About SLUPAC



Governor appointed Council with voting members from all 17 counties and Nevada Indian Commission



Provides statements of policy and recommendations concerning Federal, State & Local land use issues



Meetings are held quarterly throughout the state

HISTORY & INTENT

1977 Enabling Legislation

- SB 212 established Executive Council
- Help resolve land use conflicts between local governments

2014 Sunset Subcommittee Review

- Decided to keep Executive Council within NRS
- AB 144 Removed from State ACEC process and required members to be from around the state

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL



Consists of 4 SLUPAC members from around the State and the Administrator of State Lands (2-year terms)



Provides technical assistance, mediation, and conduct public hearings



If necessary, resolves land use inconsistencies between two or more adjacent or overlapping local government entities

The Executive Council only meets when requested from a local government
