

Offender Classes in NV

NRS 176.09123

Arrestee: Persons arrested for a felony

NRS 176.0913

Conviction: Persons convicted of any Felony, Crime against a child, misdemeanor sex offenses, Abuse of older or vulnerable persons, Failure to register with local law enforcement

NRS 179D.443

Sex Offender Registration: Persons required by Nevada law to register as a sex offender (Not being collected due to an injunction. Set for implementation later this year)


STaCS

 Samples are collected by all agencies through a web based software program called STaCS

 STaCS is used by many offender collection agencies including Cal DOJ, FBI, AZ, PA, CO, TX, FL, IL, MI, MO, RCMP, and many others

STaCS

 When a felony arrest is made the jail staff collect a set of prints and using the SID and SSN they check STaCS to see if a sample is already on file



If a sample exists with the same SID or SSN a warning shows up with the information of the existing record. Allowing the collector to decide if the sample is truly a duplicate

Demographic Information

Review and Submit

STaCS

 The DNA sample is collected, sealed inside the kit and sent to the lab once probable cause has been confirmed


 The laboratories receive the kits and prepare the samples for DNA processing

Lab Processing

 Once a DNA profile has been obtained it is uploaded into CODIS and goes to NDIS for national searching

The kit is then filed for long term storage

What Gets Entered?

- Specimen ID: S084109
- Laboratory ID: NV0160000
- Specimen Category: Forensic Unknown, Offender, Unidentified Human Remains
- DNA Profile: TH01: 7,9 D5S818: 9,13, TPOX: 8 etc.


No personally identifiable information is entered. CODIS is nameless

Typical Case

 An unknown male DNA profile from vaginal swabs is entered into the Nevada database as a Forensic Unknown

 Because it is a complete profile from an acceptable specimen type, it will be sent to NDIS and searched nationally

HOW CODIS WORKS EACH WEEK




DNA Profiles

Local DNA Databases (Washoe County Sheriff's Office, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police)

Who Is This Offender?

 Because CODIS has no names, we must use a separate database (STaCS) to track the personally identifiable information associated with each offender entered into CODIS

 For hits to offenders from other states we must contact the CODIS administrator for that state and request match confirmation and release of the offenders information



The Hit Process

Offender Hits must be confirmed

- This process is mandated by the FBI
 - Offender samples have no C.O.C.
 - The sample is pulled and re-typed
 - The fingerprint card is confirmed (CO)
 - Once the DNA profile is confirmed a report is issued releasing the name

Expungements

- The Washoe County Laboratory has received four expungement requests through the Central Repository
- All four requests were researched to see if another qualifying offense could be found
- All four expungement requests were granted
- There was no significant cost to these expungements

How Expungement Works

 The physical sample is destroyed and the information deleted from STaCS

The DNA profile is deleted from the local database

During the next upload to NDIS the sample is deleted from the National database

Implementation Costs

- STaCS was purchased in 2012 in anticipation of needing a statewide system to accommodate arrestee collection
 - Base Price \$170,000
 - Cost to accommodate arrestee's, maintain the system annually, and integrate with the Central Repository CCH \$145,000 to date
- DNA Collection Kits for Northern Agencies \$90,000
- Hiring of an Office Support Specialist \$62,000
- Hiring of a Criminalist \$101,000
- Setup/Training of arrestee collection sights \$2000

Administrative Assessment Collection in the North

- Collection amounts are sufficient to pay for production of DNA profiles ~ \$75 per sample
- They do not cover equipment costs or future improvements
- Washoe County BCC approved salary for OSS and Criminalist be paid from this fund
- Program supplemented with federal grant money
