


% Growth of Older Adults


NV Population Growth: Year by Age


NV Migration by Age and Area


NV Age and Gender Distribution, 2018










NV % of Households with Age 65 and older Living in Poverty


Avg Annual Expenditures by U.S. Region, Age 65 and older









Leading Causes of Death, Age 65 and Older, 2017






NV People Receiving Mental Health Treatment, 2019


NV Rate of Falls by Age Group, 2018


NV Drug Overdose Related Inpatient Admissions, 2019

NV Elder Abuse – Substantiated Cases, 2019








U.S. Age Distribution of Medicaid and CHIP Enrollees, 2017


Healthcare Expenditures by Type, 2014


Median Annual Costs of Care, 2019

Nursing Home Deficiencies in Detail, 2014




