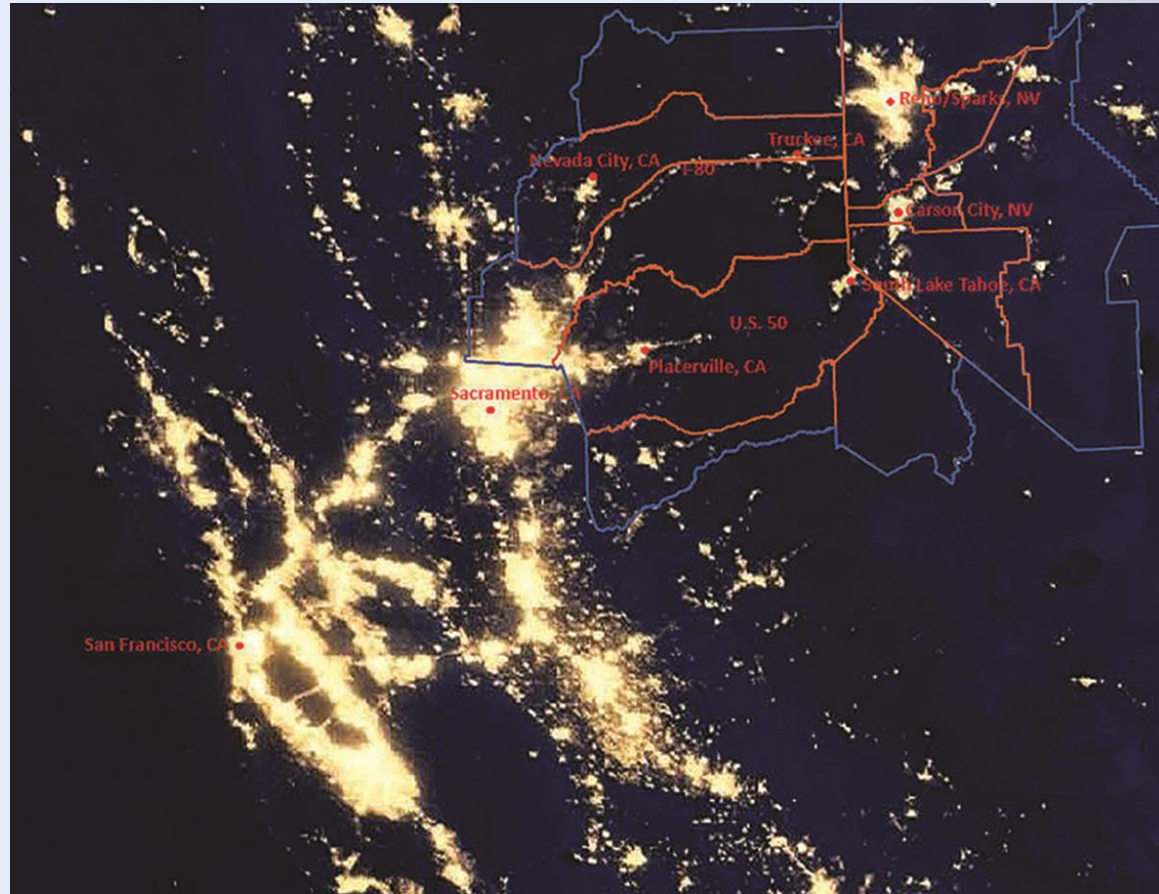

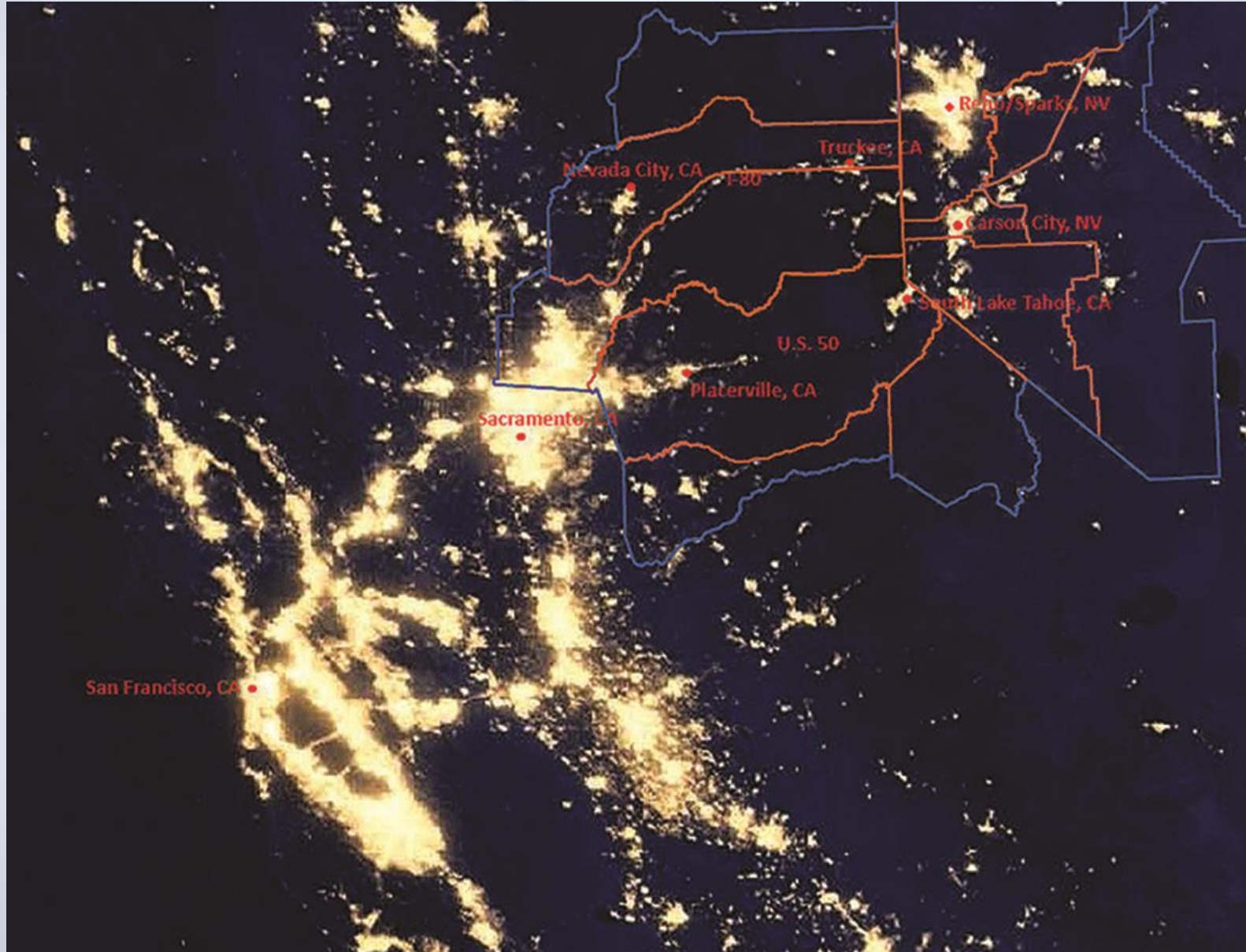


Megapolitan Area
