Recommendations to improve program structure: 1) establish income and resource limit guidelines; 2) define eligibility criteria as cancer related to tobacco use or exposure and document levels of use or exposure; 3) require proof of income and resources, including application for SSI and Medicaid, for specified timeframe; 4) define what qualifies for continued assistance and length of assistance; 5) provide outcome measures on health improvement and/or acquisition of 3rd party payor; 6) stipulate repayment of benefits that are subsequently paid by a 3rd party payor; 7) document referrals to cessation programs; and 8) develop written policies and procedures for standard staff and client reference.
