


## Quality Measures

- Provider Qualifications
  - Licensure or Certification from the Bureau of Health Care Quality and Compliance or the Aging and Disability Services Division
    - Includes background checks and training components
- Person Centered Planning/Health Safety and Wellness Assurances
  - Driven by the recipients
  - Includes individually identified goals and preferences related to relationships, community participation, employment, etc
  - Includes risk factors and plans to minimize them
- Participant Experience Surveys
  - Face to face visit by an individual trained in the survey, with the recipient of services to evaluate the persons perception of the quality of services being provided

#### Nursing Facility vs. HCBS Recipients




# Institutional & HCBS Waiver Spending by State Fiscal Year




#### Personal Care Services (PCS)

- In 2003 the PCS program was added as an expanded State Plan service
- Recipient assessments:
  - Functional assessment and service plan (FASP)
     completed in the recipient's home by licensed PTs
     and OTs.
- Services provided by:
  - Qualified individual who is not a legally responsible individual
  - Personal Care Services Agencies (108)
  - Intermediary Service Organizations (14)

### PCS Recipients & Expenditures




### ISO Recipients & Expenditures





# Money Follows the Person (MFP) Grant

- The MFP Grant is helping to further rebalance and redesign the long-term care system. We will do the following:
  - Create innovative long-term care services focused on selfdirection.
  - Build on the considerable success of FOCIS.
  - Develop a single, coordinated quality system
  - Collect and analyze data
  - Transition 524 individuals over the grant term
  - Partnership of Medicaid and Aging and Disability Services.
- Grant total: \$9.9M
