- Gap in coverage due to changes in payer or patient status
 - ✓ Presumptive eligibility process for skilled
 - ✓ Expand MCO skilled/custodial coverage
- Long Term Care Bed Accessibility
- Managing the Back Door Support
 - ✓ Group Home Waiver Bed Availability

Skilled Nursing: Collaborative Funding Opportunities

- Continue our collaboration with Medicaid and skilled nursing industry to identify new creative funding opportunities and payment methodologies
 - √To maximize resources AND
 - √To ensure resources are directed to the most appropriate level of care for the individual

Collaborative Opportunities

Present System:

- Medicaid pending calculation in Provider Tax formula
- Quality measures reflective of care delivered in the facility

Future System:

- Acceptable base rate with quality focus for skilled care providers
- Payer driven access to all levels of care

Financial Implications to the Right Level of Care

Level of Care	Est. Daily Rate
Skilled Nursing/	\$206.72 avg. statewide
Long-Term Care	Medicaid rate
Assisted Living Facility	70% of SNF rate
Group Home Waiver	22% of SNF rate
Home Care Non-Skilled	20% of SNF rate

Conclusion

- Access to quality cost effective care in Nevada is important to all those we serve. In order to achieve this going forward we need to consider the following:
 - ✓ Coverage policy changes to streamline payer transitions (i.e. presumptive eligibility/no gaps in coverage)
 - ✓ Explore Medicaid payment method changes that will ensure the resources follow the patient care
 - ✓ payments that more closely approx. cost of care
 - √ supplemental payment programs
 - ✓ Creating access to lower levels of care will be more cost effective for the State
