- SEEK INPUT AND APPROVAL FROM BUSINESS & INDUSTRY THROUGH JOINT TECHNICAL SKILLS COMMITTEES
- DEVELOP ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
- OBTAIN FINAL APPROVALS AND SIGNATURES

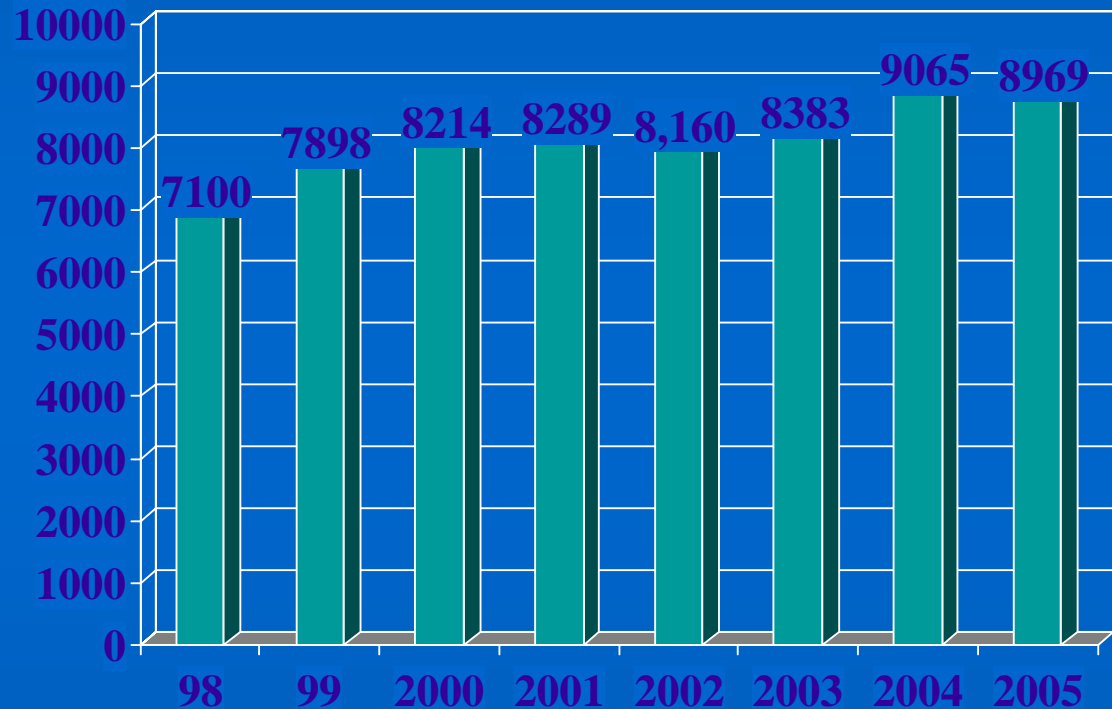
TO EARN COLLEGE CREDIT

- THE STUDENT MUST BE A JUNIOR OR SENIOR ENROLLED IN AN ARTICULATED COURSE.
- STUDENT APPLIES FOR CREDIT DURING THE SECOND SEMESTER BY COMPLETING A FORM AND PAYING \$10.00 FEE PER COURSE.
- TO RECEIVE CREDIT, THE STUDENT MUST EARN AN “A” OR “B” IN THE COURSE AS CERTIFIED BY THE TEACHER.
- A CCSN TRANSCRIPT IS THEN SENT TO THE STUDENT’S HOME DURING THE SUMMER.

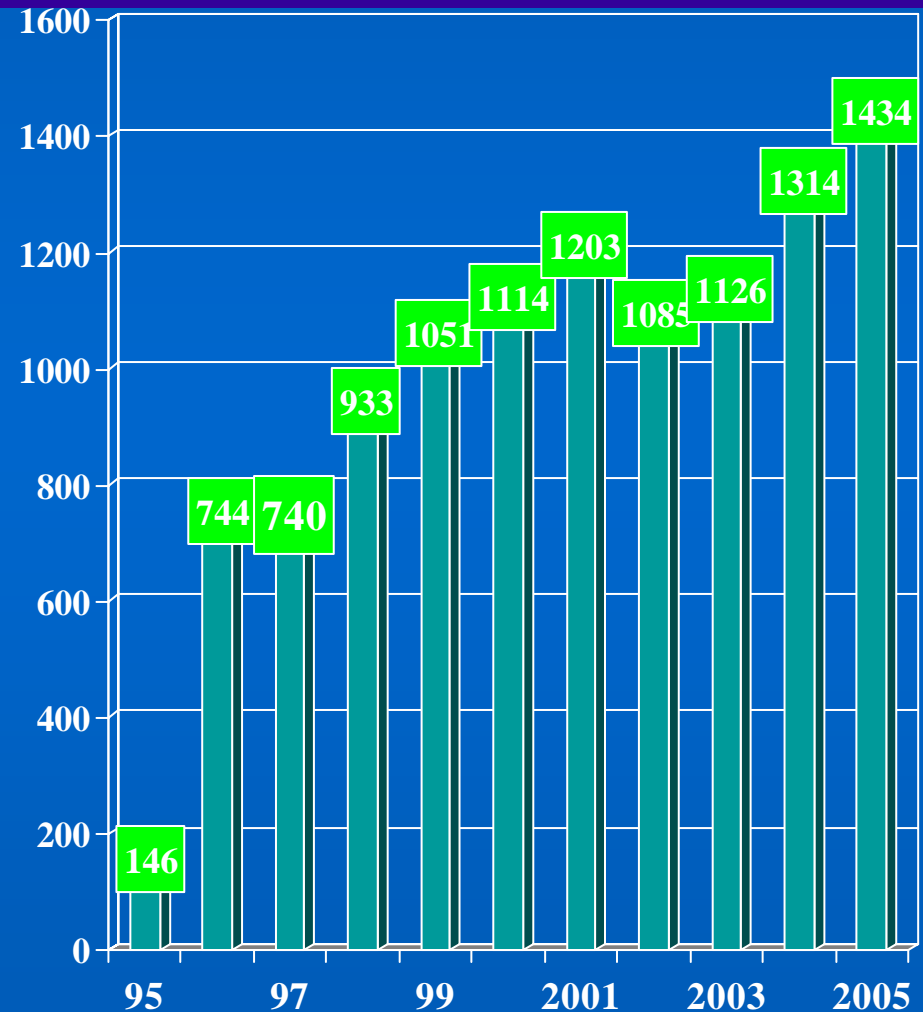

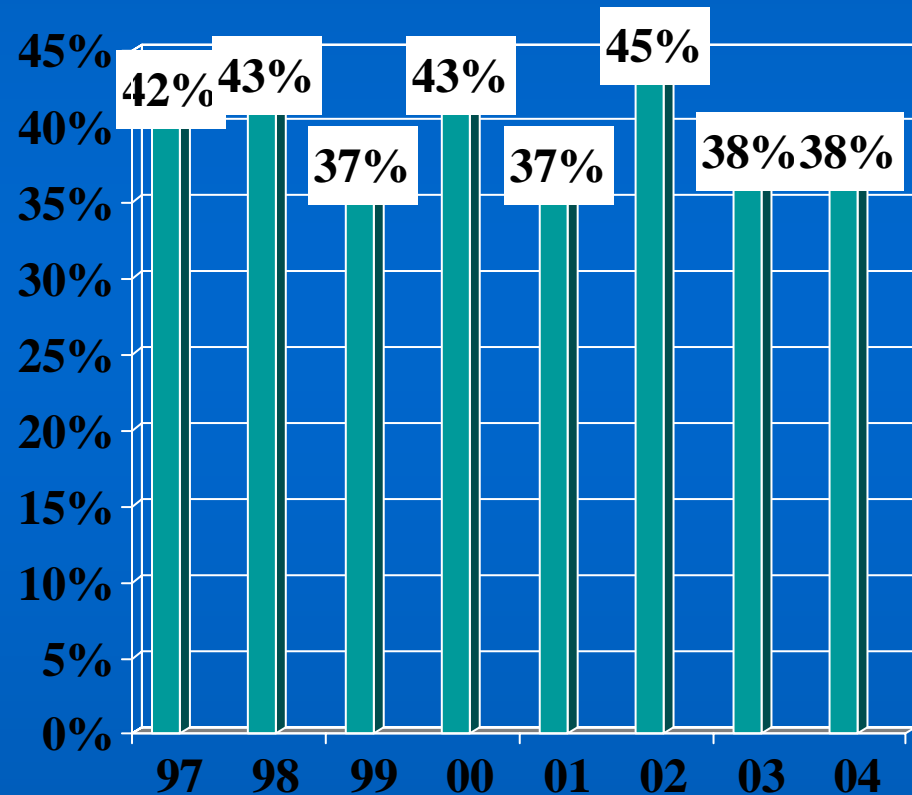
