September 9, 2021

AGENDA ITEM I—CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

Senator Wiener called the first meeting of the NYL for the 2021–2023 Term to order.

Senator Wiener noted that Jazmine Krueger-Eckhout decided to resign from her position as a youth legislator based on conflicting schedules.

AGENDA ITEM II—PUBLIC COMMENT

Senator Wiener called for public comment; however, no testimony was presented.

AGENDA ITEM III—SWEARING IN OF NEW YOUTH LEGISLATOR

Senator Wiener introduced Youth Legislator Price and swore him in.

Youth Legislator Price recited the NYL oath (Agenda Item III).

AGENDA ITEM IV—THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR

Senator Wiener called attention to the Leadership Responsibilities: Chair and Vice Chair document (<u>Agenda Item IV</u>) and explained the election process for the chair and vice chair for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

AGENDA ITEM V—ELECTION OF THE CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR OF THE NEVADA YOUTH LEGISLATURE FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE 2021–2023 TERM

Youth legislators who wished to run in the election for the chair or vice chair for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term completed a questionnaire. Prior to the meeting, all youth legislators received the completed questionnaires for chair (<u>Agenda Item V A</u>) and vice chair candidates (<u>Agenda Item V B</u>) to review.

The candidates for chair—Youth Legislators Dimasin, Miller, Moss, and Wong—provided their vision for the NYL for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

Senator Wiener called for a roll call vote in which Youth Legislators Dimasin and Moss each received the same number of votes.

Youth Legislators Dimasin and Moss then each shared what they hoped to accomplish during 2021–2022, and why they should be elected as NYL chair.

After another roll call vote, Senator Wiener announced Youth Legislator Moss as chair for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

The candidates for vice chair—Youth Legislators Grinstein, Lyle, and Raugust—shared their vision for the NYL for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

Senator Wiener called for a roll call vote in which Youth Legislators Grinstein and Lyle received the top number of votes.

Youth Legislators Grinstein and Lyle explained why they would be the premier vice chair candidate for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

After another roll call vote, Senator Wiener announced Youth Legislator Grinstein as vice chair for the first year of the 2021–2023 Term.

AGENDA ITEM VI-PUBLIC COMMENT

Senator Wiener called for public comment; however, no testimony was presented.

AGENDA ITEM VII-ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the NYL, the meeting was adjourned at $2:31\ p.m.$
