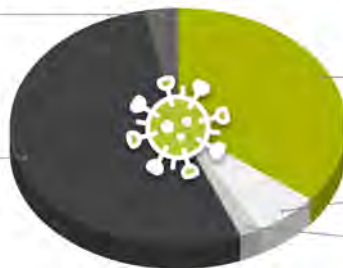

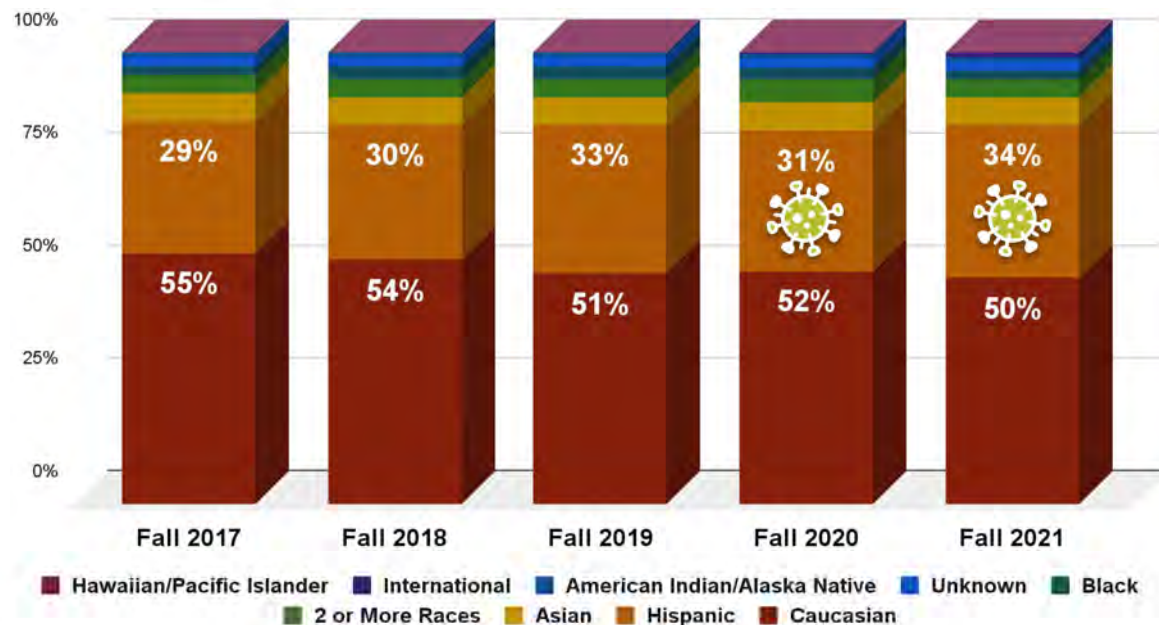

University Transfers & the Arts at TMCC

- Transfer degree-seekers comprise **75% of our student body**.
- University Transfer degrees comprise **73% of degrees** we award.
- **62% of students** earning a transfer degree at TMCC transfer to another institution to continue their education.
