Re: Nevada HIFA program statistics

Attached are some spreadsheets depicting the proposed HIFA waiver expenditures, covered lives and fund utilization for the five (5) year life of the project.

The first page (Option 5A) outlines the proposal as presented on May 7, 2004, with a small change in revenues available due to a change in the Federal Medicaid Assistance Percentage (FMAP).

The second page (Option 5B) outlines a modified proposal. This option drops the small business insurance package and moves all private coverage expansion to the Subsidy Program. As presented, this option only covers 10,000 lives though it can be scaled up or down based upon feedback from various members of the Technical Working Group and Legislative Subcommittee.

The last page presents the calculations utilized to estimate the availability of funding for the waiver project using the newly published FMAP percentages. Included is a comparison to the amount reported earlier.
