life is at Stake
  - Economic Vitality
  - Mobility for passenger and freight movement
  - Air Quality
- Innovation Is Needed
  - Use Public/Private Partnerships-not a panacea
  - Use Market Pricing to Shift Travel Off-Peak
