

Percentage of 2004 High School Graduates Immediately Enrolling in Post-Secondary Education¹



Percentage of 2004 Nevada and WCSD High School Graduates Enrolling in Local, In-State and Out-of-State Institutions¹




WCSD High School Graduates Attending UNR or TMCC

Percentage of WCSD Graduates Enrolling in UNR or TMCC by Year




Need for Remediation

Percentage of WCSD 2004 Graduates With ACT, SAT or Accuplacer Scores Demonstrating a Need for Remedial Math or English Placement




Remediation Rates by Institution

Percentage of WCSD Graduates Registered in a Remedial Course




