Legislative Counsel Bureau Announces Meeting of the Committee to Conduct an Investigation into Matters Relating to Reapportionment and Redistricting in Nevada

CARSON CITY - The Committee to Conduct an Investigation into Matters Relating to Reapportionment and Redistricting will conduct an initial organizational meeting for the 2021 reapportionment and redistricting process on Thursday, October 7, 2021 at 4:30 pm.

The agenda for this meeting will include the election of a committee chair and vice chair; discussion on the dates and locations of future meetings for public input; and submission of draft maps, a presentation from the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB) on the web-based tools available to the public to submit maps for consideration, and discussion of the research needs to be fulfilled by LCB.
