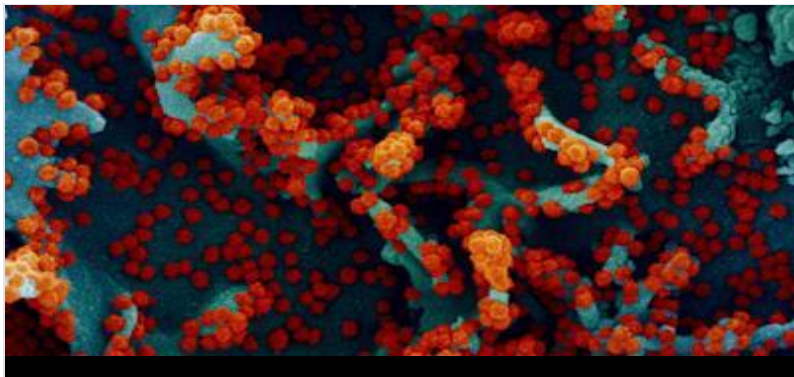


Dear Mr. Haas,
