



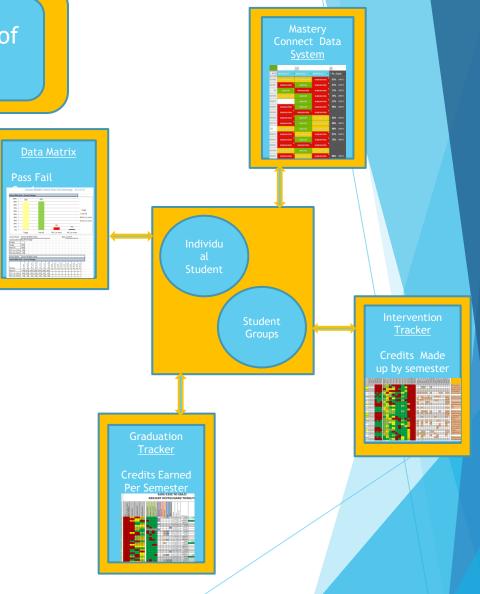
Tracking Individual and Groups of Students in Real Time

<u>Mastery Connect:</u> This system tracks student mastery of learning targets and common unit assessments

<u>Data Matrix:</u> Pass fail by course and by school track number of passing and failing grades

<u>Graduation Tracker:</u> Tracks number of credits earned by student and student groups

<u>Intervention tracker:</u> tracks interventions targeting credit recovery



Early wins

- Shift in organizational beliefs
- Intrinsic motivation for students and teachers is growing
- Quality of collaboration up significantly
- Alignment with NEPF (Teacher and Administrator Evaluation) Leverage
- Robust data systems -
- Elevated curriculum (All Content) Biology Algebra I
- Pass rates in Algebra I up from 72% to 88%
- # Credits earned up significantly...
- Moving more students into advanced tracks
- System is easily replicable and can provide same impact on districts that choose to make these changes.
